This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent, for each acre irrigated, and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The right herein granted is limited to the appropriation of water from Catharine Creek for fish propagation purposes.

The amount of water appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use and not to exceed 4.0 cubic feet per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation. The priority date of this permit is January 23, 1923.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before October 31, 1924. and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before June 1, 1925

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1926.

CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That OREGON STATE HIGHWAY COMMISSION

of Salem, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Catherine Creek a tributary of Grande Ronde River for the purpose of Irrigation of 1.8 acres under Permit No. 6048 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from January 23, 1923;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed .023 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 20, T. 4 S., R. 40 E., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated throughout the irrigation season,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NOTE: This certificate is issued to confirm a change in use of water approved by an order of the State Engineer, dated June 18, 1943, pursuant to the provisions of Section 116-606, O. C. L. A., and supersedes certificate of water right heretofore issued to the Oregon State Game Commission and recorded at page 8002, Volume 8, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.


