of Rm. 301 Highway Building, Salem , State of Orsson, 97310 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Clackenss River

a tributary of Willamette River irrigation of 72.6 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 32895 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accorderice with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 24, 1967

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.9 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 1 (NW SW), Section 18, T. 3 S., R. 4 R., T. M., 2490 feet North and 40 feet East from the SW Corner of Section 18.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 24 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.




