This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 1.20 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Clackamas River

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is August 24, 1967

Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 17, 1969 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1970

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1971

## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

OREGON STATE PARKS AND RECREATION DIVISION  
OREGON STATE HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT

of **Rm. 301 Highway Building, Salem**, State of **Oregon, 97310**, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of **Clackamas River**

a tributary of **Willamette River** for the purpose of irrigation of **72.6 acres**

under Permit No. **32895** and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from **August 24, 1967** that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed **0.9 cubic foot per second**

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the **Lot 1 (NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ ), Section 18, T. 3 S., R. 4 E., T. M., 2490 feet North and 40 feet East from the SW Corner of Section 18.**

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to **one-eightieth** of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed **2 $\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre** for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

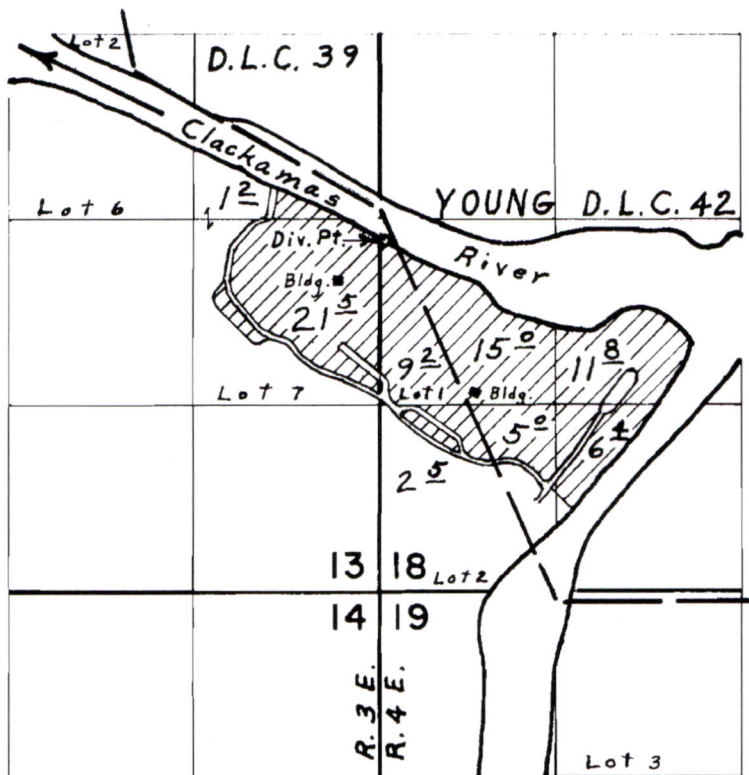

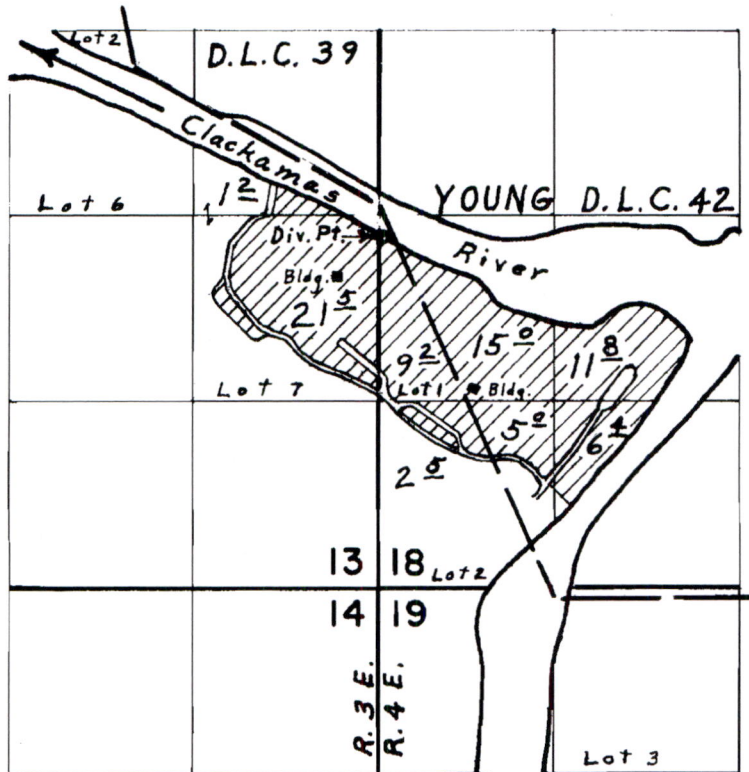
