To Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Oregon State Parks and Recreation Division of the Oregon State Highway Department of Room 301 Highway Building, Salem State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is unnamed creek, a tributary of Columbia River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.5 cubic feet per second.

**3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Park purposes 0.15 c.f.s. irrigation 0.35 c.f.s.

4. The point of diversion is located 660 ft. N and 200 ft. W from the SE corner of Sec. 34

being within the SE4 SE4 of Sec. 34, Tp. 3 N R. 9 E, W. M., in the county of Hood River

5. The pipe line to be 2,600 ft. in length, terminating in the NW4 SW4 of Sec. 35, Tp. 3 N R. 9 E, W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.50 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from an unnamed creek

The use to which this water is to be applied is use in public park and irrigation being 0.15 cfs for park use and 0.35 cfs for irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/40th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is August 17, 1967

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 18, 1969 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1969.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1970.

CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That OREGON STATE PARKS & RECREATION DIVISION
Oregon State Highway Department
of Room 301, Highway Building, Salem, State of Oregon, has made proof
to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of
an unnamed creek

a tributary of **Columbia River** for the purpose of
use in public park and irrigation of 3.4 acres

under Permit No. **32846** of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters
has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby
confirmed dates from **August 17, 1967**

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes
aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed
**0.10 cubic foot per second, being 0.05 cubic foot per second for park use and
0.05 cubic foot per second for irrigation**

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.
The point of diversion is located in the **SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 34, T. 3 N., R. 9 E., W. M.,
660 feet North and 200 feet West from SE Corner, Section 34.**

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other
right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to **one-fortieth** of one cubic foot per second
per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited
to a diversion of not to exceed **4 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated
during the irrigation season of each year,**

and shall
conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is
appurtenant, is as follows:

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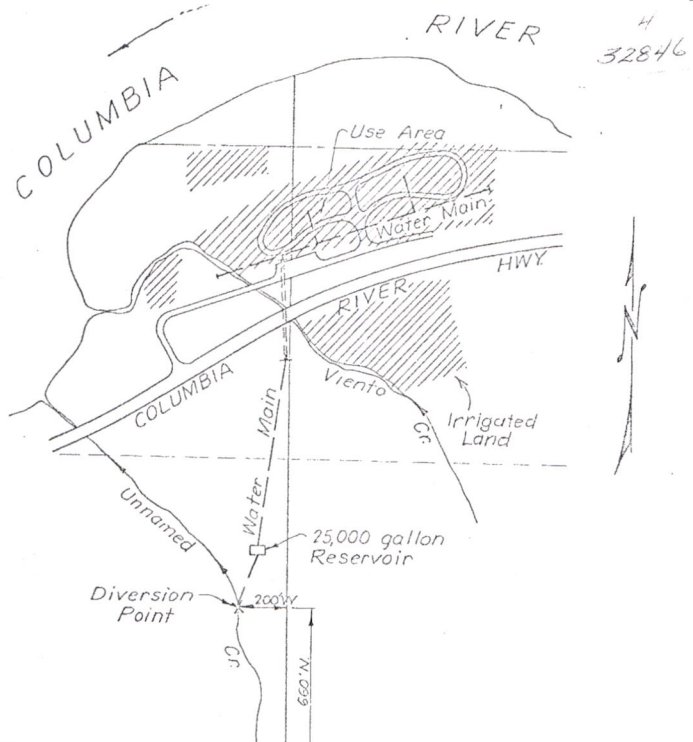
