## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

OREGON STATE PARKS & RECREATION DIVISION Oregon State Highway Department

of Room 301, Highway Building, Salem , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed creek

under Permit No. 32846 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 17, 1967

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.10 cubic foot per second, being 0.05 cubic foot per second for park use and 0.05 cubic foot per second for irrigation

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SEX SEX, Section 34, T. 3 N., R. 9 E., W. M., 560 feet North and 200 feet West from SE Corner, Section 34.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.


