This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.025 measured at the point of diversion, cubic feet per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from an unnamed spring, tributary of Long Tom River

The use to which this water is to be applied is Public park purposes

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to ----- of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is December 3, 1935

Actual construction work shall begin on or before December 12, 1936 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before Oct. 1, 1937



CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That STATE HIGHWAY COMMISSION

of Salem, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Unnamed Spring a tributary of Long Tom River for the purpose of Public park purposes under Permit No. 11940 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from December 3, 1935;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.025 cubic foot per second measured at the point of diversion,

or its equivalent in case of rotation.

The point of diversion is located in the SE 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 28, Township 16 South, Range 6 West, T. 16. N.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

PLACE OF USE:

NE 1/4 NW 1/4 and SE 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 28, Township 16 South, Range 6 West, T. 16. N.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

After the expiration of fifty years from the date of this certificate or on the expiration of any federal power license issued in connection with this right, and after not less than two years' notice in writing to the holder hereof, the State of Oregon, or any municipality thereof, shall have the right to take over the dams, plants and other structures and all appurtenances thereto which have been constructed for the purpose of devoting to beneficial use the water rights specified herein, upon condition that before taking possession the State or municipality shall pay not to exceed the fair value of the property so taken, plus such reasonable damages, if any, to valuable, serviceable and dependable property of the holder of this certificate, not taken over, as may be caused by the severance therefrom of the property taken in accordance with the provisions of section 47-508, Oregon Code 1930.
