FINAL ORDER

**Summary:** Order approving the renewal of Application G-12601 and issuing Permit G-18906.

**Authority**

The application was processed in accordance with Oregon Administrative Rule (OAR) 690-502-0200. These administrative rules provide the authority to extend a water use permit, for a period not to exceed five years, provided that the groundwater resource can probably support the extended use. **FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. On July 5, 1991, Glenn Walters Nursery, Inc., submitted an application to the Department for a water use permit. The proposed use is located in the Chehalem Mountain Groundwater Limited Area.
2. On August 4, 1995, the applicant submitted a Claim of Beneficial Use.
3. On June 23, 1994, the Department issued a water use permit. This permit expired on June 23, 1999. The permit was renewed in July 1999, September 2004, October 2009, December 2013, and October 2018.
4. On December 16, 2009, the application was assigned to Midway Equities, LLC.

**CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

1. The Department finds that the groundwater resource can probably support the extended use.

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**


This is a Final Order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 536.075 and ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

NOTE: When issuing permits, ORS 537.628(1) authorizes the Department to include limitations and conditions which have been determined necessary to protect the public welfare, safety and health.

**ORDER**

Application G-12601 has been renewed and Permit G-18906 is issued. This permit shall expire on October 31, 2028.
