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#### LEGAL DESCRIPTION:

TRACT 12 (3S45 5BC TL 500)

A tract of land situated in Lot 6, Section 5, Township 3 South, Range 45 East of the Williamette Meridian, Wallowa County, Oregon more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING 257.44 feet North of a point marked by a ½" pipe 18 inches long, which point bears North 88°11' East (magnetic variation 21°30' East) 886.2 feet from the West Quarter corner of said Section 5; thence North 51.48 feet; thence East to the high water mark of Wallowa Lake; thence Southerly along the high water mark of Wallowa Lake to a point 51.48 feet at right angles South from the above East course; thence West parallel with and 51.48 feet at right angles South from the said East course to the point of beginning.

ALSO a strip of land commencing at the Northwest corner, as shown by Survey No. CS 96-018, of that percel described in that deed dated June 8, 1995, and recorded in the Office of the Wallowa County Clerk on June 22, 1995 as Microfiche No. 95-28988 (hereinafter "Jones Parcel") at a 1" iron pin set by the Plat of Wallowa Lake Heights, vacated, all as shown by Survey Number CS 96-018; thence North 1°6' East 10 feet; thence South 88"54'24" East 122.5 feet more or less to the West boundary of that parcel described in deed dated August 2, 2001, and recorded in the Office of the Wallowa County Clerk on August 7, 2001, as Microfiche No. 2001-43706; thence Southerly 10 feet more or less along the West boundary of said parcel to the North boundary of the Jones parcel as shown by the Survey Number CS 96-018; thence North 88"54'24" West to the point of beginning.
