\*APPLICATION FOR PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Oregon State Parks and Recreation Branch (Name of applicant) of 300 State Highway Building - Salem (Mailing address) State of Oregon 97310, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Onyhee River (Name of stream), a tributary of the Snake River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.13 cubic feet per second. (If water is to be used from more than one source, give quantity from each)

\*\*3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Irrigation of lawn, trees and landscape plantings. (See Remarks) (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

5. The Pipeline to be 1,500 ft. (Main ditch, canal or pipe line) (Miles or feet) in length, terminating in the SW 1/4 of NW 1/4 of Sec. 32, Tp. 22S (Smallest legal subdivision) (N. or S.) R. 45 E, W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map. (E. or W.)

DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

Diversion Works—

Remarks: The water applied for in this application will be supplemental to the water used under Permit No. 25571, for public park purposes, which is filed in the State Record of Water Right Certificates, Volume 22, Page 30502. Due to expansion of the overnight camp in recent years, the quantity of water proved to be inadequate for potable and irrigation use. The water source contained in Permit No. 25571 will only be used to provide water for potable and sanitary purposes and the water applied for under this application will be used to provide irrigation for the area presently covered by Permit No. 25571.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.13 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Owyhee River

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is June 11, 1975

Actual construction work shall begin on or before February 13, 1977 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1977.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1978.

CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to certify, That

OREGON STATE PARKS AND RECREATION BRANCH

of Suite 301, 525 Trade St. SE, Salem, State of Oregon 97310, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Owyhee River

a tributary of Snake River for the purpose of irrigation of 5.3 acres

under Permit No. 39506 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 11, 1975

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.09 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 31, T22S, R45E, WM; 3510 feet North and 30 feet West from SE Corner Section 31.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

- 0.2 acre SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 31
0.3 acre NW 1/4 NW 1/4
4.8 acres SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 32
Township 22 South, Range 45 East, WM

In processing the application towards issuance of the permit, it appears that a clerical error was inadvertently made in limiting the duty of water to not exceed 1/80th of one cubic foot per second per acre and 4 acre-feet per acre. In the issuance of this certificate, the duty of water has been raised to 1/60th cubic foot per second per acre and 4 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, in keeping with the customary policy and determination of this office of the proper maximum limits.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Policy Review Board with an effective date prior to this right.

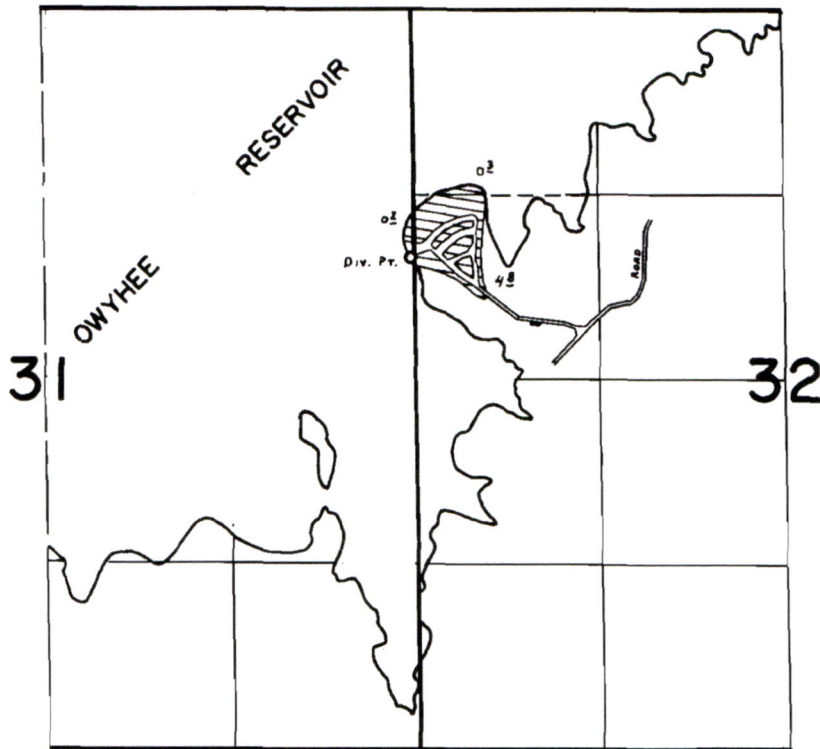
