CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to certify, That

, State of Oregon 97310 of Suite 301, 525 Trade St. SE, Salem , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Owvhee River

Snake River a tributary of irrigation of 5.3 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 39506 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.09 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of is located in the SE 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 31, T22S, R45E, WM; diversion is located in the 3510 feet North and 30 feet West from SE Corner Section 31.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is tenant, is as follows:

0.2 acre SE 1/4 NE 1/4 appurtenant, is as follows:

Section 31 0.3 acre NW 1/4 NW 1/4 4.8 acres SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 32 Township 22 South, Range 45 East, WM

In processing the application towards issuance of the permit, it appears that a clerical error was inadvertently made in limiting the duty of water to not exceed 1/80th of one cubic foot per second per acre and 4 acre-feet per acre. In the issuance of this certificate, the duty of water has been raised to $1/60{
m th}$ cubic foot per second per acre and 4 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, in keeping with the customary policy and determination of this office of the proper maximum limits.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Policy Review Board with an effective date prior to this right.


