This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.21 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from an unnamed intermittent water channel.

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/40 of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is March 24, 1972

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 27, 1974 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1975.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1976.

CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That OREGON STATE PARKS & RECREATION SECTION

of 300 Highway Bldg., Salem, State of Oregon, 97310, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed intermittent water channel (West Culver Drain)

a tributary of Crooked River for the purpose of irrigation of 17.0 acres

under Permit No. 36828 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 24, 1972 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.21 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 11, T. 12 S., R. 12 E., W. M., 1900 feet North from the SE Corner, Section 11

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.



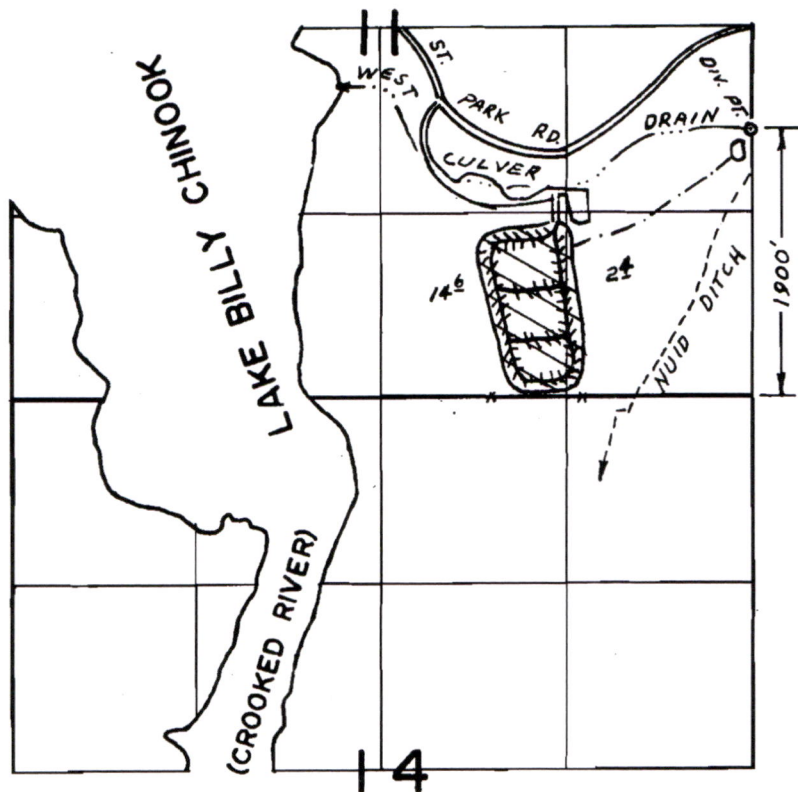
