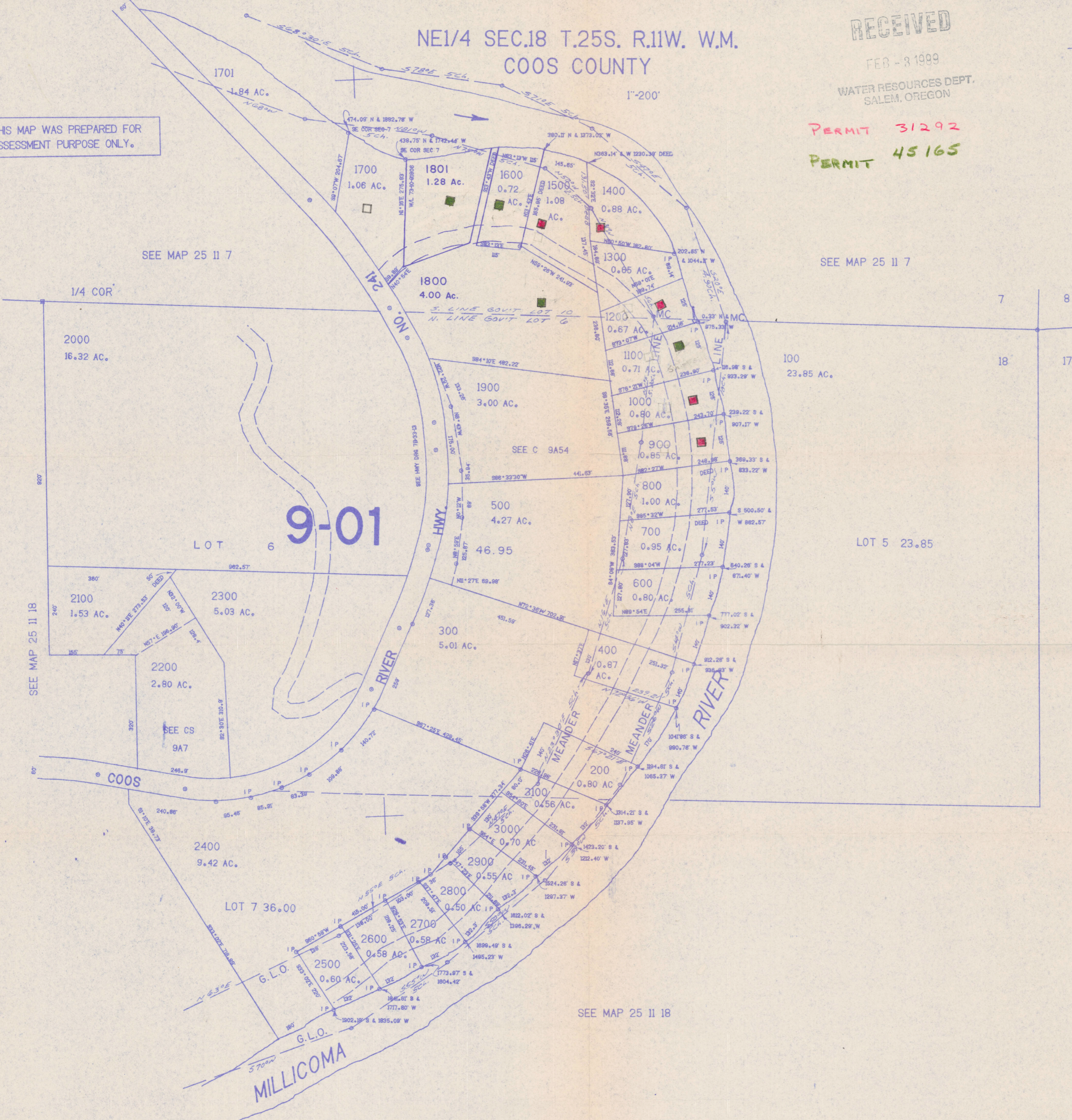

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from a spring

The use to which this water is to be applied is domestic use of four families

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to - - - of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is June 3, 1980

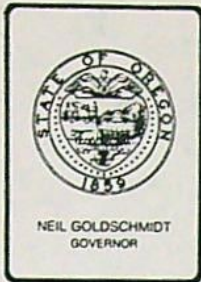

On Oct. 12, 1988: I mailed to you maps and copies of the water rights to which property they applied and tried to explain to you the mistake that was made.

On Nov. 22, 1988: you forward me a letter rejecting all that information.

In contacting state Water Master in Coquille, he advised me to obtain these letters here enclosed as to the use of the water rights.

I myself uses the water on an emergency basis only at least one or two times a year, when pump goes off a pump breaks down.

Water Master assured me that this
would correct the mistakes that
have been made.

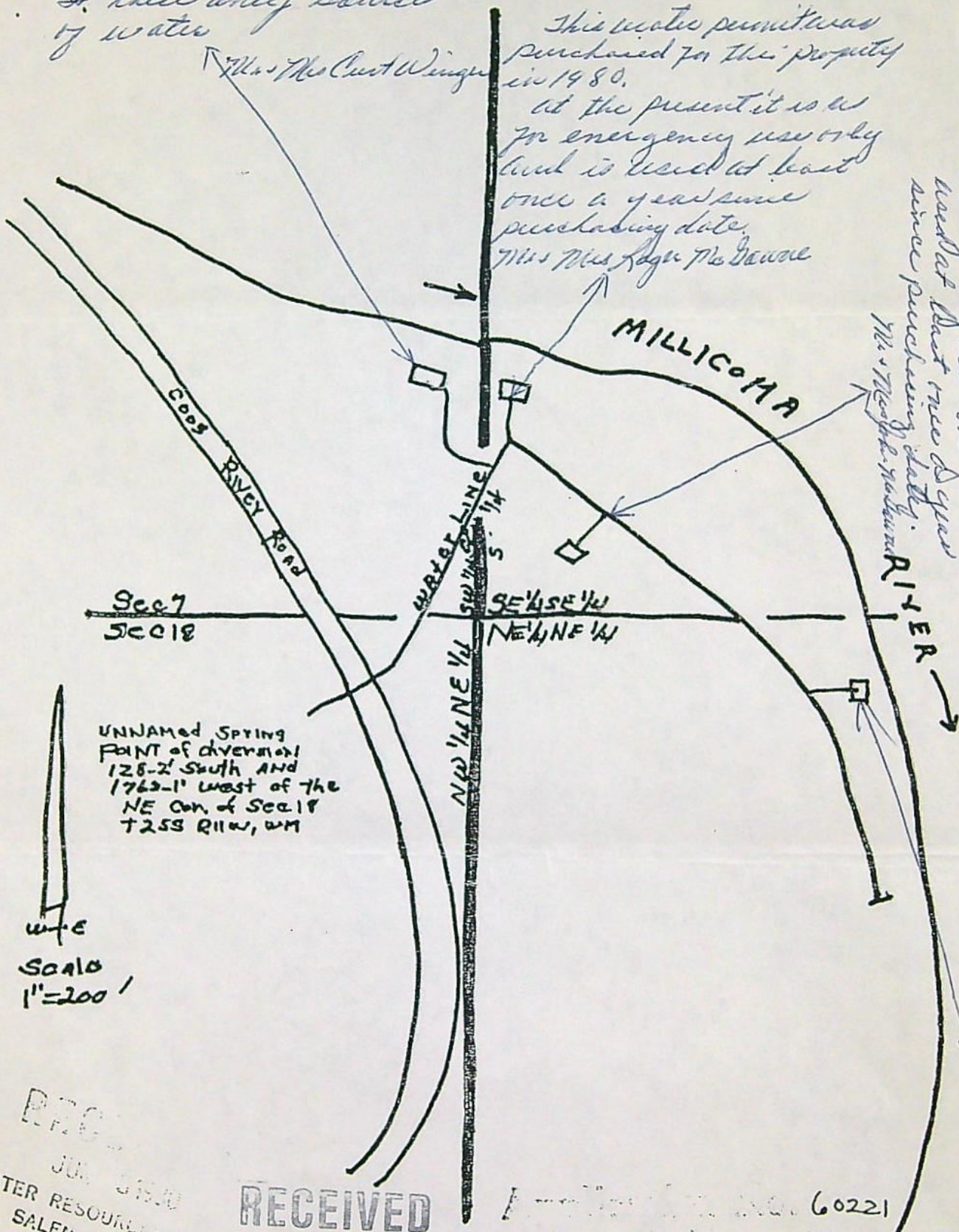



I HAVE ENCLOSED COPIES OF THE FIELD NOTES AND OTHER INFO. I TRUST THIS WILL CLEAR UP SOME OF YOUR CONFUSION ABOUT THE WATER RIGHT ISSUED IN 1975.

THERE WERE EIGHT FAMILIES USING WATER FROM THE SPRING AT THE TIME OF THE FIELD WORK ON 8/1/72. ONLY FIVE, HOWEVER, HAD BEEN IN USE SINCE THE "C" DATE OF 10/1/69. THE OTHER THREE, PLUS ONE ADDITIONAL HOUSE ON THE SW SIDE OF THE ROAD, WERE THE APPARENT SUBJECTS OF PERMIT 45165, FILED BY JOHN MCGOWNE IN 1980. HIS APPLICATION GIVES NO CLUES AS TO THE NAMES OF THE OWNERS INVOLVED IN THE SECOND FILING.

OUR FIELD INSPECTION FOR THE MCGOWNE PERMIT 45165 ON 9/17/88 STATES THAT ONLY ONE OF THE FOUR HOUSES IS "HOOKED UP" TO THE SPRING, AND THEN ONLY AS A BACKUP TO A WELL. I TRUST YOU RECEIVED A COPY OF MY 11/22/88 LETTER TO MR. MCGOWNE.

Dear Mr. McGowne:

On October 12, 1988, we received a letter from you which we presume refers to Permit 45165. The permit was issued October 14, 1980, and allows for the use of 0.01 cfs of water from a spring for domestic use of four families. Under the time limits, the use was to have been completed on or before October 1, 1983.

Our field representative contacted you on September 17, 1988 in order to conduct our usual field inspection. This inspection is to determine the actual extent of use, from which the final water right is issued.

Our representative reports that he spoke to you and that only one house uses the spring for domestic purposes, and then only as a backup source to a well. Apparently, the other three house do not use the spring.

Assuming this information is correct, the final water right certificate will be issued describing only domestic use for one family. If you have any questions, feel free to contact us.

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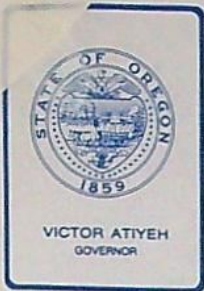

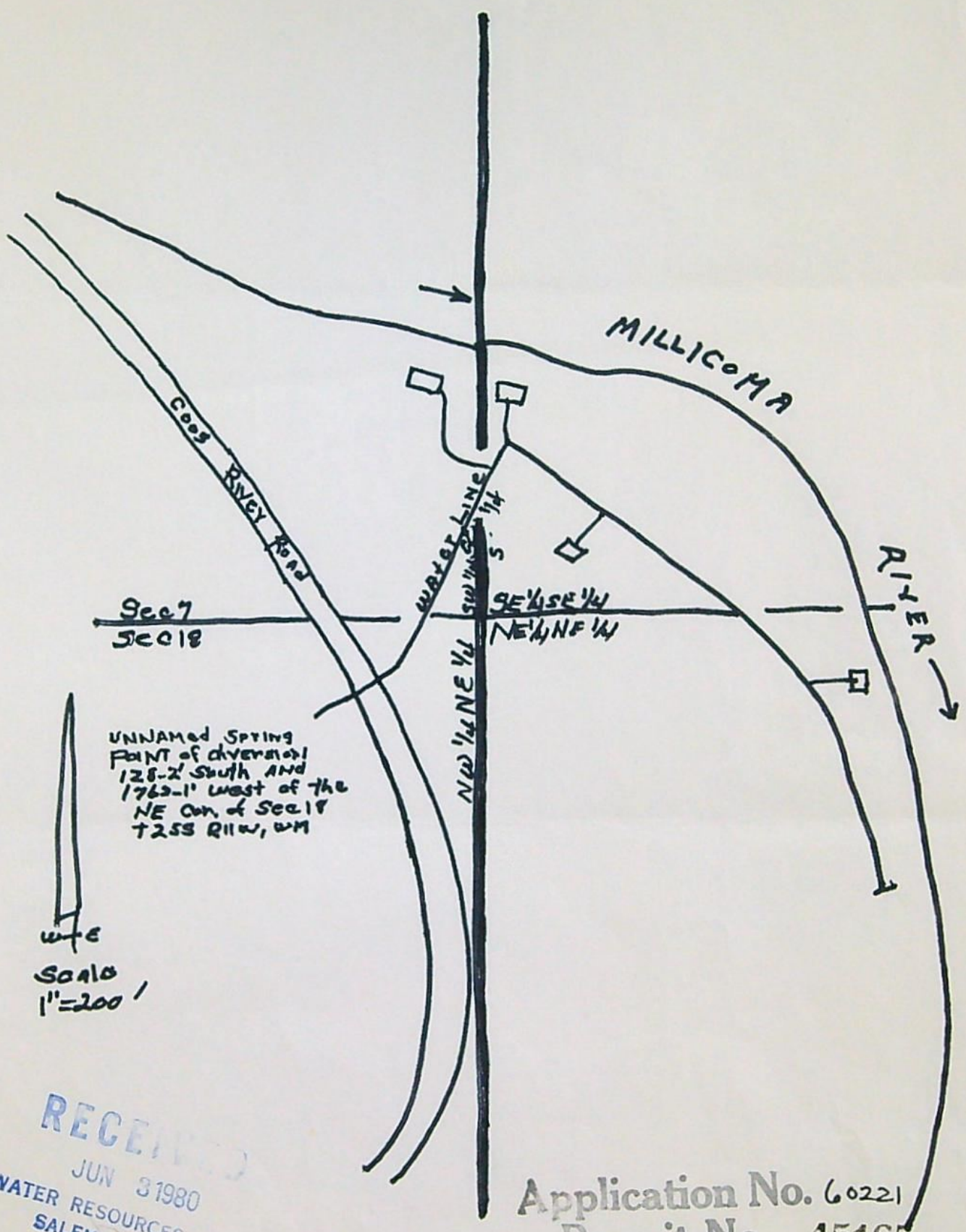
