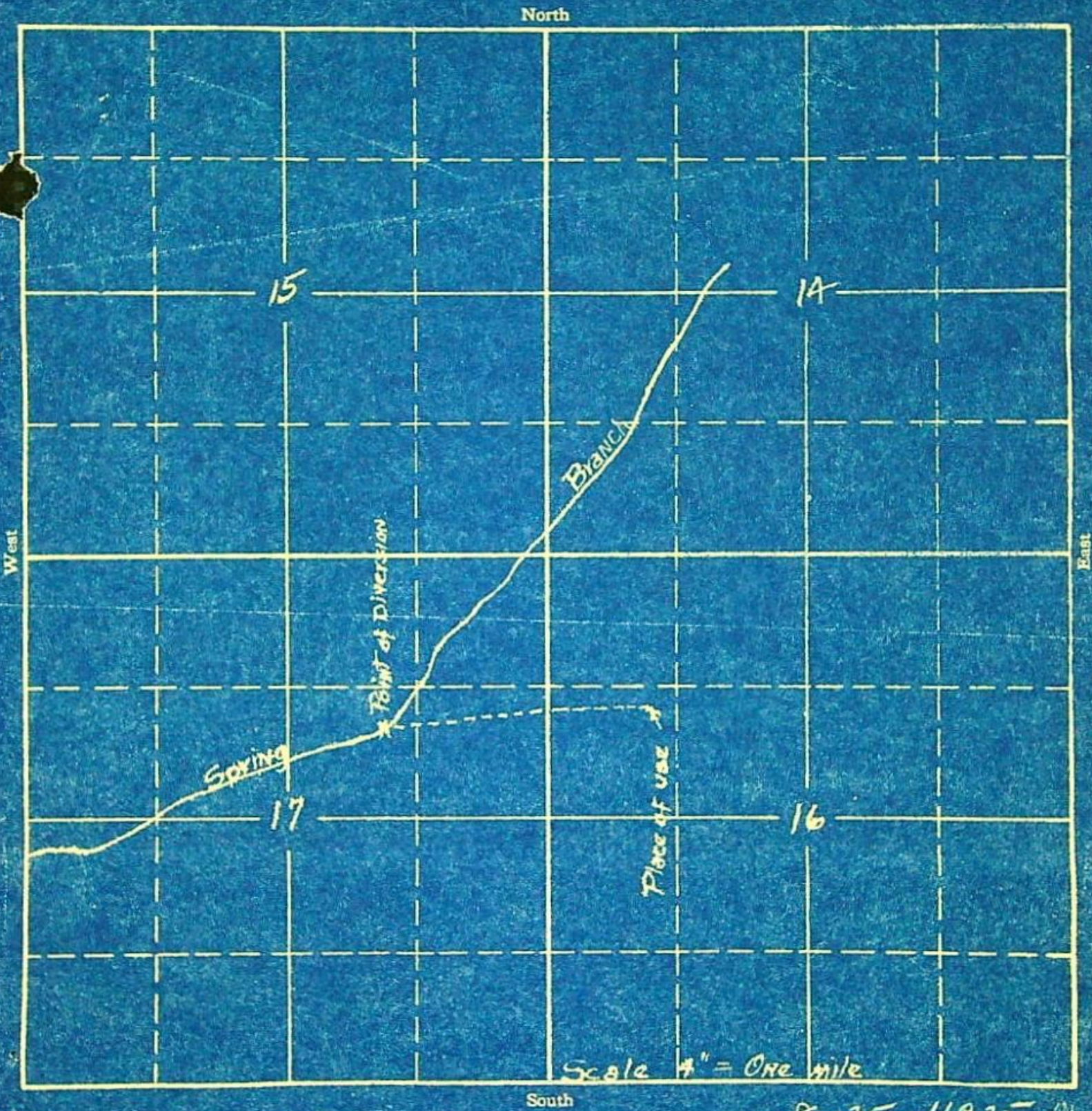

Herewith you will find Application No. 16925, Permit No. 12682, together with blue print.

This application has been approved and recorded in this office.

Please read carefully the following instructions:

Your permit has been recorded in this office, but you should hold the original as evidence of your water right unless the land described therein is disposed of. In that event you should file an assignment to the new owner for record in this office. Assignment blanks will be furnished upon request.

Whenever a measuring device becomes necessary for the proper distribution of water the permittee will be required to install one to the satisfaction of the State Engineer as provided by Section 47-701, Oregon Code 1930.

As it appears from statements made in your application that all construction work has been done and the appropriation completed, I am mailing to the watermaster in your district a blank for making final proof. He will assist you in completing the proof. The form should be filled out, giving a complete description of the appropriation, and the affidavits of appropriator and witnesses executed before a notary public. It should then be submitted to this office with a fee of \$1.00 for recording your water right certificate in the county clerk's office.

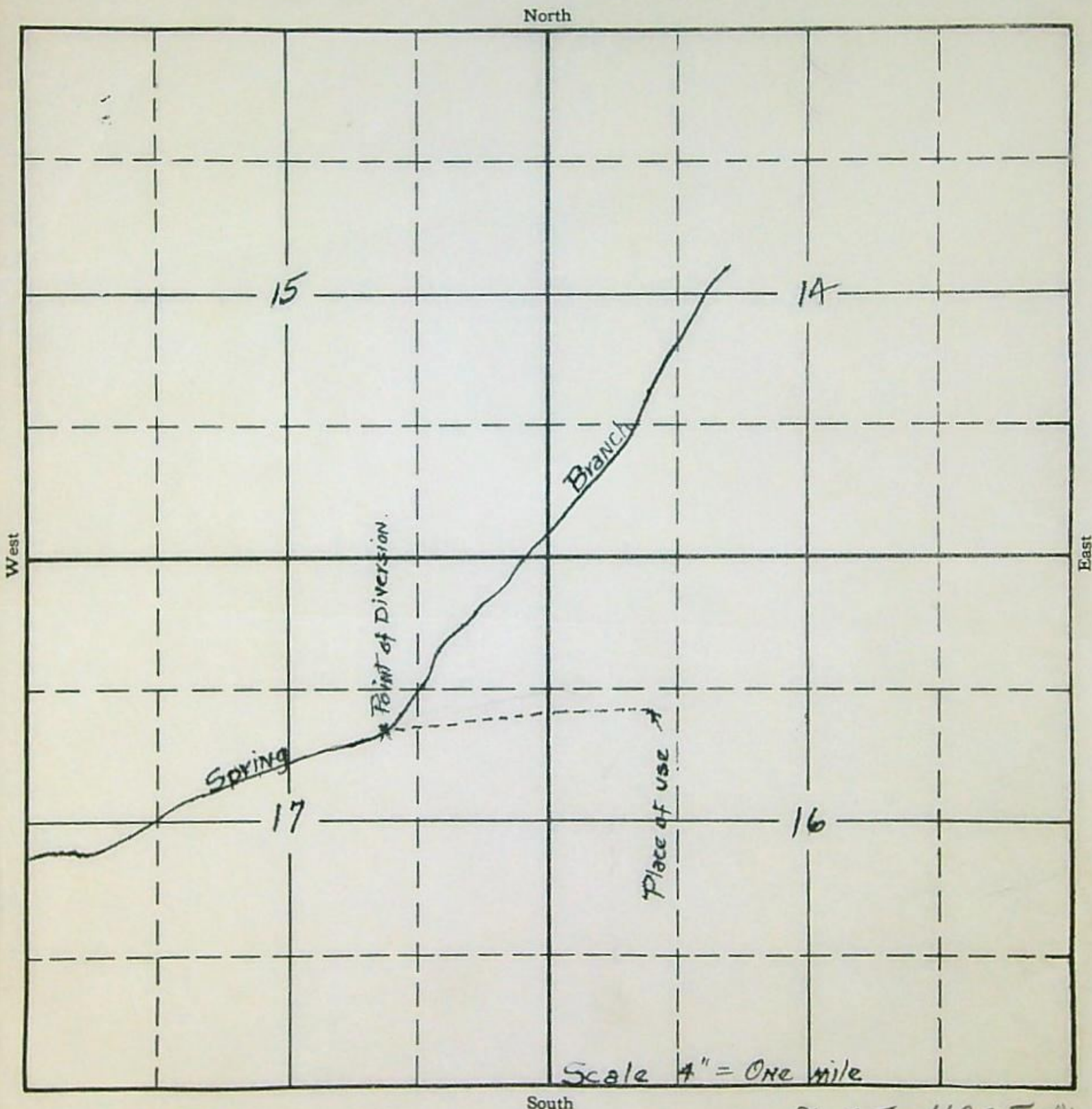
