



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

(b) Affidavits by Janeen Armbruster and Ted LeBraun alleging non-use of water from storage in Holzhauser Reservoir on lands across the county road to the West of the reservoir.

(c) An application for a permit to store 40.0 acre feet of water in Holzhauser Reservoir for irrigation purposes, together with a print of a plans sheet prepared by Tom Pearce.

After this survey, proof may be made and certificate issued covering the actual use of water as found by the engineer. In the case of irrigation, any lands described in the permit that have not been irrigated will be automatically eliminated from the water right.

In the meantime, the permit which you hold will be valid evidence of the water right in question so long as you continue to use the water.



Pursuant to your request, I am returning your sketch and the typed partial sheet.

For your convenience in filing an application for a permit to appropriate water, I am enclosing a form, together with a copy of the Rules and Regulations of the State Engineer, in which you will find definite instructions for preparing an application and the map which must accompany it.

It is essential that the map accompanying an application be drawn on transparent tracing paper or tracing cloth showing all of the important items of the proposed appropriation, including definitely the area to be irrigated in each forty-acre tract and in the instant case the location of the lateral delivering water to the lands to be irrigated, as explained on pages 6 and 8 of the Rules and Regulations. This specific map is required regardless of the fact that there may be maps on file in this office covering the general area involved.

If it is proposed to file an application for a permit to irrigate more than 30 acres of land, the required map must be made by an engineer or a surveyor as explained in the Rules and Regulations.

Detailed information relative to old rights to the use of the waters of Rogue River is on file in the office of Mr. Tom R. Pearce, Watermaster of District No. 16, in the Court House at Grants Pass. Maps of the Rogue River are also on file in the Watermaster's office and available for inspection.

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
