

Dear Sir:

The work on my Water Wright has been somewhat delayed - I have about half of the land irrigated and am seeding to permanent grasses. The other half will be delayed for a time for the following reasons.

1. The fill I built to carry the water to the portion that has not been as yet irrigated is of such soil that water soon soaks through the fill and washes it out. Also there is a rodent problem. It will be necessary to use about 2000 feet of pipe to get the water on the land to be irrigated.

2. The topography is such that the land is going to need more leveling for flood irrigation than I originally anticipated.

This additional work and costs make it necessary to request an extension of the completion date of the project. Please send me the necessary forms.
