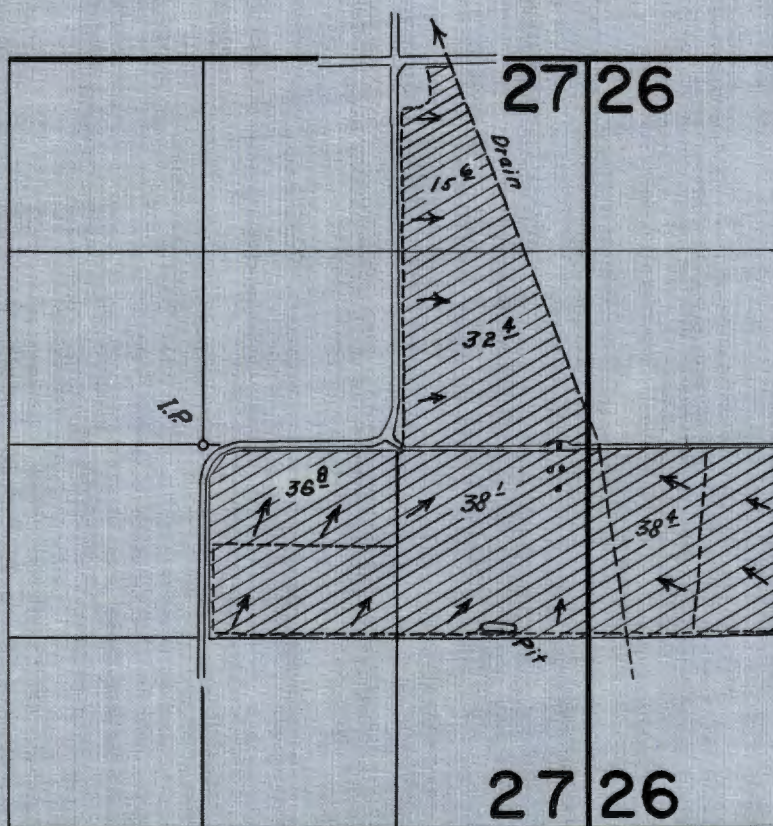

Dear Mr. Ward:

We have recently received your application numbered G-6752 and a print of a map. Thank you for sending us your check in the amount of \$34.00 for the additional irrigation recording fees.

Certificate of water right recorded at Page 33398 (Permit G-1784) issued to Clyde Ward does not include the use of water within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 26, Township 8 South, Range 40 East, W.M.; therefore, your application will have to be amended by deleting all reference to the permit number G-1784. We will delete this information from the application if you will send us written authorization to do so.

In the event water will no longer be appropriated from Geddes pit as allowed under the water right, our records should be cleared of this water right. We will prepare the necessary affidavit of abandonment if the owner of the land will send us a statement requesting the cancellation of the water right.

Further action will be held on your application numbered G-6752 for a reasonable length of time pending your reply.

Dear Mr. Ward:

Your application for a permit to appropriate 900 gallons of water per minute from Missouri Flat Well No. 1 for the irrigation of 160 acres has been received along with a print of a map and the fees of \$23.50. Your application has been filed as number G-6752.

Item 17 of the application will have to be completed by listing the month and year that your project will be completely irrigated. It is also necessary to sign the application in the space provided under item 18.

Your application requires an examination fee of \$15.00 in addition to an irrigation recording fee for 160 acres of \$42.50. We have applied \$23.50 to your application, however, an additional \$34.00 is required to complete the fees.

For clarification, the number of acres within each forty acre tract will have to be shown on your map to correspond with the data given in item 12 of the application.

In the event water from Geddes pit (permit G-1784) will no longer be used for supplemental irrigation purposes, this right should be cleared from our records. If the owner of the land will send us a statement requesting the cancellation of the certificate of water right we will prepare the necessary affidavit of abandonment.

I am returning your print of a map and application for correction and completion. The application is endorsed so that in order to retain its priority date, it must be received in this office on or before March 13, 1975.



I have your application for an extension of time limits under your water right permit No. G-1784, and a check in the amount of \$2 for which our receipt No. 40034 is enclosed.

I note on your application you say that you have used water under the permit for irrigation of "about 290 acres".

Permit No. G-1784 authorizes the appropriation of not to exceed 2.16 second feet of water from Geddes Pit for supplemental irrigation of 172.7 acres of land, only.

It appears there may be some misunderstanding in regard to the coverage of this permit. If you have used water from the source identified as Geddes Pit for supplemental irrigation of 172.7 acres of land, it would appear that you should report completion of the appropriation so that a final proof survey can be carried out and a certificate of water right issued in evidence of the right established.

Further action on this matter will be withheld for a reasonable period of time pending your reply.

FOR WATER PERMIT FOR IRRIGATION

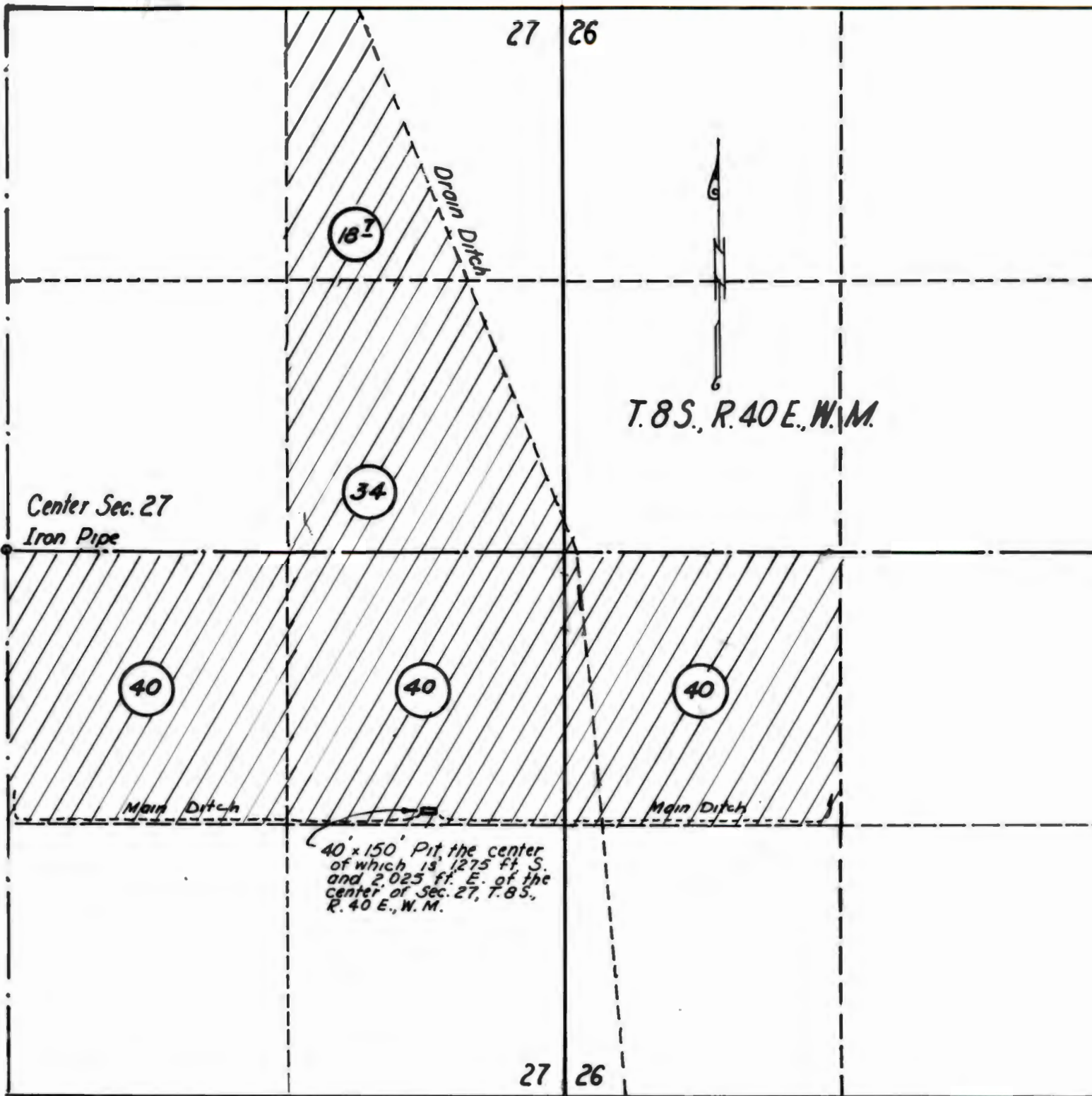

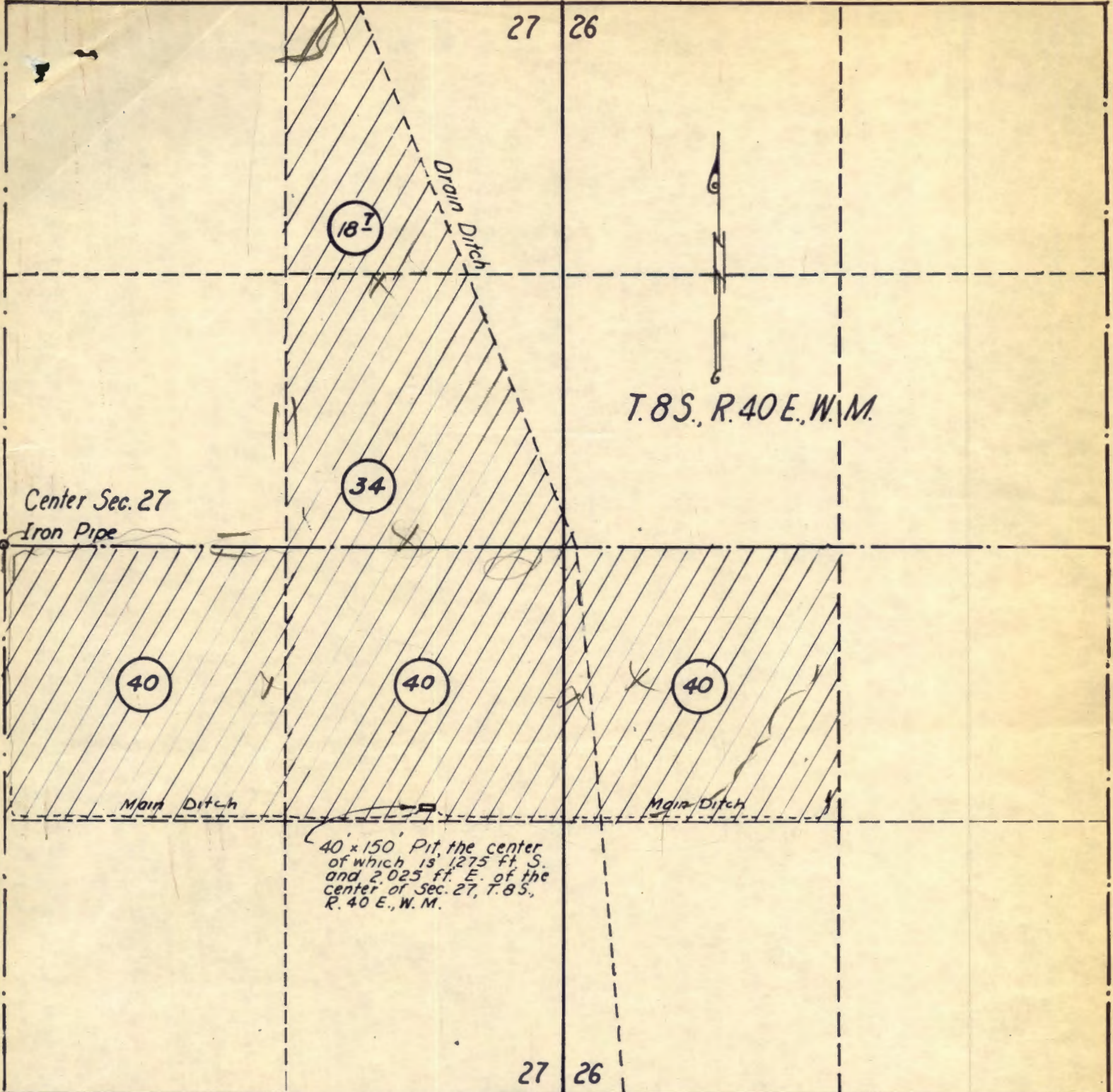
