

Gentlemen:

Permit No. 17946 was confirmed by certificate recorded at page 21448, issued to Henry M. Von Clasen and Richard P. Smith, and locates a diversion point in the NEW SWW. of Section 4. This is a typographical error and should have located the diversion point in the NEW SEW of Section 4. Apparently the abstract of the permit is also in error as it locates the diversion point in the NEW SEW. I will check into this as soon as we have a new watermaster in Roseburg.

The diversion point for this right and for the right described in certificate recorded at page 17821, issued to Associated Plywood Mills, Inc., is identical. At the time of proof Mr. Von Clasen and Mr. Smith had a 1¼" pipeline tapped into Associated Plywood Mills' 6" line.

I am enclosing a final proof survey map made in connection with both permits. The one also shows the diversion and use under application No. 20719, which has no bearing on this.

Neither of the two rights describe Little River at the source, but rather an unnamed creek which is a tributary of Little River. If either group has changed the location of the diversion point, they should obtain approval of the State Engineer for the change in point of diversion by making proper application to this office.

I see no particular reason for the hearing concerning the determination of the relative rights to the use of water. Assuming both rights are valid and presently used for the purposes described, the distribution would be on the basis of priority date. Certificate 17281 bears a priority date of April 14, 1944 and certificate 21448 bears a priority date of August 26, 1947.

If there is not sufficient water in the stream to satisfy the demand under and within the terms of certificate 17281, then Mr. Von Clasen and Mr. Smith or their successors would have to curtail their use. Little River Christian Camp could not demand water for any greater use than was made by Associated Plywood Mills by October 1, 1947.

January 12, 1966 Kelley, Garrison & Lasswell -2-If there was sufficient water in the stream and the various users were sharing a common pipeline, the jurisdiction for distribution of water by the State Engineer would end when the diversion was made from the natural water course. A dispute over a division of water after entering the pipe at the diversion point would be up to the parties involved to solve. There is no statutory provision for reissuing a certificate to show subsequent owners of a property or an assignment of an evidenced right, as a completed right is appurtenant to the land described and travels with that land at time of sale.
