This Permit to store waters is issued approving Reservoir Application R-69872. The date of priority is APRIL 14, 1989 FOR 560.0 ACRE-FEET AND AUGUST 24, 1989 FOR 255.8 ACRE-FEET. The amount of water entitled to be stored each year is not more than 815.8 ACRE-FEET.

The dam will be located as follows:

The area submerged by the reservoir, when full, will be 128.6 acres and the maximum depth of water will be 14.0 feet.

This project was considered and approved by the Water Resources Commission on March 30, 1990.

The permit is subject to the following conditions:

1. The structure shall be constructed, operated and maintained in accordance with the approved plans and specifications and with the design intent.
2. The repairs to the structure shall be constructed under the supervision of a registered engineer licensed in Oregon. No water shall be stored until this department receives written certification from the engineer that construction has been completed in accordance with the approved plans and specifications, and written authorization for storage is received from this department.
3. The outlet gate shall be cycled at least once each year in order to assure smooth operation.
4. The embankment and spillway channel shall be kept clear of trees and brush and other debris.
5. The embankment shall be kept free of burrowing animals.

The storage of water allowed herein is subject to the installation and maintenance of an outlet pipe, or the provision of other means to evacuate water when determined necessary by the Water Resources Director to satisfy prior downstream rights.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before APRIL 30, 1991, and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1992. The reservoir shall be filled, and complete application of the stored water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 1993.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this permit may result in action including, but not limited to restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the permit.

The permit is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The storage of water allowed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.

#### Appeal Rights

**This is a final order in other than a contested case.** This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. A request for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080 you may either file for judicial review, or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

#### Application History

Permit R-11221 was issued by the Department on April 30, 1990. The permit called for actual construction to begin by April 30, 1991, completion of construction by October 1, 1992 and complete application of water to beneficial use by October 1, 1993. On November 3, 2014,

Richard Morgan submitted to the Department an Application for Extension of Time for Permit R-11221. In accordance with OAR 690-315-0050(2), on December 16, 2014, the Department issued a Proposed Final Order proposing to extend the time to complete construction from October 1, 1993 to October 30, 2015 and the time to apply water to full beneficial use from October 1, 1993 to October 30, 2015. The protest period closed January 30, 2015, in accordance with OAR 690-315-0060(1). No protest was filed.

### **FINDINGS OF FACT**

The Department adopts and incorporates by reference the findings in the Proposed Final Order dated December 16, 2014.

At time of issuance of the Proposed Final Order the Department concluded that, based on the factors demonstrated by the applicant, the permit may be extended subject to the following conditions:

### **CONDITIONS**

1. **Last Extension Condition**

This is to be the last extension of time granted for Permit R-11221. Any future extensions of time requests will be denied.

### **CONCLUSION OF LAW**


The applicant has demonstrated good cause for the permit extension pursuant to ORS 537.230, 539.010(5) and OAR 690-315-0040(2).

*In summary, the Department proposes to:*

- Grant an extension of time to complete construction of the water system from October 1, 1993 to October 30, 2015.
- Grant an extension of time to apply water to full beneficial use from October 1, 1993 to October 30, 2015.<sup>1</sup>
- Make the extension subject to certain conditions set forth below.

This Extension of Time request is being processed in accordance with Oregon Revised Statute 537.230 and 539.010(5), and Oregon Administrative Rule Chapter 690, Division 315

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<sup>1</sup> Pursuant to ORS 537.230(4), upon the completion of beneficial use of water allowed under the permit, the permit holder shall hire a certified water rights examiner to survey the appropriation. Within one year after the complete application of water to a beneficial use (or by the date allowed for the complete application of water to a beneficial use), the permit holder shall submit a map of the survey and the claim of beneficial use.

### AUTHORITY

Generally, see ORS 537.230 and OAR Chapter 690 Division 315.

**ORS 537.230(3)** provides in pertinent part that the Oregon Water Resources Department (Department) may, for good cause shown, order an extension of time within which irrigation or other works shall be completed or the right perfected. In determining the extension, the Department shall give due weight to the considerations described under ORS 539.010(5) and to whether other governmental requirements relating to the project have significantly delayed completion of construction or perfection of the right.

**ORS 539.010(5)** provides in pertinent part that the Water Resources Director, for good cause shown, may extend the time within which the full amount of the water appropriated shall be applied to a beneficial use. This statute instructs the Director to consider: the cost of the appropriation and application of the water to a beneficial purpose; the good faith of the appropriator; the market for water or power to be supplied; the present demands therefore; and the income or use that may be required to provide fair and reasonable returns upon the investment.

**OAR 690-315-0040** provides in pertinent part that the Water Resources Department shall make findings to determine if an extension of time may be approved to complete construction and/or apply water to full beneficial use.

**OAR 690-315-0050(5)** states that extension orders may include, but are not limited to, any condition or provision needed to: ensure future diligence; mitigate the effects of the subsequent development on competing demands on the resource; and periodically document the continued need for the permit.

### **FINDINGS OF FACT**

#### Background

1. Permit R-11221 was granted by the Department on April 30, 1990. The permit authorizes the storage up to 815.80 AF of water in South Arm Reservoir from Hay Creek, a tributary of Drews Creek, to be appropriated under Permit S-50968 for irrigation. The permit specified actual construction was to begin by April 30, 1991, construction of the water system was to be completed by October 1, 1992, and complete application of water was to be made on or before October 1, 1993.

2. One prior permit extension has been granted for Permit R-11221. The most recent extension resulted in the completion dates for construction being extended to October 1, 1993.
3. The permit holder submitted an "Application for Extension of Time" to the Department on November 3, 2014, requesting the time to complete construction of the water system extended from October 1, 1993 to October 30, 2015 and the time to apply water to full beneficial use under the terms of Permit R-11221 be extended from October 1, 1993 to October 30, 2015.
4. Notification of the Application for Extension of Time for Permit R-11221 was published in the Department's Public Notice dated November 11, 2014. No public comments were received regarding the extension application.

Review Criteria [OAR 690-315-0040]

*The time limits to complete construction and/or apply water to full beneficial use may be extended if the Department finds that the permit holder has met the requirements set forth under OAR 690-315-0040. This determination shall consider the applicable requirements of ORS 537.230<sup>2</sup>, 537.248<sup>3</sup> and/or 539.010(5)<sup>4</sup>.*

Complete Extension of Time Application [OAR 690-315-0040(1)(a)]

5. On November 3, 2014, the Department received a completed Application for Extension of Time and the fee specified in ORS 536.050 from the permit holder.

Start of Construction [OAR 690-315-0040(1)(b) and 690-315-0040(5)]

6. Actual construction of the water system began prior to the April 30, 1991 deadline specified in the permit.

Duration of Extension [OAR 690-315-0040(1)(c)]

*Under OAR 690-315-0040(1)(c), in order to approve an extension of time for water use permits the Department must find that the time requested is reasonable and the applicant can complete the project within the time requested.*

7. As of November 3, 2014, the remaining work to be completed consists of obtaining written certification from the engineer that construction has been completed in accordance with the approved plans and specification, and written authorization for storage of water from the Department; completing construction of the water system and applying water to full beneficial use.
8. Given the amount of development left to occur, the Department has determined that the permit holder's request to have until October 30, 2015, to complete construction of the water system and to accomplish the application of water to beneficial use under the terms and conditions of Permit R-11221 is both reasonable and necessary.

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<sup>2</sup>ORS 537.230 applies to surface water permits only.

<sup>3</sup>ORS 537.248 applies to reservoir permits only.

<sup>4</sup>ORS 539.010(5) applies to surface water and ground water permits.

Good Cause [OAR 690-315-0040(1)(d)]

*The Department's determination of good cause shall consider the requirements set forth under OAR 690-315-0040(2).*

Reasonable Diligence of the Appropriator [OAR 690-315-0040(2)(a)]

*The Department's determination of reasonable diligence shall consider the requirements set forth under OAR 690-315-0040(3)(a-d). In accordance with OAR 690-315-0040(3), the Department shall consider, but is not limited to, the following factors when determining whether the applicant has demonstrated reasonable diligence in previous performance under the permit:*

Amount of Construction [OAR 690-315-0040(3)(a)]

9. Work was accomplished within the time allowed in the permit or previous extension as follows:
  - a. Construction of the water system began prior to the April 30, 1991 deadline specified in the permit. Dam spillway improvements were completed to the existing dam and spillway April 30, 1990.
  - b. No work was completed during the original development time frame under Permit R-11221, as most work was completed before Permit issuance.

Beneficial Use of Water [OAR 690-315-0040(3)(b)]

10. The following beneficial use was made of the water during the permit or previous extension time limits:
  - a. Since the issuance of Permit R-11221 on April 30, 1990, the permit holder has stored 815.8 AF of water diverted from the Hay Creek, a tributary of Drews Creek for irrigation on 197 acres.
  - b. Delay of full beneficial use of water under Permit R-11221 was due, in part, to the permit holder failing to obtain written certification from an engineer that construction has been completed in accordance with the approved plans and specification, and written authorization for storage from the Department.

Compliance with Conditions [OAR 690-315-0040(3)(c)]

11. The water right permit holder's conformance with the permit or previous extension conditions.
  - a. The Department has considered the permit holder's compliance with conditions, and has identified the following concerns: (1) the permit holder has not yet obtained written certification from an engineer that construction has been completed in accordance with the approved plans and specification, and (2) the permit holder has not yet obtained written authorization for storage from the Department.

- b. Failure to comply with permit conditions constitutes illegal storage of water. In order to legally perfect the storage of water under this permit, the permit holder must demonstrate that all conditions of the permit have been satisfied.

Financial Investments to appropriate and Apply Water to a Beneficial Purpose [OAR 690-315-0040(2)(b),(3)(d),(4)(d)]

12. As of November 3, 2014, the permit holder has invested approximately \$15,000, which is about 88 percent of the total projected cost for complete development of this project. The permit holder anticipates an additional \$2,000 investment is needed for the completion of this project.

Good Faith of the Appropriator [OAR 690-315-0040(2)(c)]

13. The Department has found good faith of the appropriator under Permit R-11221.

The Market and Present Demands for Water [OAR 690-315-0040(2)(d-e)]

*The Department's determinations of market and present demand for water or power to be supplied shall consider the requirements set forth under OAR 690-315-0040(4)(a-f). In accordance with OAR 690-315-0040(4), the Department shall consider, but is not limited to, the following factors when determining the market and the present demand for water or power to be supplied:*

14. The amount of water available to satisfy other affected water rights and scenic waterway flows; special water use designations established since permit issuance, including but not limited to state scenic waterways, federal wild and scenic rivers, serious water management problem areas or water quality limited sources established under 33 U.S.C. 1313(d); or the habitat needs of sensitive, threatened or endangered species, in consultation with the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife [OAR 690-315-0040(4)(a-c)].
  - a. The amount of water available to satisfy other affected water rights and scenic waterway flows was determined at the time of issuance of Permit R-11221; furthermore, water availability for other affected water rights and scenic waterway flows after the permit was issued is determined when an application for a new water right is submitted. The point of diversion is located on Hay Creek, a tributary of Drews Creek, and is not located within a Withdrawn Area. Hay Creek, a tributary of Drews Creek is not located within or above a state or federal scenic waterway, however, it is located within an area ranked "moderate" for stream flow restoration needs as determined by the Department in consultation with the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife, and is located within a Sensitive, Threatened or Endangered Fish Species Area as identified by the Department in consultation with Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife. The point of diversion is not in a location listed by the Department of Environmental Quality as a water quality limited stream.

15. Other economic interests dependent on completion of the project [OAR 690-315-0040(4)(e)].
  - a. None have been identified.
16. Other factors relevant to the determination of the market and present demand for water and power [OAR 690-315-0040(4)(f)].
  - a. None have been identified.
17. OAR 690-315-0050(5) provides for extension orders to include, but are not limited to, any condition or provision needed to ensure future diligence, and/or mitigate the effects of the subsequent development on competing demands on the resource. The Department determined the need to place a "Last Extension Condition" on this extension of time in order to ensure diligence is exercised in the development and perfection of the water use permit. This condition, specified under Item 1 of the "Conditions" section of this PFO, was determined to be necessary due to no additional work having been accomplished since October 1, 1993

Fair Return Upon Investment [OAR 690-315-0040(2)(f)]

18. Use and income from the permitted water development will likely result in reasonable returns upon the investment made to date.

Other Governmental Requirements [OAR 690-315-0040(2)(g)]

19. Delay in the development of this project was not caused by any other governmental requirements.

Unforeseen Events [OAR 690-315-0040(2)(h)]

20. None have been identified.

## CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The applicant is entitled to apply for an extension of time to complete construction and/or completely apply water to the full beneficial use pursuant to ORS 537.230(3).
2. The applicant has submitted a complete extension application form and the fee specified in ORS 536.050, as required by OAR 690-315-0040(1)(a).
3. The applicant complied with begin actual construction timeline requirements pursuant to ORS 537.230 as required by OAR 690-315-0040(1)(b) and OAR 690-315-0040(5).
4. Completion of construction and full application of water to beneficial use can be accomplished by October 30, 2015<sup>5</sup>, as required by OAR 690-315-0040(1)(c).

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<sup>5</sup>Pursuant to ORS 537.230(3), upon the completion of beneficial use of water allowed under the permit, the permittee shall hire a certified water rights examiner to survey the appropriation. Within one year after the

5. The Department has considered the reasonable diligence and good faith of the appropriator, the cost to appropriate and apply water to a beneficial purpose, the market and present demands for water to be supplied, the financial investment made and fair and reasonable return upon the investment, the requirements of other governmental agencies, and unforeseen events over which the permit holder had no control, whether denial of the extension will result in undue hardship to the applicant and whether there are no other reasonable alternatives for meeting water use needs, any other factors relevant to a determination of good cause, and has determined that the applicant has shown that good cause exists for an extension of time to apply water to full beneficial use pursuant to OAR 690-315-0040(1)(d).
6. As authorized in OAR 690-315-0050(5) and as described in Finding 17, above, the Department has established, as specified in the "Conditions" section of this PFO (Item 1), a "Last Extension Condition" in order to ensure future diligence is exercised in the development and perfection of Permit R-11221.



### Proposed Final Order Hearing Rights

1. Under the provisions of OAR 690-315-0100(1) and 690-315-0060, the applicant or any other person adversely affected or aggrieved by the proposed final order may submit a written protest to the proposed final order. **Findings of Fact**

1. Application R-69872, in the name of Edward L Garrett, was received April 14, 1989. Permit R-11221 was issued April 30, 1990, approving the application. The permit was subsequently assigned to Mildred Garrett 1992 Living Trust.
2. Permit R-11221 allowed the storage of water from Hay Creek in South Arm Reservoir. The extended date for the complete application of water was set for October 1, 1993.
3. The Department received a Claim of Beneficial Use on August 12, 1994.
4. The permit contains a condition which reads, "No water shall be stored until this department receives written certification from the engineer that construction has been completed in accordance with the approved plans and specifications, and written authorization for storage is received from this department."
5. The Department's records do not contain either written certification from the engineer that construction has been completed in accordance with the approved plans and specifications, or any written authorization for storage by the department.

**Conclusions of Law**

Satisfactory proof of beneficial use was not received. The use allowed by Permit R-11221 is lost. The permit should be cancelled.

Under the provisions of OAR 690-320-0020, when it appears from an onsite examination by the Water Resources Department that no appropriation has been made under the terms of the permit, or that use once made has undergone a period of five successive years of nonuse, a certified letter of intent to cancel the permit shall be sent to the permittee, allowing 60 days from the date of the

Consideration for Approval of Applications R-69872 and 69868 to Store and Use Water from Hay Creek, Tributary to Drews Creek for Irrigation, Edward L. Garrett, Lake County.

Background:

On April 10 and April 14, 1989, Edward L. Garrett submitted Applications R-69872 (Attachment 1) and 69868 (Attachment 2) respectively. Application R-69872 proposes to store up to 815.8 acre-feet of water from Hay Creek behind an existing dam that is 19.2 feet high. Application 69868 proposes to use up to 4.93 cfs from direct flow and storage for irrigation on 45.1 acres of primary lands and on 151.9 acres of supplemental lands. The project is located near Lakeview (Attachment 3).

The question before the Commission is whether the issuance of a permit for up to 815.8 acre-feet of storage would have a significant adverse effect on the public interest. Administrative Rule 690-11-080 (2)(a)(C) specifies that appropriations for greater than 9.2 acre-feet of storage be referred to the Commission to make a public interest determination under ORS 537.170.

Evaluation:

The South Arm Reservoir (Attachment 4) is an earth-fill dam that is about 40 to 45 years old. The drainage area for the watershed is about 5.2 square miles, but most of the water entering the reservoir is from springs. The applicant intends to irrigate lands that are not covered by the Goose Lake Decree. Lands covered by the Goose Lake Decree will get supplemental water for irrigation.

The Dam Safety Section reviewed and approved the plans with conditions. Those conditions are listed in the draft permit (Attachment 5).

Notice of this application was provided to the public. The Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife reviewed the project and submitted a "no comment" response. The Fremont National Forest indicated that the applicant will receive a special use permit.

Water is available in this reach to meet the demand during this time period and the use of water should not pose a problem. The applicant will be required to bypass water to meet the demands of downstream rights and provide adequate controlling devices for the watermaster to distribute on Hay Creek.

The Goose and Summer Lakes Basin Program adopted in August 1988 requires consideration of the following items for reservoir construction:

- 1) alternative sizing of the project to achieve a reasonable economic development of the proposed site;
- 2) the potential for use of the reservoir and any water which is stored and released for multiple beneficial uses; and
- 3) the maintenance of natural flows downstream from the reservoir at levels sufficient to meet instream and out-of-stream needs.

These issues were considered by the applicant and reviewed by staff. Since the reservoir was previously constructed, those matters could not be answered as readily as for a new reservoir. Alternative sizing was not a major determination because the reservoir was built and the applicant is filing on a previously constructed reservoir. Multiple use was considered, but the reservoir is too small for a major recreational site. The reservoir provides for some fishing and wildlife habitat.

Water is stored for irrigation. Reservoir releases are for irrigation and to meet downstream demand. Water released enters Drews Reservoir and is used by the Lakeview Water Users.

Staff does not believe that this proposal would have a significant adverse effect on the public interest or have an adverse impact on the water resources in the basin. Storage would be subject to downstream storage rights with senior priorities.

Alternatives:

1. Find that the proposed use of water may have a significant adverse effect on the public interest, and schedule a hearing to assist the Commission in making its determination.
2. Find that the proposed use of water would not have a significant adverse effect on the public interest, and authorize the Director to issue the permit with the appropriate conditions.

Summation:

The proposed use of water is from an existing reservoir. The applicant would store up to 815.8 acre-feet of water for irrigation. Water is available. The use of water should not have a significant adverse effect on the water resources in the basin.

Director's Recommendation:

The staff recommends Alternative 2, that the Commission find that the use of water would not have a significant adverse effect on the public interest and authorize the Director to issue the permit.

Attachments:

The plans and reports you submitted last month to support Edward L. Garrett's Applications R-69872 and 69868 have been reviewed.

Before the applications can be considered for approval, it will be necessary to make certain amendments to the applications, submit additional supporting documents and additional fees will be needed. The applications will also need to be placed on an agenda to be reviewed by the Water Resources Commission.

Since the dam for the reservoir is located downstream from the South Arm Spring, the source for filling the reservoir needs to be identified as the stream in Item 1 of the Reservoir Application rather than the spring. If the stream is known as Hay Creek in the vicinity of the dam, "Hay Creek a tributary of Drews Creek " needs to be noted as the source.

Unless the runoff water mentioned in Item 2 of the Reservoir Application is conveyed to the reservoir via man-made facilities, the statement: "Runoff water also contributes" needs to be deleted from Item 2. A permit issued for the storage of water from the stream (Hay Creek) would provide for the storage of waters naturally flowing into the reservoir area above the dam site.

The balance of the items on the Reservoir Application will need to be properly completed or amended and be in agreement with the plans submitted. We will also need a sepia print of the plans.

If there will be water available in the stream during the irrigation season for irrigation of lands listed under primary irrigation, the stream (Hay Creek) could be included in Item 1 of the Secondary Application 69868 as a source of water for the lands to receive the primary supply. Item 1 will then need to be further completed by noting that the sources are tributaries to Drews Creek.

Since the reservoir area is under three ownerships, it will be necessary to show by documentary evidence that an agreement has been entered into with the owners of the reservoir for a permanent and sufficient interest in the reservoir to impound enough water for the purpose set forth in the Secondary Application 69868. This is as required by law (ORS 537.400).

The Goose and Summer Lakes Basin Program adopted in August of 1988, by the Water Resources Commission requires that any person proposing the development of a reservoir in the area involved shall give due consideration to:

- A) alternative sizing of the project to achieve a reasonable economic development of the proposed site;
- B) the potential for use of the reservoir, and any water which is stored and released, for multiple beneficial uses; and
- C) the maintenance of natural flows downstream from the reservoir at levels sufficient to meet instream and out-of-stream needs.

Evidence that the aforementioned three matters have been considered will need to be submitted.

In addition to the \$200 Examination fees presently credited to each file, each application will require Permit Recording fees. The Reservoir Application based upon the 815.8 acre-feet to be stored as noted on the plans will need Permit Recording fees in the amount of \$291.50. The Secondary based upon the 197.0 acres to be irrigated will need Permit Recording fees in the amount of \$474. Therefore, an additional \$765.50 will be needed. However, we will not need these additional fees until the after the applications are in satisfactory form and have been reviewed by the Water Resources Commission.

I am returning both of the applications to you for correction and completion. The applications are endorsed so that in order to retain their priority dates, they must be received in this office on or before November 6, 1989.

We received the Reservoir Application you submitted for Edward L. Garrett on April 14, 1989, describing the construction of South Arm Reservoir and proposed storage of 560.0 acre-feet of water from South Arm Spring for irrigation.

We also received the secondary application you submitted for Edward L. Garrett on April 10, 1989, describing the proposed use of 4.93 cubic feet per second of water from South Arm Reservoir for irrigation of 45.1 acres and supplemental irrigation of 151.9 acres.

Supporting data, map and fees were also received. Our Receipts-57702 and 57666 are enclosed. The applications have been filed, assigned numbers R-69872 and 69868 and will be reviewed in detail as time allows.

The applicant will be required to hire a Certified Water Right Examiner to survey the extent of use of water perfected under the terms of the permits that may be issued approving the applications. Within one year of application of water to beneficial use or the date to make complete application of water allowed in your permits, he will need to submit a map of the survey prepared by the Certified Water Right Examiner.






