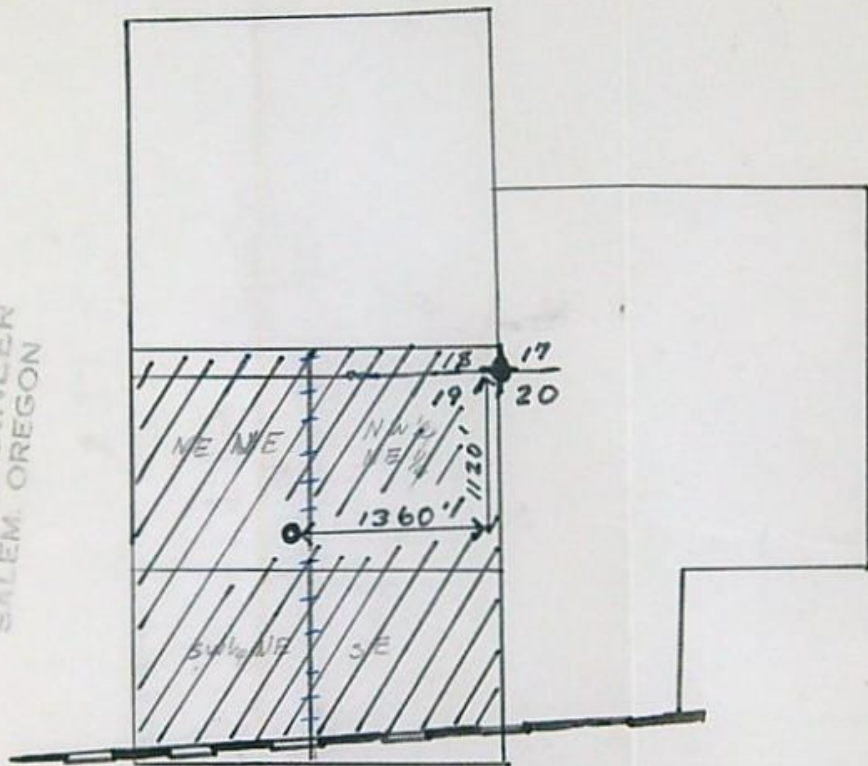

Dear Mr. and Mrs. Iverson:

We have recently received your application for a permit to appropriate 1,200 gallons of water per minute from a well for the irrigation of 160.2 acres and a reproducible map. This will also acknowledge the fees of \$33.55 for which our receipt numbered 33026 is enclosed. The application has been filed and numbered G-6047.

Our records show that permit numbered 11656 has been issued to the Silver Lake Irrigation District for the use of water from Silver Creek and East Thompson Valley Reservoir for irrigation. The lands listed on your application are included under the District's permit. If you do not intend to use water from Silver Creek or the East Thompson Valley Reservoir, it will be necessary for you to make a statement to this effect on the application.

On the other hand, if water from the well will be used to supplement water from the District's permit, it will be necessary to amend your application by listing "supplemental irrigation" and identify the existing water right under item 18 of the application.

Your map will have to be accurately drawn to an even foot scale.

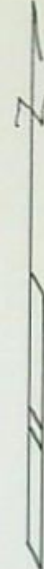
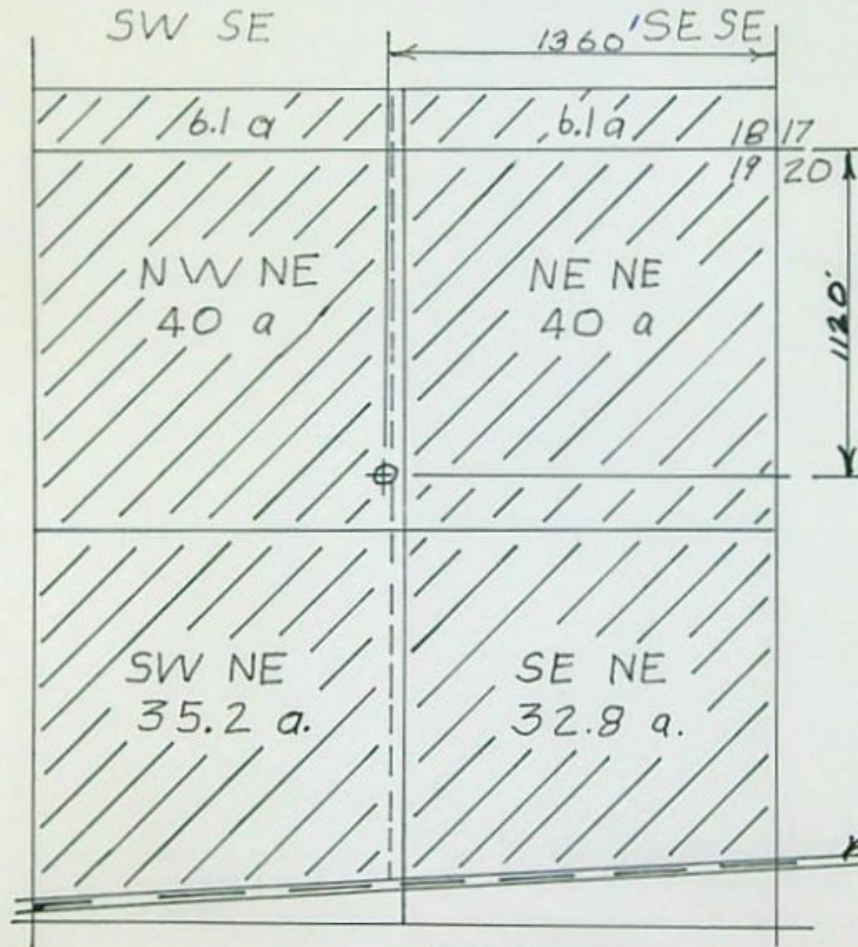
