## NOTICE OF CERTIFICATE ISSUANCE

Attached is a certificate that confirms the water right established under the terms of a permit issued by this department. The water right is now appurtenant to the specific place where the use was established as described by the certificate. The owner of the land is the owner of the water right. The water right is limited to a specific amount of water, but not more than can be beneficially used for the purposes stated within the certificate.

This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within **60 days of the mailing date stated above** as specified by ORS 183.484(2).

This statement of judicial review rights is required under ORS 536.075; it does not alter or add to existing review rights or create review rights that are not otherwise provided by law.

Under ORS 537.260 and 537.270, a water right certificate may be contested before the Water Resources Department within three (3) months of the date it is issued. If a certificate is contested, the contestant shall be offered an administrative hearing.

Oregon law does not allow the Director to reissue a certificate because of a change in the ownership. The water must be controlled and not wasted. To change the location of the point of diversion, the character of use, or the location of use requires the advance approval of the Water Resources Director.

If any portion of this water right is not used for five or more consecutive years, that portion of the right may be subject to forfeiture according to ORS 540.610. Land enrolled in a Federal Reserve Program is not subject to forfeiture during the period of enrollment. Other exceptions to forfeiture are explained in ORS 540.610.



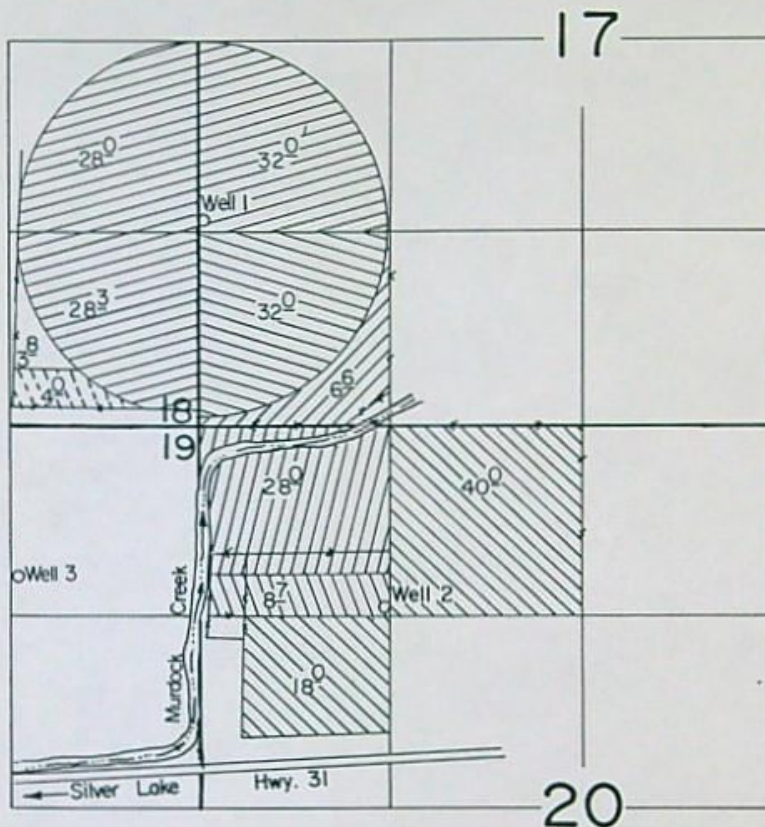

The survey found a total of 7.8 acres claimed irrigated in connection with Permit No. G-10330 which exceeds the limit of 4.0 acres under the permit. The 3.8 acres overacreage is displayed on the map copy, if you intend to establish a legal water right for the additional 3.8 acres, you will need to determine the permitting requirements for your area.

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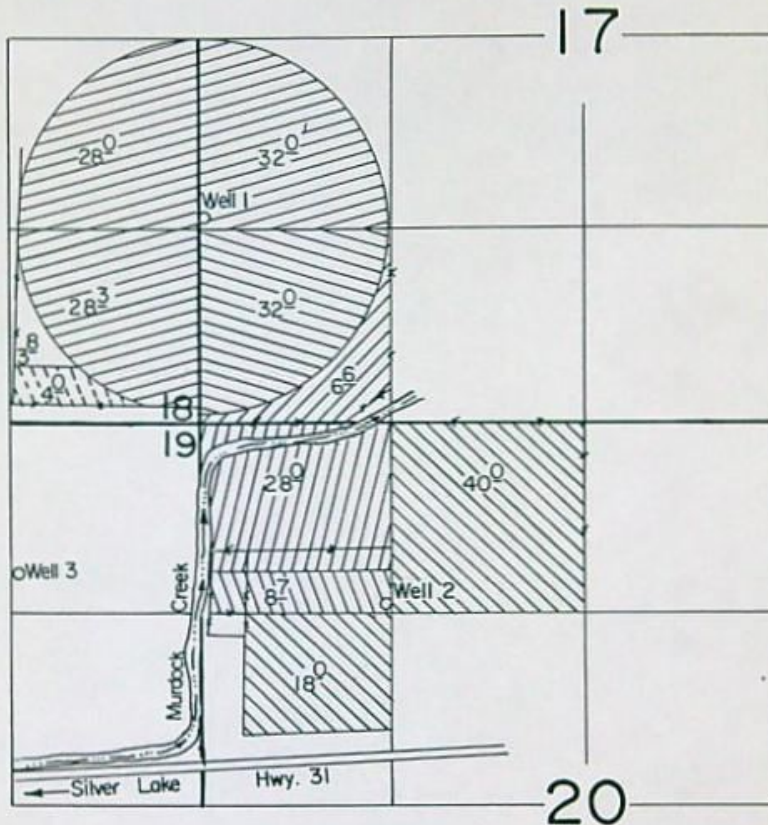

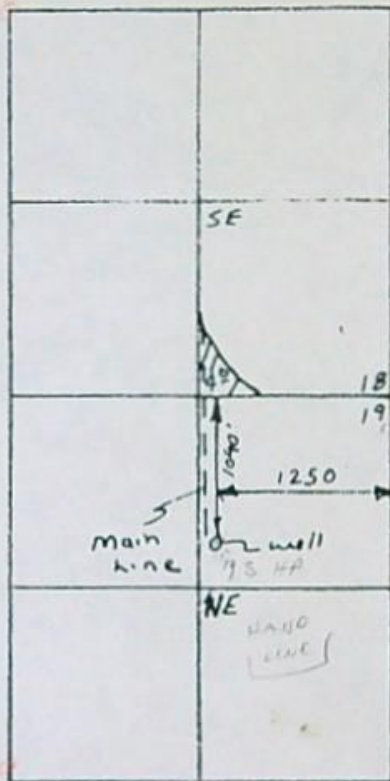

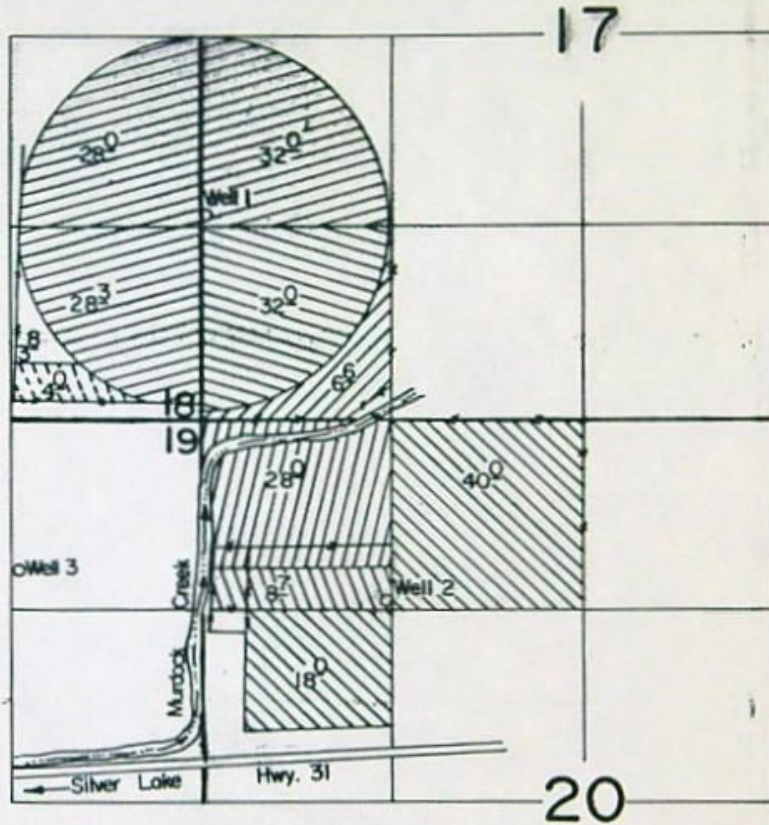

REFERENCE: File G-11196

Your Application G-11196 describing the proposed use of 0.05 cubic foot per second of water from one well for the irrigation of 4.0 acres, together with the map, has been reviewed.

The Water Resources Department has information that the water table in your area appears to be declining in response to current pumping withdrawals. Current annual pumping appears to be approximately equal to ground water recharge in the basin.

If in fact the ground water levels are declining or the available ground water supply in the area in question is being or is about to be overdrawn, the Water Resources Director will be required to protect the ground water resource from overappropriation.

This would be accomplished by prohibiting further drilling of wells in the affected ground water reservoir and, if necessary, controlling or shutting off the use of water from existing wells, based on priority date, until a stable ground water level is established.

A permit issued in approval of your application would in no manner guarantee the availability of ground water and would, of course, add to the total pumping withdrawals already legally taking place in the basin. You are cautioned that in the future the use of water under such permit may be restricted or terminated by order of the Water Resources Director.

We have received your application for use of water for irrigation along with supporting data and fees. Our Receipt 39572 is enclosed. Your application has been filed and assigned number G-11196.

Applications which are received in proper form for a permit, including maps, supporting data and fees, will receive a permit shortly after the mandatory 30-day waiting period. Applications which are defective, conflict with existing rights or require additional information will be reviewed in detail and will be returned for completion or correction within 45 days.

If your application is approved, the permit authorizing the project described in the application would be subject to prior rights and require that the well be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The permit would also require that a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device be installed, if required by the Watermaster, and a log be kept recording the amount of ground water withdrawals. If you have any questions regarding these provisions or the Well Standards, please contact this office.

If you wish to resubmit the application, it will receive a tentative date of priority as of the date it is received in this office with the statutory filing fees.

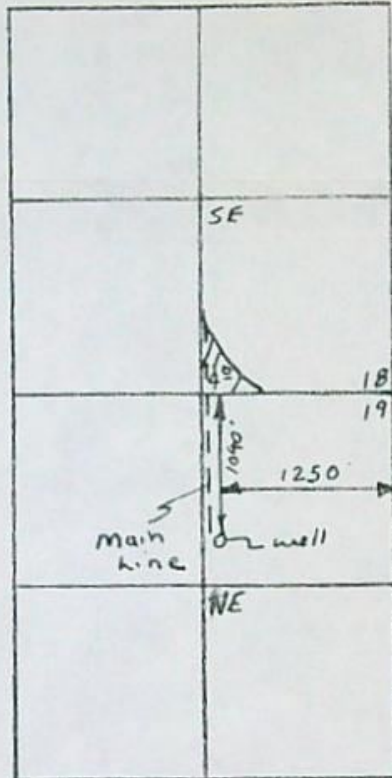
