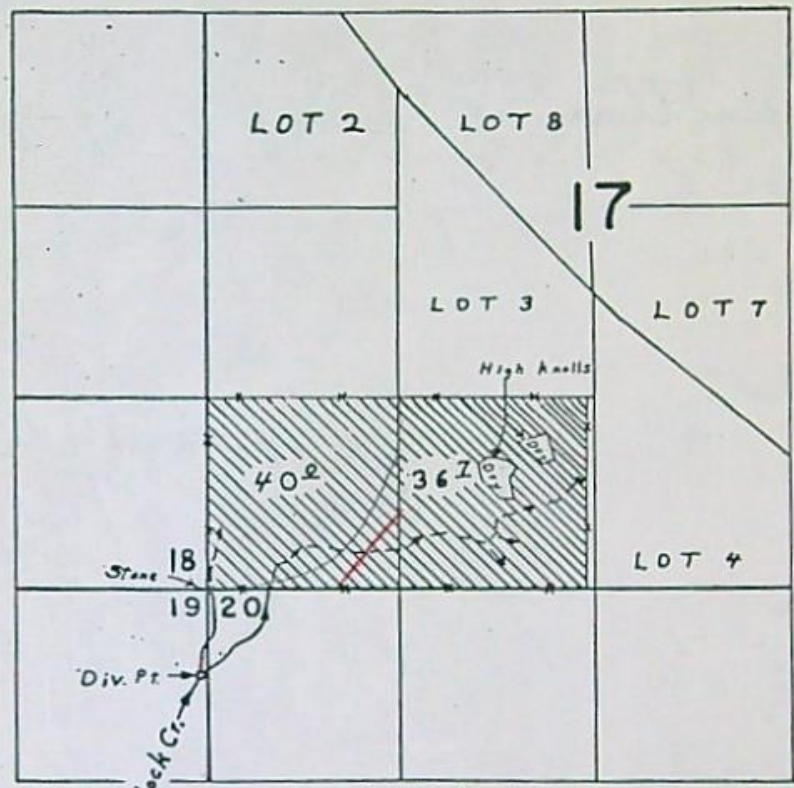

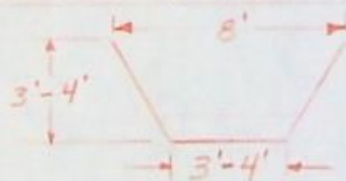

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 62259 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Lawrence and Marjorie Iverson of PO Box 97, Silver Lake, Oregon 97638, phone 576-2217, for the use of the waters of Murdock Creek, a tributary of Silver Lake, for the PURPOSE of supplemental irrigation. The use allowed herein may be made anytime between October 1 and March 31 that water can be put to beneficial use by irrigation, either for immediate crop growth or for forecast requirements to raise the soil moisture to field capacity in the soil profile to be utilized by plant growth in the subsequent growing season; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from August 13, 1981, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 1.92 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 580 feet South and 40 feet West from the Southwest Corner of Section 17, being within the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 19, Township 28 South, Range 15 East, WM, in the County of Lake.

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 1/40 of one cubic foot per second per acre, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 1.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the period from October 1 to March 31, provided further that the right allowed herein, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same land shall not exceed 3.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated in any one year. The use of water authorized herein shall not establish priority of right as against future appropriations of surface water for beneficial uses or for storage for such beneficial uses, other than similar rights for irrigation from October 1 to March 31, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 12, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1984.

I am returning application 62259, map, etc for out of season irrigation for 76.7 acres. The reason we are asking for this change is because Mundock Creek is only a wet weather stream & only flow real early on in the middle of winter (like Christmas time) when snow has accumulated on the rock-flats & it rains or melts. We have tall wheat planted in this 76.7 acres & it is clay soil & hold moisture thru to growing starts - We have never seen any water in this channel after April 1 - & no aquatic life at all. This Creek and land is outside the boundaries of the Silver Lake Irrigation Dist - When the Dist was first

organized in 1921 it was - but the
list has been reorganized and lots
of the original land has been with-
drawn

The soil moisture in this type of soil
holds good - Perhaps Mr. Daggert of
your office could give you some
information also, he is real familiar
with the creek and our operation.

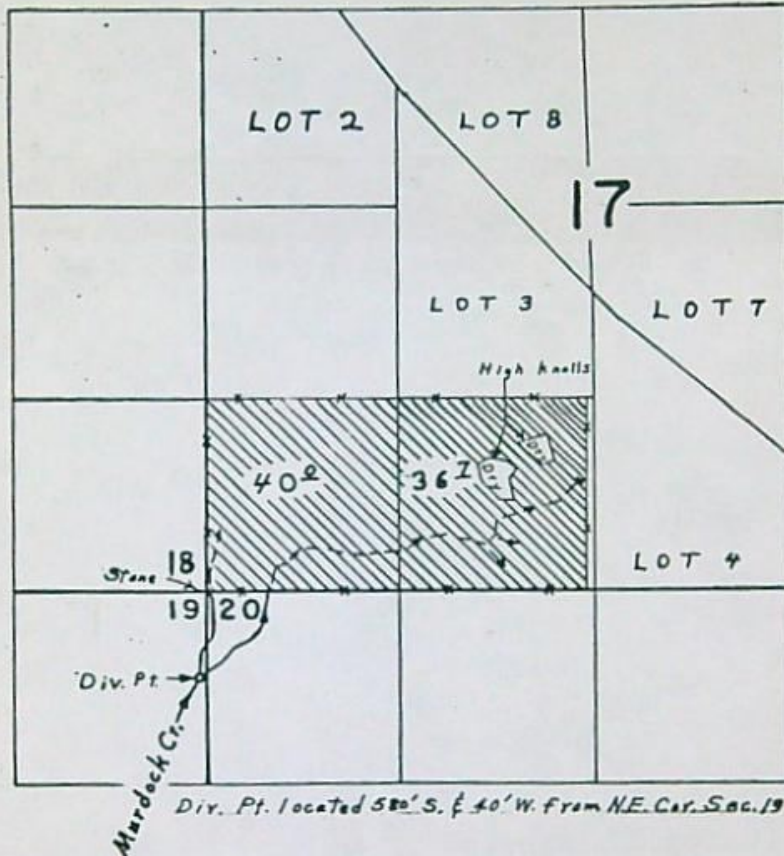
