Enclosed are five Claim of Beneficial Use (COBU) reports prepared for water right permits held by Iseli Nursery, Inc (Iseli). Iseli completed development of the water rights and provided the Department with notice to this effect in the late 1980's; however, to-date the Final Proof Surveys of the water rights not been completed. To facilitate certification of these water rights, we have prepared COBU reports documenting the use of water under these water rights.

The data and information contained in the COBU reports were collected during site inspections of the nursery completed on May 2, 2008 and June 12, 2008. Based on conversations with Iseli, it is my understanding that the water use and water diversion and conveyance system observed and documented during the site inspections accurately reflects what was present at the time notice of complete water use was provided to the Department. In other words, Iseli had the ability to operate the system and use water prior to the C-Date of the permits in the same fashion as demonstrated during the site inspections.

Your Application 65054 describing the proposed use of 5.5 cubic feet per second of water from Tickle Creek for nursery use on 272.1 acres, together with the map, has been reviewed. Enclosed is Receipt 36395 for fees.

In talking with Clif King, Watermaster for your area, he has said that your entire operation will be containerized nursery stock. Since this use of water does not fall in the category of normal irrigation, the recent policy of this office is to consider this use of water as a commercial use. There are no primary or supplemental rights when the use is commercial. Therefore, in Item 3 of the application, please delete primary and supplemental and insert container nursery operation. In Item 5, please state container nursery use.

The diversion point, as shown on the map, measures 800 feet North and 990 feet East from the SW Corner of Section 8. This does not agree with the location as listed in Item 2 of the application. Please amend Item 2 of the application to correctly locate the diversion point.

Your application now has two tentative priority dates; April 28, 1983 for 2.61 cfs and May 11, 1983 for the additional amount of 2.89 cfs.

Please put this statement in Item 6 of the application: "I do not wish to waive my existing rights from the well."
