Landowners can request a Well ID for existing wells that do not have one. The Well ID is intended to serve as a unique identification number for each well.  
 \*\* A well log ID (e.g. MARI 1234) is assigned by the Department to each log in the agency's well log database. A separate well log is required for each subsequent alteration of the well.
