


Dear Mrs. Caspers

The only rights which I am able to find in the name of Louis J. Wilke in Clackenas County are described as follows:

A certificate issued on December 15, 1927 and recorded on Page 7hh3, State Record of Water Rights Certificates, which confirmed the right to the use of not to exceed 0.81 cubic foot per second from Jackson Creek for irrigation of 23 acres in the NET NET; 31 acres in the NET NET and 15 acres in the NET NET, Section 35, Township h South, Range 3 East, W.M., under a date of priority of December 11, 1923;

A certificate of water right issued on November 26, 1930 and recorded on Page 8898, State Record of Water Rights Certificates, which confirmed the right to the use of not to exceed 0.75 cubic-foot per second from Jackson Creek for maintenance of commercial trout ponds in the NW4 NE4 and the NE4 NE4, Section 35, Township & South, Range 3 East, W.M., under a date of priority of May 6, 1927. These rights would be valid unless they had subsequently been abandoned.

Water Rights which are acquired through a State Engineer's permit and certificate or by virtue of their initiation prior to February 2h, 1909, are an appurtenance to the premises upon which the water is applied until the right is abandoned. The right to the use of water, however, is limited to the quantity, place of use and character of use as acquired and set out in the right. The law provides that a period of five years continuous non-use constitutes a loss of such right.

There is no provision whereby you can file for and hold a right without actually making a development and applying the water to beneficial use. Rights to the use of water are in accordance with their relative dates of priority.


You did not submit a copy of the legal description of the property involved; therefore, I am unable to determine whether or not a permit may have been issued for use of water thereon. If no permit was issued, the only way a right could have been acquired was by initiation and use prior to February 2h, 1909.

Mrs. Grear Casper October 28, 1957 Anyone can file a right to the use of the public waters of the state; however, if it is necessary to cross property which the applicant does not own with a ditch or pipeline, he must obtain such right of way from the owner of the land. Dear Sirs:



We purchased some property in Clackamas Co. At the time, we were told that we received water and mineral rights with it.

We would like to check and see if this is correct. If not, we would like to file for them. The water rights should include both springs and creeks.

According to our title insurance, Mr. Louis Wilke, former owner, filed for water rights, December 16, 1927.....Book 1, Pg. 58.

The problem now is that the property was sold by Mr. Wilks to a lumber company who cut off all the marketable timber, then sold the place in two parcels to separate owners. The party on the other part of the place is using water piped from a spring on our place. (Mr. Wilke piped it into their house years ago.) It is not that we object to their using it, but we want to be projected in case we need to use water from this spring sometime, which is very possible because our property down there is very suitable for a building site, which we are going to have to consider soon.

Williyou please let us know whether we have water and mineral rights. If not, how do we file? Can or have the other party filed for water rights to use the water from our spring? If they have not, what kind of aprocedure would we go thru to let them use it until such as time as we would need it? We would appreciate any help you can give us in this matter
