Hi Brandy,

Thanks for your call and interest in the assignment process to change the permit holder of record name from your father, Thomas LeChuga to yourself. You mentioned that your father is deceased, so I've attached a copy of the Request for Assignment by Proof of Ownership Form. You will need to send a separate form for each water right, and there is a \$120 fee for each request.

Requests for assignment by proof of ownership require two items of proof. Proof that you are the current owner of the property described in the permit may include a copy of the deed to the land. For the second item, you may submit a death certificate or copy of an online obituary for proof that current permit holder of record is not able to assign the permit to you. Proof examples for both are listed on the bottom of the request form.

You mentioned that you received a 60-day letter from Jonnine and have already been in touch with a Certified Water Rights Examiner. Please have any CWRE that you are working with contact the Department with an estimated timeline for Claim of Beneficial Use submittal.

Additionally, you requested a copy of this information be sent to your home address below and that our records be updated. I will be in the office on Thursday this week and will send you information and update our records with your address at that time.

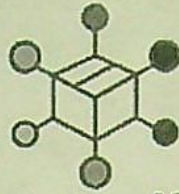

Good afternoon, Brandy,

Thanks for getting into contact with me regarding your Water Rights (S-54118, R-13981).

As discussed, it is time for these water right permits to be "proved up" into water right certificates. To prove up your water rights, you will need to hire a Certified Water Rights Examiner (CWRE) to submit a Claim of Beneficial Use. I have attached a list of CWRE's that service the Grants Pass area.

I have relayed your updated contact information to Salem, and you should be receiving a 60-day notice letter that goes over what you need to do to "prove up" your water right permits into water rights certificates (which we discussed in detail over the phone). I have also attached a "Resource Sheet" that contains information on the process to change the name of a water right permit into your name. This resource sheet also contains other useful information.

This letter is in regard to your water use permit as referenced above. Your permit required you to complete the development of your water use by **October 1, 2008**.

In order for the Department to consider issuance of a certificate of water right, you are required by law to hire a certified water right examiner to prepare and submit a claim of beneficial use that includes a final proof survey map of the development. The map and claim of beneficial use were to have been submitted to our Department within one year of October 1, 2008. The fee for submitting a claim of beneficial use is \$230.00. Please see the enclosed 'Resource Sheet' for our current database of CWRE's.


If you are not finished with the development of your permit, you need to file an application for an extension of time to complete your development. The fee for filing an extension of time is \$780.00. Please see the enclosed 'Resource Sheet' to access the extension of time form.

In the event that you are no longer using water as allowed by this permit, you should cancel it so that we may clear our records. Please see the enclosed 'Resource Sheet' to access the cancellation form, if you are interested in this option.

If you have not submitted either a Claim of Beneficial Use or a request for an extension of time for your permit within 60 days of the date of this letter (August 30, 2024) the Department may issue a Final Order to cancel your permit without further notice. If the Department issues a Final Order to cancel your permit, and you request reconsideration of the final order and reinstatement of your permit, there is a \$610.00 reinstatement fee that is charged in addition to the claim of beneficial use or extension of time fee.

Voluntary Cancellation of a Permit

Whenever the owner of a permit wishes to cancel a permit due to inability to develop the permit or the permit is no longer usable for any reason, the owner may cancel the permit by submitting a form to authorize the cancellation of a permit.

Application for Permit Extension of Time

An Extension of Time is a process in which the Department can approve additional time for a permit holder to perfect the beneficial use of water as authorized by the permit. An Extension of Time may be approved if the permit holder has demonstrated reasonable diligence in developing the beneficial use of water as authorized under the permit and the Department can find good cause to do so. Each Application is reviewed on a case-by-case basis. An Extension of Time may provide the ability for a permit holder to extend their completion of construction date (B-date) and complete application of water date (C-date).

Assignments

An Assignment is a formal process to change the name of the holder of an application, permit, limited license, transfer, permit amendment or groundwater registration claim (i.e., non-perfected, non-certificated rights). This process is similar to changing the name on the title of a car. An Assignment ensures that the Department knows who the water right record belongs to and who will be responsible for finalizing the right.

Self-Certification Form (for qualifying Alternate Review reservoirs only)

Certain qualifying reservoir permits allow the permit holder to self-certify their reservoir permit. For a reservoir permit to qualify for this process, the reservoir must meet each of the following criteria:

- 1) The permit was issued under the authority of ORS 537.409; and
- 2) No secondary permit exists for the use of water stored in the reservoir; and
- 3) The developed capacity of the reservoir is less than 9.2 acre-feet; and
- 4) The water was stored by the date required in the permit

Find a Certified Water Right Examiners (CWRE)

CWREs are engineers, surveyors, and registered geologists who have passed a certification to perform water right related functions including the preparation of Claims of Beneficial Use (COBU). The COBU is both a report that describes the extent to which the use authorized under the permit has been developed and a map that identifies where the use and point of diversion or well is located. In addition, the COBU describes how conditions have been timely complied with.

Measurement, recording and reporting conditions:

- A. Before water use may begin under this permit, the permittee shall install a meter or other suitable measuring device as approved by the Director. The permittee shall maintain the meter or measuring device in good working order.
- B. The permittee shall allow the watermaster access to the meter or measuring device; provided however, where the meter or measuring device is located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

- C. The Director may require the permittee to keep and maintain a record of the amount (volume) of water used and may require the permittee to report water use on a periodic schedule as established by the Director. In addition, the Director may require the permittee to report general water use information, the periods of water use and the place and nature of use of water under the permit. The Director may provide an opportunity for the permittee to submit alternative reporting procedures for review and approval.

STANDARD CONDITIONS

Where two or more water users agree among themselves as to the manner of rotation in the use of water and such agreement is placed in writing and filed by such water users with the watermaster, and such rotation system does not infringe upon such prior rights of any water user not a party to such rotation plan, the watermaster shall distribute the water according to such agreement.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this permit may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the permit.

This permit is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.


The use of water allowed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including prior rights for maintaining instream flows.

The Director finds that the proposed use(s) of water described by this permit, as conditioned, will not impair or be detrimental to the public interest.

Complete application of the water to the use shall be made on or before October 1, 2008. If the water is not completely applied before this date, and the permittee wishes to continue development under the permit, the permittee must submit an application for extension of time, which may be approved based upon the merit of the application.

Within one year after complete application of water to the proposed use, the permittee shall submit a claim of beneficial use, which includes a map and report, prepared by a Certified Water Rights Examiner (CWRE).

REAL ESTATE TRANSACTIONS: Pursuant to ORS 537.330, in any transaction for the conveyance of real estate that includes any portion of the lands described in this permit, the seller of the real estate shall, upon accepting an offer to purchase that real estate, also inform the purchaser in writing whether any permit, transfer approval order, or certificate evidencing the water right is available and that the seller will deliver any permit, transfer approval order or certificate to the purchaser at closing, if the permit, transfer approval order or certificate is available.

CULTURAL RESOURCES PROTECTION LAWS: Permittees involved in ground-disturbing activities should be aware of federal and state cultural resources protection laws. 
On February 19, 2004, THOMAS LE CHUGA submitted an application to the Department for a water use permit. The Department issued a Proposed Final Order on July 6, 2004. The protest period closed August 20, 2004, and no protest was filed.

The proposed use would not impair or be detrimental to the public interest, but the Department's continuing evaluation reveals that the Proposed Final Order requires modification to correctly describe the measurement, recording and reporting conditions.

STANDARD CONDITIONS

Where two or more water users agree among themselves as to the manner of rotation in the use of water and such agreement is placed in writing and filed by such water users with the watermaster, and such rotation system does not infringe upon such prior rights of any water user not a party to such rotation plan, the watermaster shall distribute the water according to such agreement.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this permit may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the permit.

This permit is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

Summary of Recommendation: The Department recommends that the attached draft permit be issued with conditions.

Application History

On February 19, 2004, THOMAS LE CHUGA submitted an application to the Department for the following water use permit:

- Amount of Water: 1.5 ACRE FEET (AF)
- Use of Water: IRRIGATION (TEMPERATURE CONTROL)
- Source of Water: A RESERVOIR, APPLICATION R-85941, A TRIBUTARY OF LATHROP CREEK
- Area of Proposed Use: Josephine County within SECTION 15, TOWNSHIP 36 SOUTH, RANGE 6 WEST, W.M.

On May 21, 2004, the Department mailed the applicant notice of its Initial Review, determining that "The use of 1.5 acre feet from a reservoir, Application R-85941, a tributary of Lathrop Creek for irrigation (temperature control) on 3.0 acres is allowable from February 1 through April 30 of each year, contingent on approval of Application R-85941." The applicant did not notify the Department to stop processing the application within 14 days of that date.

On May 25, 2004, the Department gave public notice of the application in its weekly notice. The public notice included a request for comments, and information for interested persons about both obtaining future notices and a copy of the proposed final order.

No written comments were received within 30 days.

In reviewing applications, the Department may consider any relevant sources of information, including the following:

- comments by or consultation with another state agency
- any applicable basin program
- any applicable comprehensive plan or zoning ordinance
- the amount of water available
- the rate and duty for the proposed use
- pending senior applications and existing water rights of record
- the Scenic Waterway requirements of ORS 390.835
- applicable statutes, administrative rules, and case law
- any comments received

Findings of Fact

The Rogue Basin Program allows the use of water for IRRIGATION (TEMPERATURE CONTROL).

Senior water rights exist on A RESERVOIR, APPLICATION R-85941, A TRIBUTARY OF LATHROP CREEK, or on downstream waters.

A RESERVOIR, APPLICATION R-85941, A TRIBUTARY OF LATHROP CREEK is above the Rogue River State Scenic Waterway.

Water is determined to be available for further appropriation from water legally stored under Permit R-13981, Application R-85941.

The Department finds that the amount of water requested, 1.5 AF, is an acceptable amount.

In accordance with OAR 690-33-330, an interagency team reviewed this proposed use for potential adverse impacts on sensitive, threatened and endangered fish populations. This team consisted of representatives from the Oregon Departments of Water Resources (WRD), Environmental Quality, Fish and Wildlife (DFW), and Agriculture. WRD and DFW representatives included both technical and field staff. The interagency team did not recommend that any additional conditions of use be imposed on this application.

Conclusions of Law

Under the provisions of ORS 537.153, the Department must presume that a proposed use will not impair or be detrimental to the public interest if the proposed use is allowed in the applicable basin program established pursuant to ORS 536.300 and 536.340 or given a preference under ORS 536.310(12), if water is available, if the proposed use will not injure other water rights and if the proposed use complies with rules of the Water Resources Commission.

The proposed use requested in this application is allowed in the Rogue Basin Plan, or a preference for this use is granted under the provisions of ORS 536.310(12).

Water is available for the proposed use.

The proposed use will not injure other water rights.

The proposed use complies with other rules of the Water Resources Commission not otherwise described above.

The proposed use complies with the State Agency Agreement for land use.

For these reasons, the required presumption has been established.

Once the required presumption has been established, under the provisions of ORS 537.153(2) it may be overcome by a preponderance of evidence that either:

- (a) One or more of the criteria for establishing the presumption are not satisfied; or
- (b) The proposed use will impair or be detrimental to the public interest as demonstrated in comments, in a protest . . . or in a finding of the department that shows:
 - (A) The specific public interest under ORS 537.170(8) that would be impaired or detrimentally affected; and
 - (B) Specifically how the identified public interest would be impaired or detrimentally affected.

In this application, all criteria for establishing the presumption have been satisfied, as noted above. The presumption has not been overcome by a preponderance of evidence that the proposed use will impair or be detrimental to the public interest.


The Department therefore concludes that water is available in the amount necessary for the proposed use; the proposed use will not result in injury to existing water rights; and the proposed use will not impair or be detrimental to the public interest as provided in ORS 537.170.

When issuing permits, ORS 537.211(1) authorizes the Department to include limitations and conditions which have been determined necessary to protect the public interest. The attached draft permit is conditioned accordingly.

Protest Rights and Standing

Under the provisions of 537.621(7), you have the right to protest this proposed final order. Your protest must be in writing, and must include the following:

- Your name, address, and telephone number;

This letter is to inform you of the preliminary analysis of your water use permit application and to describe your options. In determining whether a water use permit application may be approved, the Department must consider the factors listed below, all of which must be favorable to the proposed use if it is to be allowed. Based on the information you have supplied, the Water Resources Department has made the following preliminary determinations:

Initial Review Determinations:

1. The proposed use is not prohibited by law or rule except where otherwise noted below.
2. The use of water from a reservoir, Application R-85941, a tributary of Lathrop Creek for irrigation (temperature control) **is allowable** under OAR 690-515-0040(1)(a), the Rogue Basin Program.
3. Water in the amount of 1.5 acre feet for irrigation (temperature control) **is available**, contingent on approval of Application R-85941.
4. The proposed use **is located** above the Rogue Scenic Waterway, as designated under ORS 390.826.
5. Your proposed use falls within a high priority area for streamflow restoration under the Oregon Plan for Salmon & Watersheds.

Summary of Initial Determinations

The use of 1.5 acre feet from a reservoir, Application R-85941, a tributary of Lathrop Creek for irrigation (temperature control) on 3.0 acres is allowable from February 1 through April 30 of each year, contingent on approval of Application R-85941.

Because of these favorable determinations, the Department can now move your application to the next phase of the water rights application review process. This phase is where public interest factors will be evaluated.

Please reference the application number when sending any correspondence regarding the conclusions of this initial review. Comments received within the comment period will be evaluated at the next phase of the process.

To Proceed With Your Application:

If you choose to proceed with your application, you do not have to notify the Department.
