Dear Mrs. Green:

This will acknowledge your letter of February 5, 1970, in regards to your ground water application number G-3536.

Your application submitted on June 10, 1966, was approved by permit number G-3328 for the irrigation of 28.0 acres. The application indicated that all construction has been completed when the application was filed. The permit required that the complete application of water be made on or before October 1, 1969.

Proof could be made under this permit to the extent the water was actually used up to the 28.0 acres requested by completing the form C enclosed. No proof could be made on any land not beneficially irrigated under the terms of the permit.

The only proof of a water right is beneficial use of the water and there is no way that you can reserve water now for a possible use in the future.

If no use of water has been made since the permit was issued, the enclosed authorization to cancel the permit could be completed to eliminate further correspondence on this matter.

If some use of water has been made and you fee you can show due diligence toward the prosecution of the work, the enclosed application for extension of time could be completed to extend the time limits for one year.

Re: G-3536

We did not irrigate this past year. I understood that in order to protect the rights to an existing well the owner was required to register the well but I didn't realize that it required the use of the well every year whether it was needed or not. Is it possible to protect our right to use the well without irrigating land that doesn't need it, for the purpose it is now being used-- to run a few cattle? If the property were to be sold would the new owner be able to use the well if we didn't irrigate every year? We only have a few acres in permanent pasture that we would want to irrigate and not the whole 28 acres as your letter states. We do have 28 acres, however, that someone else may want to irrigate in the future, or indeed that we may want to irrigate at a date far in the future. We would like to protect our rights to irrigate when it is needed but it seems foolish and a waste of precious water to put it on ground that runs only about four cattle. We have more grass than we need now without irrigating. When we retire we may wish to buy more cows and then we would need the irrigation. Please advise us what to do.

Dear Mr. Green:

According to the terms of your permit No. G-3328, which is for the appropriation of 0.35 cubic feet of water per second from a well for the irrigation of 28.0 acres. complete application of water was to have been made by October 1, 1969.

Complete application of water means the application of water to beneficial use under the permit to the full extent intended. In the case of irrigation, it means beneficial irrigation of all the lands the permittee intends to cover under the terms of the permit. If water has been used, you should promptly submit notice describing the extent of completion as set forth in the letter accompanying your permit and also in our postal card of October 27, 1969.

ORS 537.260 provides that: "Whenever the time within which any appropriation under a permit should have been perfected has expired and the owner of the permit fails or refuses within three months thereafter to submit to the State Engineer proof of completion of the appropriation as required by ORS 537.230 and 537.250, the State Engineer may, after 60 days' notice by registered mail, order the cancelation of the permit.****"

In accordance with the provisions of ORS 537.260, you are hereby notified that unless proof of beneficial use is received within 60 days from the date of this letter, the permit(s) may be canceled without further notice.

If for any reason you are no longer interested in the project described by the permit, we would appreciate it if you would so advise. If the property involved has changed hands and any part of the project has been completed, you should immediately assign the permit to the new owner and advise us of his name and address. An assignment form will be furnished upon request.

This will acknowledge receipt of your letter dated October 29, 1969, in connection with your permit No. G-3328.

This permit is for the appropriation of 0.35 cubic foot per second of water from a well for irrigation of 28.0 acres located in Section 25, T. 17 S., R. 2 W., W. M.

Under the terms of the permit, the date for complete application of water is October 1, 1969. Complete application of water would require at least one beneficial irrigation over all of the intended acreage. The only way a water right can be acquired is by use of water under the terms of the permit. Would you please let us know how many acres have been irrigated to beneficial use on or before October 1, 1969.

If you intend to irrigate next year, it may be possible for you to make application for an extension of the time limit to make complete application of water. The State Engineer is permitted by law to extend the time for completion of a project only upon the showing of due diligence by the permittee.

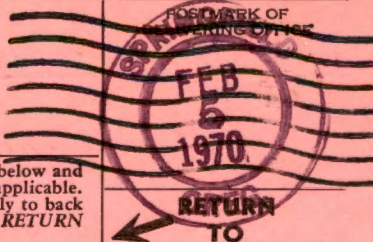
