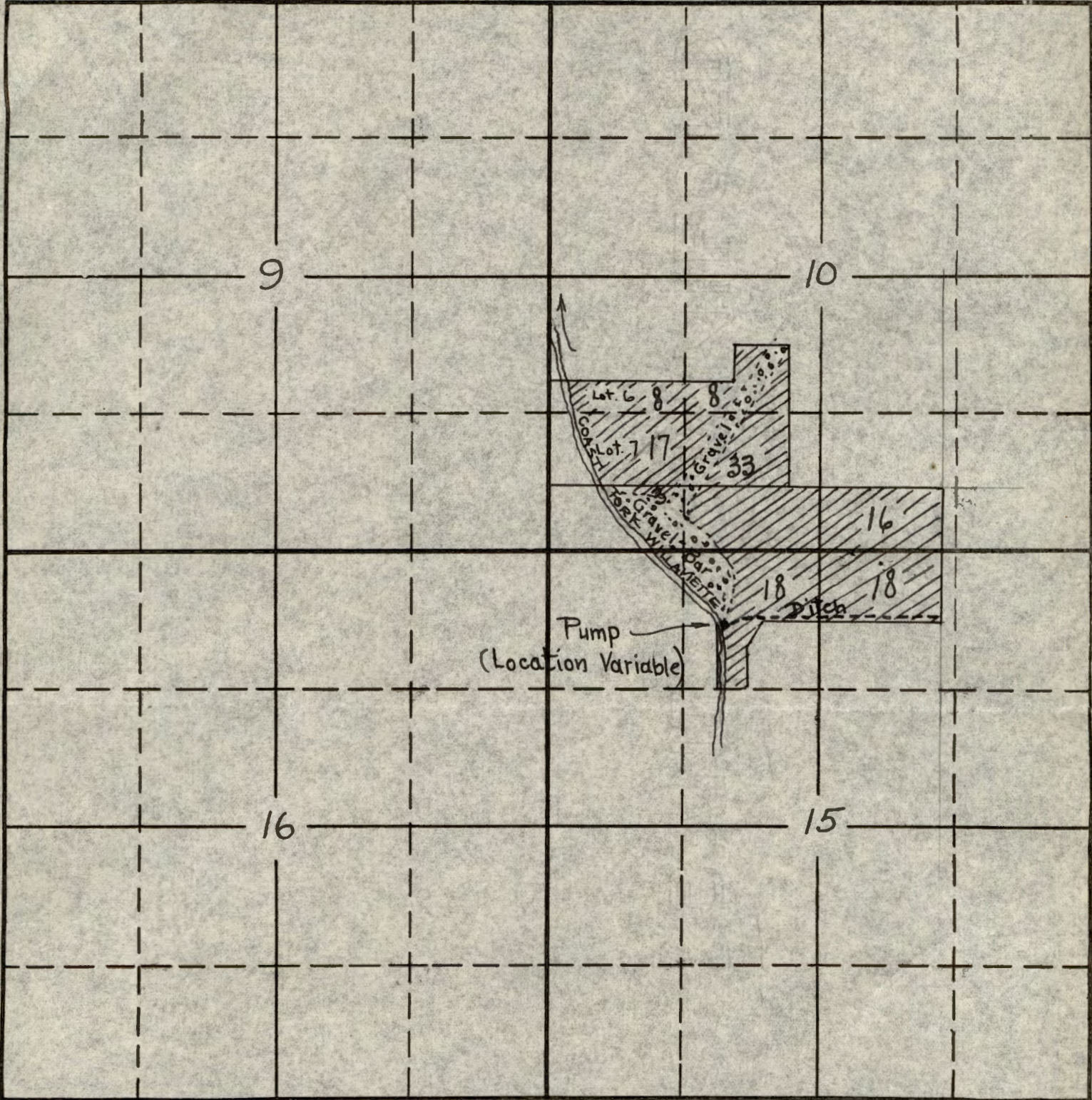

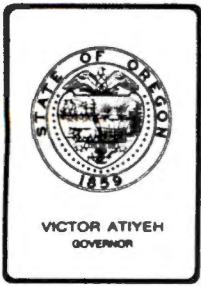


We have been advised that the Bureau of Reclamation, acting upon a request from Mrs. Francis Horn, has cancelled Willamette Basin Water Service Contract 7-07-10-W0045. The contract had provided for the use of water for irrigation, as described by Water Resources Department Permit 9996. It appears that your Application 55531, Permit 42525 now covers a portion of the same lands.

Voluntary termination of a water service contract without immediately securing a replacement contract constitutes abandonment of the water right.

Therefore, if it is your intent to keep a right for irrigation of the lands previously covered by contract water, you should secure a replacement contract as soon as possible.

Please let us know if you intend to replace the contract. In reply refer to Files 13884 and 55531.

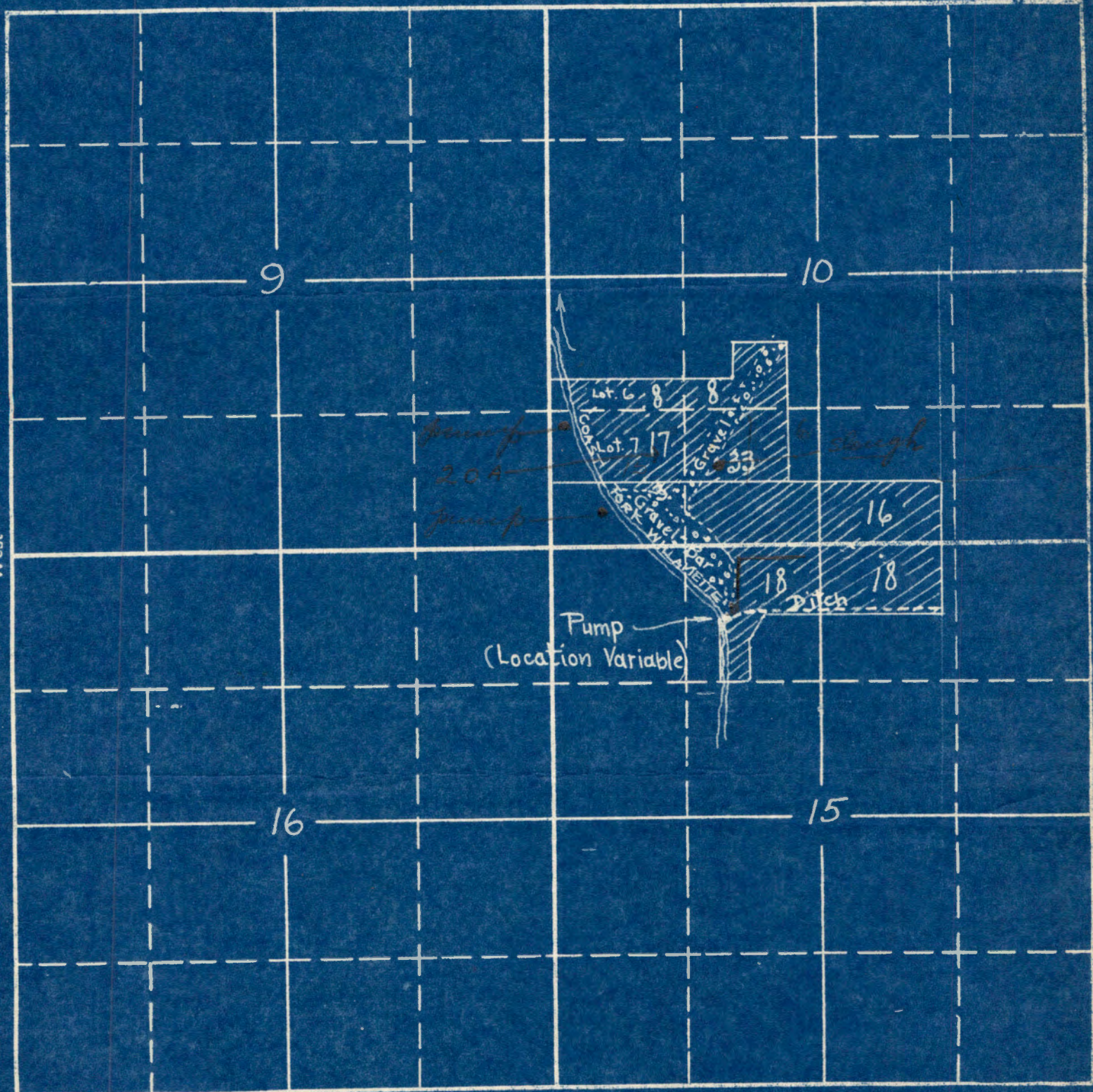

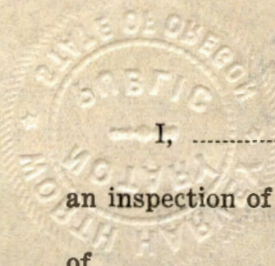

Dear Mr. Hemenway:

This will acknowledge an application submitted in the name of Francis M. Horn for a change in place of use of the water of the Coast Fork of Willamette River, a map plat and fees in the amount of \$5.00 for which our receipt No. 30606 is enclosed. The application cannot be filed at this time as the necessary fees were not submitted and the application is incomplete.

The statutory fees required for filing an application for a change in place of use is \$15.00 for examination fee, \$5.00 for recording fee and \$3.00 for certificate recording fee.

Item no. 4 must be filled in to describe the existing points of diversion as shown on the map which accompanied the final proof, a copy of which is enclosed.

The points of diversion of record as scaled from the original water right map are described as follows:

- (1) 1200 feet North and 250 feet East from the SW corner of Section 10, being within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 10,
- (2) 430 feet North and 600 feet East from the SW corner of Section 10, being within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 10, and

Dear Mr. Hemenway:

There is a statutory provision to provide for a change in place of use under a perfected, valid right from one tract to another. The owner of the land on which the water is used is owner of the right since it is appurtenant to the property. If Mr. Horn owns all of the land described in the certificate recorded at page 11298, and wishes to change the place of use from a portion of this to another tract whether it be in his ownership or another's ownership, he could make application for approval of such a change. I am enclosing a form for this purpose and excerpts from the law which includes the fee schedule. If only part of the right is to be transferred, the application must be accompanied by a map showing the area to which the transfer is made and also the area from which the transfer is made. I assume Mr. Horn has the original certificate and also a copy of the map so as to complete those parts of the application which require the record.
