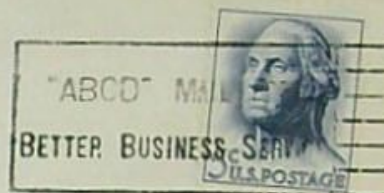
WELL LOCATION MAP FOR
