





This is to acknowledge the Application 68680 along with the superseding Application 68680 you submitted for Dick Ven Zente doing business as Tu-Tu-Tun Lodge. The sepia print of the original map and the sepia print of the superseding map were also received along with the legal description of the property.

The application now describes the proposed use of 0.01 cubic foot per second from Schneidau Creek for commercial use during the non-irrigation season and use of 0.016 cfs from the Rogue River for the irrigation of 1.72 acres.

We will need some clarification on the application and supporting map relative to the use of water from the creek and river for irrigation purposes.

According to our records, the right use of water from Schneidau Creek appurtenant to the easterly 0.8 acre of the irrigated area where the right was perfected under the terms of Permit 9987 was transferred to commercial use. If it is now intended to establish a primary right to the use of water from the Rogue River for the irrigation of this 0.8 acre area in addition to the 0.02 acre area and to continue the use of water from the creek for the irrigation of the balance of the acreage not involved in the transfer and utilize water from the Rogue River to make up for any deficiency in supply at the creek for this acreage, it will be necessary to further complete the supporting map by showing the location of the acreage (0.82 acres) to receive the primary supply from the Rogue River and by showing in a different manner the acreage to receive the supplemental supply from the Rogue River.

Item 3 of the application will then need to be further completed by separately listing the acreage to receive the primary supply from the Rogue River and by separately listing the acreage to receive the supplemental supply. However, if it is no longer intended to utilize water from the creek for irrigation purposes, it will be necessary to provide for clearing our records of the existing right to the use of water from the creek and merely indicate on the application and map that waters from the Rogue River will be used for primary irrigation of all the acreage to be irrigated.

Incidentally, the full duty of water that may be allowed from the Rogue River for the irrigation of 1.72 acres would amount to 0.022 cfs (9.6 gpm). If there will be facilities for delivering this amount of water and it can be beneficially used, the application may be amended by requesting the greater amount.

I am handing you herewith the completed and corrected application of Dirk Van Zante, dba Tu Tu Tun Lodge, for appropriation of water from the Rogue River and additional water from Schneidau Creek.

A man by the name of Gustaf Schneidau made the earliest appropriation of water from what is now known as Schneidau Creek through permit # 9987 which is evidenced by the water rights certificate recorded in Volume 10 at page 10751. This right with priority of January 24, 1931, was for irrigation and domestic use on 5.55 acres.

When Mr. Van Zante acquired the real property upon which the Tu Tu Tun Lodge is situated (see deed from Priestly to Van Zante, copy of which is handed you herewith), he acquired approximately 2.7 acres of Schneidau's original 5.55 acres.

The domestic use acquired by Schneidau is appurtenant to the old Schneidau house which is on the Tu Tu Tun property and is still used. In fact, Mr. and Mrs. Van Zante live in that house. It is shown on the maps I am handing you as "dwelling" on map # 1 (my numbering) and "dwelling permit # 9987" on map # 2.

That portion of the original Schneidau 5.55 acres now owned by the Van Zantes is shown on both maps by a line angling across a portion of the lodge with the legend "limit of Permit # 9987". The Tu Tu Tun property north of this line is the original Schneidau property. Map # 2 has been prepared to show the irrigated area included in Permit # 9987.

By order on transfer application # 5636, Mr. Van Zante was permitted to use 0.01 cfs of the water right granted under Permit # 9987 for commercial use serving Tu Tu Tun Lodge. This use was limited to the irrigation season which the local water master determined to be from May 1st to October 15th of each calendar

The Application 68680 you submitted for Dirk Van Zante describing the proposed use of 0.01 cubic foot per second from Schneidau Creek and 0.16 cfs from the Rogue River, being 0.01 cfs to be used commercially and 0.16 cfs for irrigation of 1.7 acres, together with the sepia print of a map, has been reviewed.

It will be necessary to make certain amendments to the application and supply additional information on the supporting map before the application can be considered for approval. We will also need the legal description of the property.

The legal description is needed to verify the place of use of water and may be copied from the deed, title insurance policy, or sales contract.

According to the information in Items 2 and 4 of the application, it is intended to utilize water from Schneidau Creek and the Rogue River. If so, the Rogue River needs to be included as a source of water in the first part of Item 1.

Item 2 must be completed to properly locate each point of diversion within the proper quarter-quarter section. According to the distances from the reference corner presently noted in Item 2 and according to the location of the points illustrated on the supporting map, the point on the creek would be located within the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 10 and the point on the Rogue River would be located within the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 11. If so, this information will need to be clearly given as such in Item 2.

The number of acres to be irrigated must be noted in Item 3 of the application without using a plus or minus figure.

Item 5 of the application must be further completed to clearly note the source to supply each use.

The type and extent of the commercial use needs to be explained in the application. This information may be supplied in Item 6 or in the remarks section. Also, if the use of water for commercial use is only for the period of the year not allowed under the order approving the Transfer 5636, this will also need to be noted.

The area to be irrigated will need to be clearly illustrated on the supporting map by hachuring or shading in some manner along with noting the number of acres to be in agreement with the information supplied in Item 3 of the application. If any part of the existing right for irrigation perfected under the Permit 9987 is being claimed for the property, it may be best to show both the existing right location and the lands to be covered by the new filing. This may be accomplished by shading or hachuring in different manners and placing a legend on the map. Also, if the dwelling illustrated on the map is covered by the domestic right for the use of water perfected under the Permit 9987, the dwelling should be designated as such.

I am returning the application and map to you for correction and completion. The application is endorsed so that in order to retain its priority date it must be received in this office on or before May 21, 1986.
