<u> Appeal Rights</u>

This final order is subject to judicial review by the Court of Appeals under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482(1). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Application History

Permit G-15024 was issued by the Department on February 15, 2002. The permit called for complete application of water to beneficial use by October 1, 2006. The most recent Extension of Time specified complete application of the water was to be made by 2017. On August 27, 2021, Chris Edlebeck, submitted to the Department an Application for Extension of Time for Permit G-15024. In accordance with OAR 690-315-0050(2), on July 2, 2024, the Department issued a Proposed Final Order proposing to deny the time to fully apply water to beneficial use to October 1, 2041. The protest period closed August 16, 2024, in accordance with OAR 690-315-0060(1). No protest was filed.
