PUMPING PLANT and SCREENING STRUCTURE
COLUMBIA RIVER

Interested parties are hereby notified that application has been made for a Department of the Army permit under Section 10 of the River and Harbor Act of 1899 to construct a pumping plant, screening structure, and connecting intake pipes. The pumping plant will consist of eight 40-50 horsepower pumps which will lift the water to horizontal revolving weed seed removal screens and into a second reservoir where eight 800-1,000 horsepower highhead turbine pumps will charge a steel penstock leading to the farm land.

The screening structure will be placed approximately 900 feet from the south shoreline of Lake Umatilla (268 Pool) and will consist of an H-pile and precast concrete structure approximately 16 feet square and 30 feet high with a low profile hoist rail. The structure will be fitted with nine 4-feet by 13.5-feet screen panels and three 4-feet by 10.5-feet screen panels. The screening fabric will be 4-1/2 mesh of .080 wire with openings of .142 inches. The velocity one foot in front of the screen will be .176 feet per second and the velocity through the screen will be .43 feet per second.

The intake pipes from the screening structure to the pumping plant will consist of two 42-inch pipes with space provided for a third pipe. An electric cable to supply power to the screening structure will be placed in the intake pipe trench. Excavation of approximately 3,500 cubic yards of river bed material will be required for placement of the intake pipes.

Certification: A permit will not be issued until certification as required under Section 401 of the Federal Water Pollution Control Act Amendments of 1972 (PL 92-500), has been received from the State of Oregon Department of Environmental Quality.

Conditions: The applicant proposes and agrees to the following conditions:

a. All construction debris will be disposed of on land in such a manner that it cannot enter into the waterway.

b. All piling and lumber treated with creosote or other protective material will be completely dry before use in or near the waterway.

c. Care will be taken to prevent any petroleum products, chemicals, or other deleterious materials from entering the water.

d. All areas along the bank disturbed or newly created by the construction activity will be seeded, riprapped or given some other equivalent type of protection against subsequent erosion.

e. Work in the waterway will be done so as to minimize turbidity increases in the water which tend to degrade water quality and damage aquatic life.

f. If a bucket dredge of any type, including but not limited to grab or clamshell, dipper, dragline or backhaul bucket is used, all digging passes of the bucket shall be completed without any material once in the bucket, being returned to the wetted area except as approved.

g. All excavated material will be disposed of on land in such a manner that it cannot enter into the waterway.

h. Navigation lights and markings as required by the U.S.Coast Guard will be provided and installed.

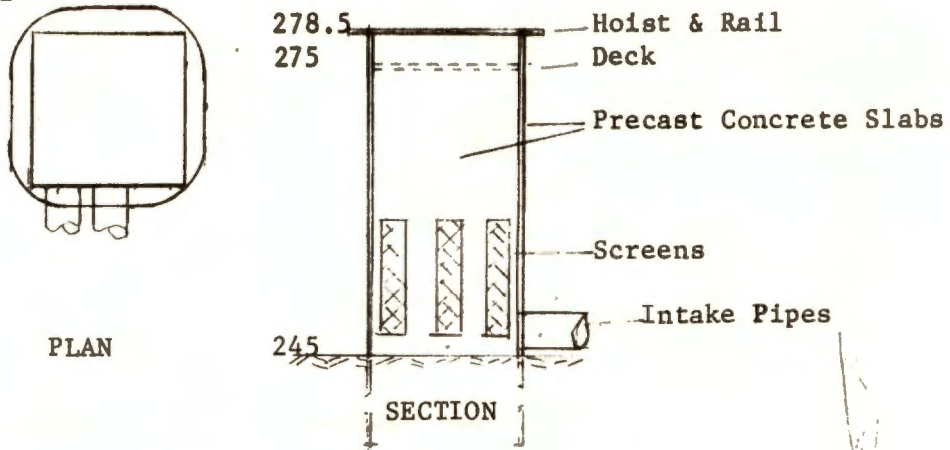

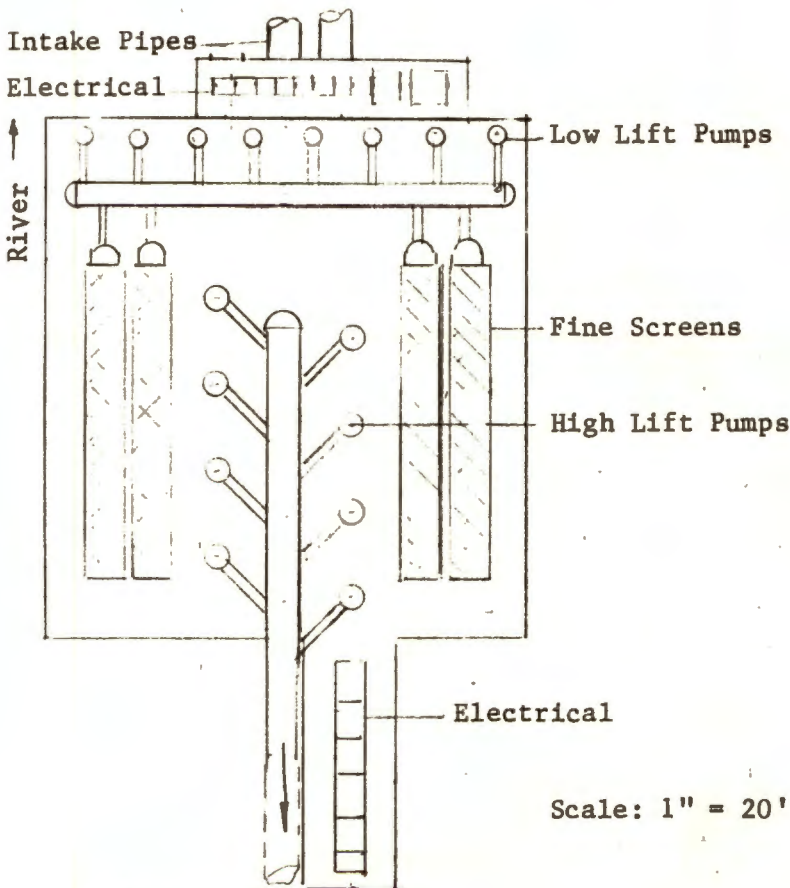

SCREENING STRUCTURE

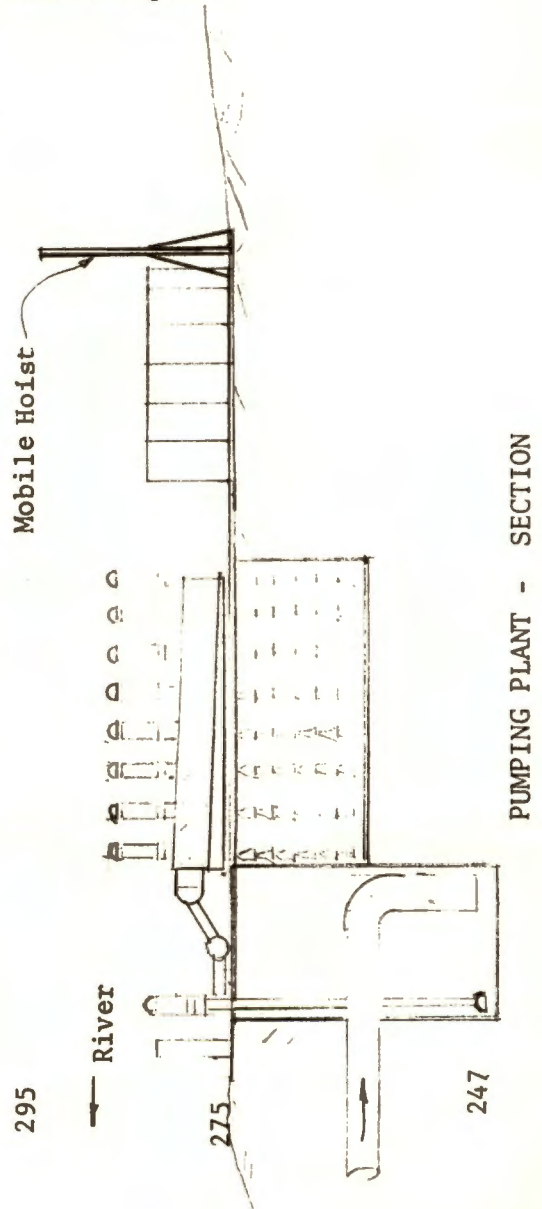

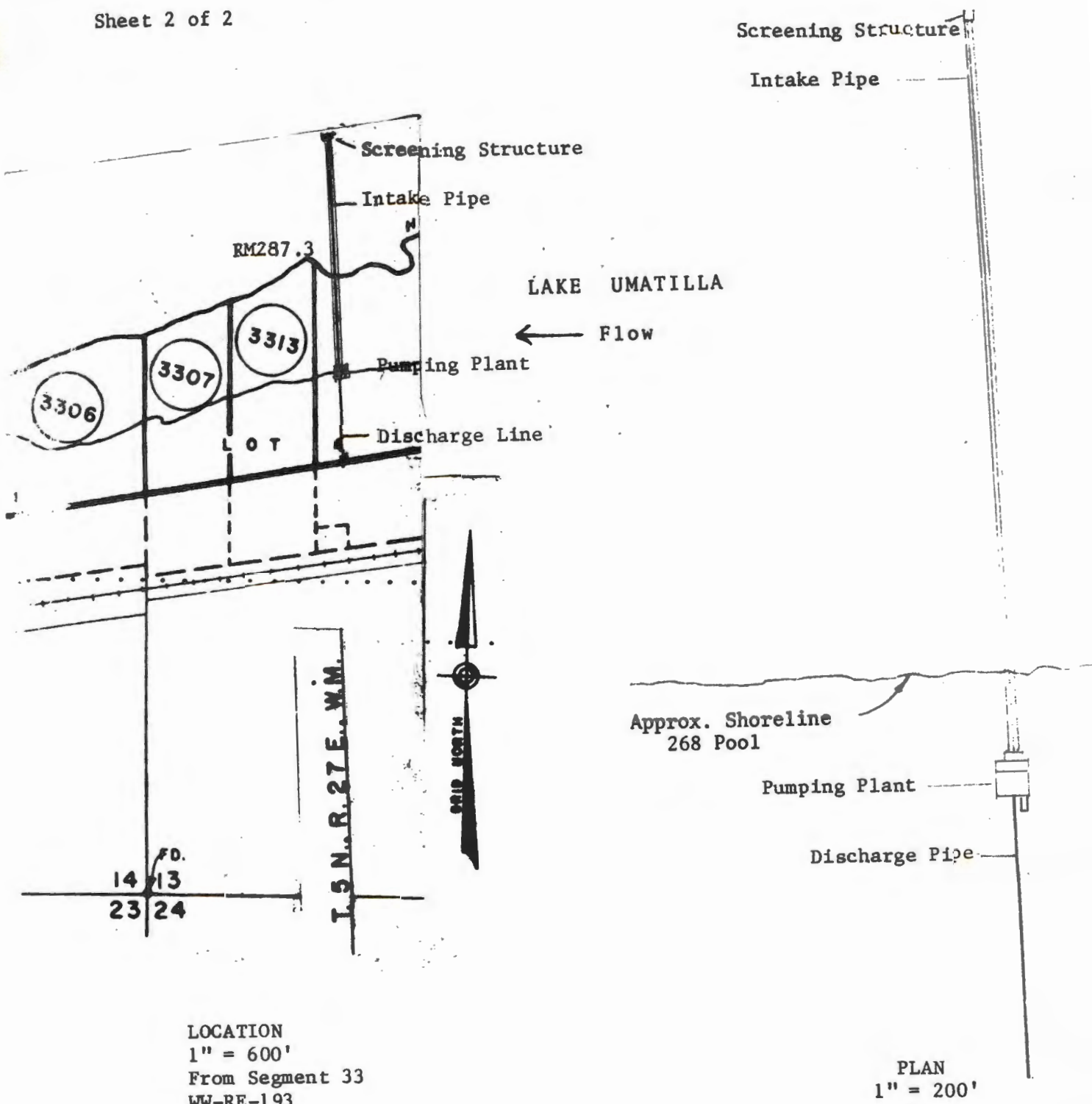


PUMPING STATION-PLAN

The record of rights you requested took longer than I anticipated. I am not sure I made the proper notes during our conversation so I am enclosing a map with the property outlined according to my notes. Work on the Butter Creek critical ground water area involved the rights in question and locating the files I needed slowed my search somewhat.

Permit No. 37108 was issued to C & B Livestock Company for the appropriation of 108.0 c.f.s. of waters of Columbia River for irrigation of the land tabulated on the enclosed sheets. The notice of complete application of water was submitted on October 25, 1977, but the first proof survey has not been made.

Certificate 39547 describes the irrigation of 66.6 acres which is half of land covered by a circle. The irrigation of the other half of the circle was done under permit No. G 4337. Proof was made under this permit as set out in certificate 42860 and located by the enclosed final proof survey map.

The right appurtenant to 87.4 acres canceled as noted in certificate 35094 was irrigated from another well and in part is described in certificate 38288.

Ronald and Jane Baker are record holders of permit No. G 5044 and G 6727 but these cover lands in sections 28 and 29, north of the U.P.R.R. and west of Highway 207 and are outside of the L.D. you gave me.

C & B Livestock Company filed application No. G 7602 for a permit to appropriate water from a well for irrigation of 60.0 acres in the E $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 27, Township 4 N Range 28 E. The well is within the Butter Creek critical ground water area and I do not think a permit can be issued unless the well is sealed off to limit the appropriation to the depth of the alluvial gravels.

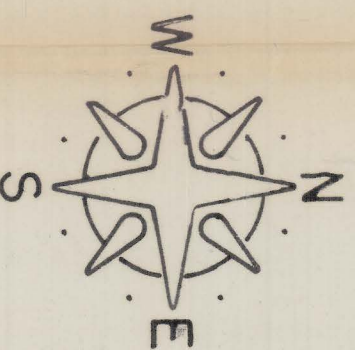
