LEGAL DESCRIPTION: Real property in the County of Clackamas, State of Oregon, described as follows:

PARCEL 1:

Part of the North one-half of the Southeast one-quarter and part of the Northeast onequarter of the Southwest one-quarter of Section 18, Township 5 South, Range 1 East, of the Willamette Meridian, in the County of Clackamas and State of Oregon, to-wit:
