

This will acknowledge your application for a permit to appropriate 53 gallons of water per minute from a well for the domestic water supply for a subdivision, a tracing, and fees in the sum of \$20 for which our receipt numbered 36425 is enclosed.

Your application has been examined and filed under file number G-2498. Before your application may be considered for approval by issuance of a permit it must be completed as follows:

Item Four: Upon examination of Item 4 and the map accompanying your application, it appears that there is a disagreement between the information given in Item 4 and that shown on the map. So that this might be checked further, it is requested that you submit a legal description of the property which has been subdivided, copying the description word for word from the deed, abstract, title insurance policy or sales contract. The map should include the tie from the Government Survey Corner to the well.

Item Twelve: The quarter quarter sections within which the water will be used must be specified. It appears that this will be the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ and the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$. It is also requested that you state the number of families to be served by the proposed domestic water system.

So that you might make the necessary additions and corrections, we are returning the application and the accompanying map and have endorsed the application so that in order to retain its date of priority it must be returned to this office on or before February 28, 1963.

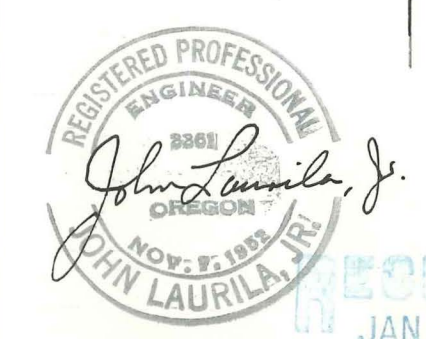
