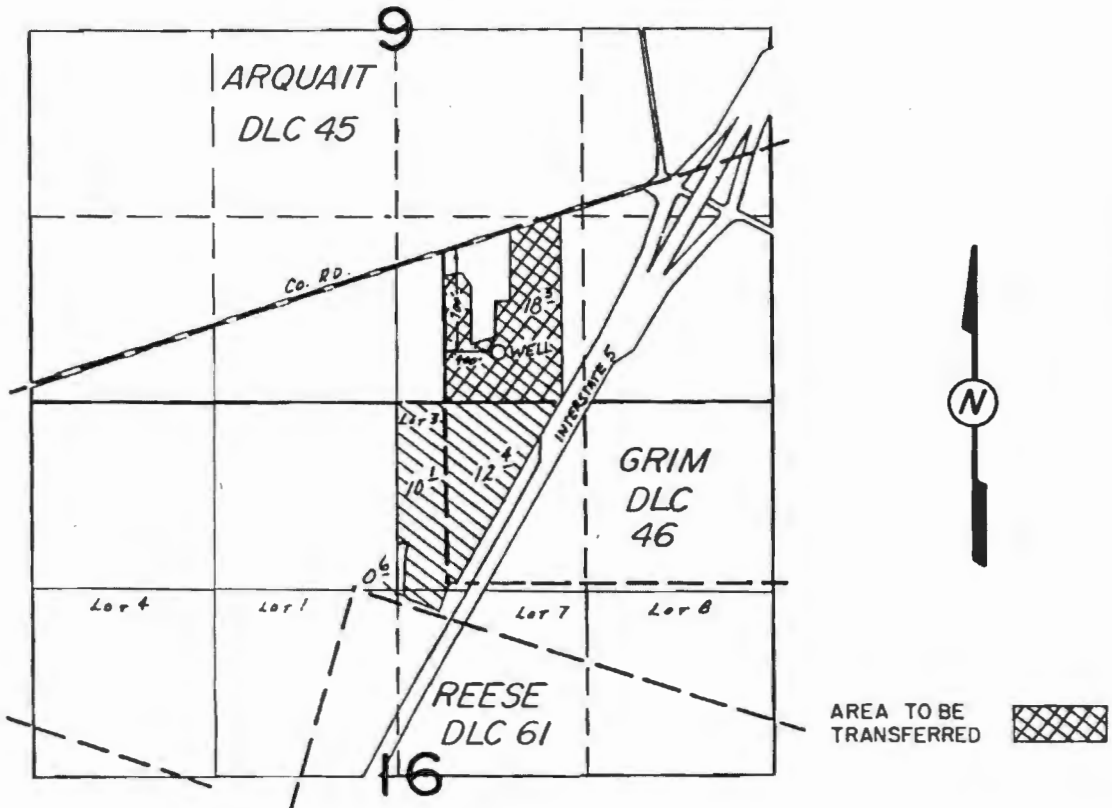

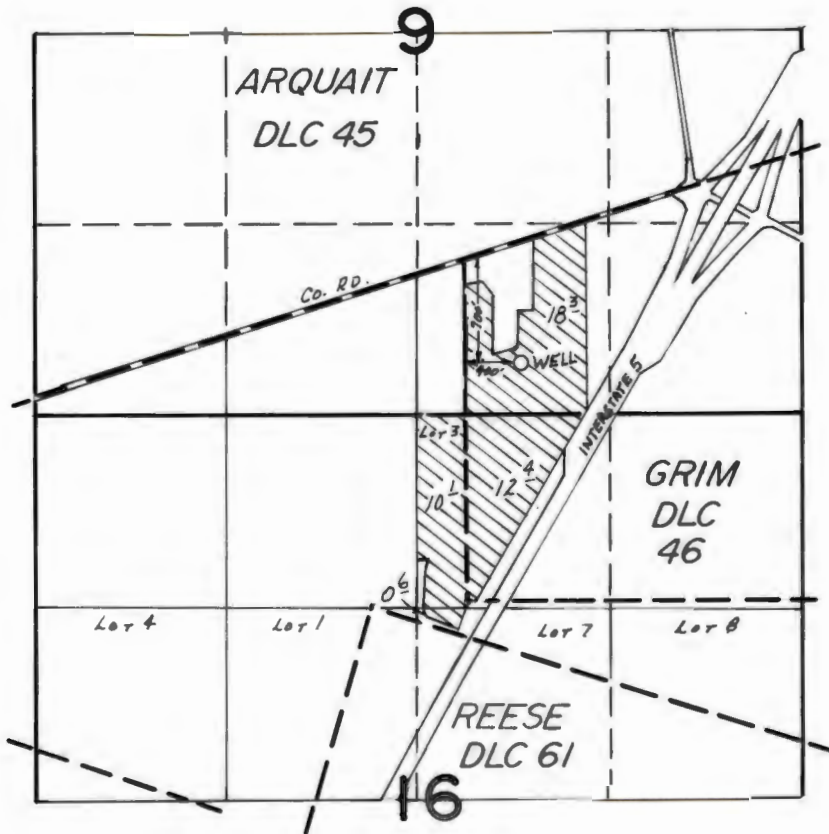


EXTENSION OF TIME

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.52 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the well or source of appropriation, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from one well

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation

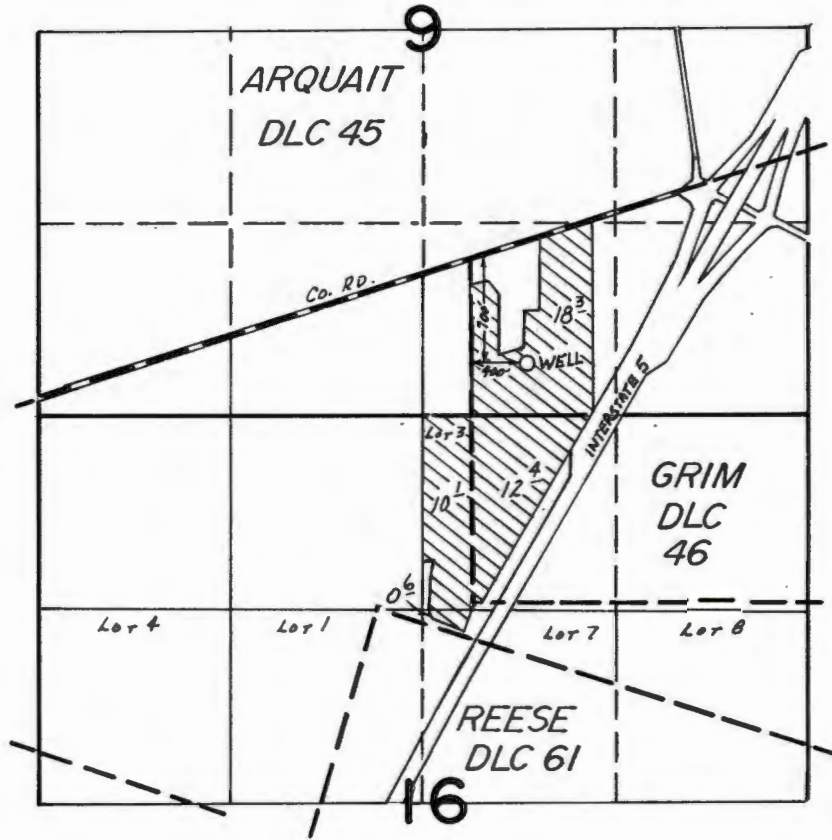

Your Application G-11322 describing the proposed use of 550 gallons of water per minute from one well for the irrigation of 41.7 acres together with the map prepared on tracing paper and legal description of the three parcels, has been reviewed.

The location of the well needs to be given in Item 2 of the application by a distance north or south and by a distance east or west from a public land survey corner. However if you wish, you may use one distance and one bearing from the reference corner. I have illustrated a manner of locating the well on your supporting map. 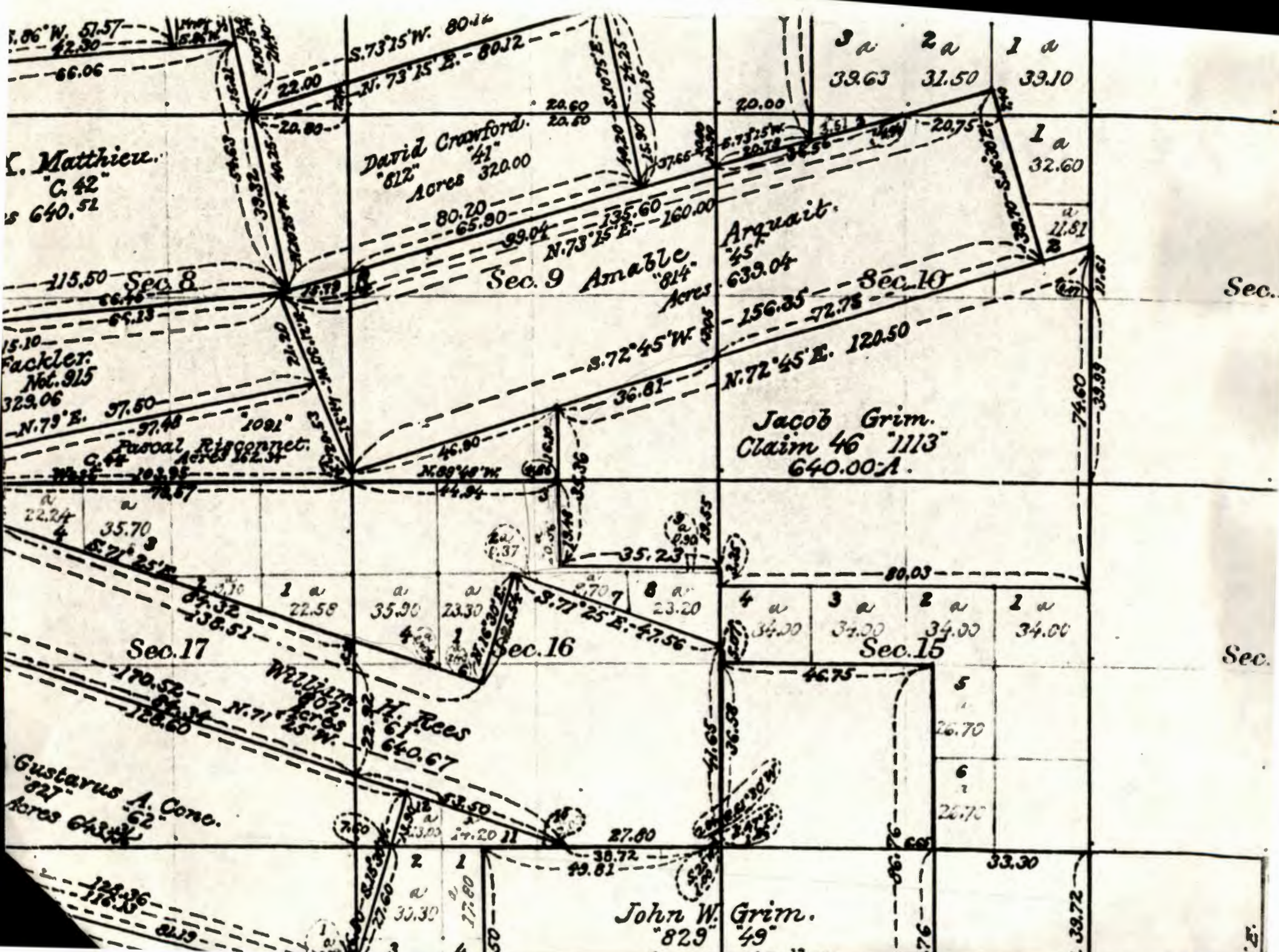

Your application for a permit to appropriate 550 gallons of water per minute from one well for the irrigation of 41.7 acres was not accompanied with the required fees, so could not be filed.

The application requires an examination fee of \$200. In addition to the examination fee, permit recording fees in the amount of \$164 are needed based upon the 41.7 acres you propose to irrigate. Therefore, total fees in the amount of \$364 should be submitted with your application.

The first part of Item 2 on your application must be completed by locating the well by distances and directions from a public land survey corner such as a corner of the section or a donation land claim corner instead of the tax lot corner presently noted.

Item 3 will need to be completed by listing the number of acres to be irrigated in each quarter-quarter section.

The map you submitted does not meet our requirements. The map to support your application must show your proposed project with relation to the section lines and quarter-quarter lines in the vicinity and if prints are to be submitted, it is necessary to complete prints of the entire original map further completed to show your project. Additional requirements for the map are briefly explained on pages 3 and 4 of the enclosed booklet relative to ground water applications.

A legal description of the property upon which the water will be used is needed. This legal description is needed to verify the place of use and may be copied from your deed, title insurance policy or sales contract.
