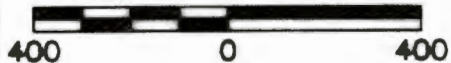

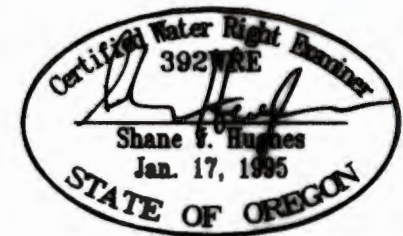

The right allows the use of SILTCOOS LAKE, a tributary of PACIFIC OCEAN, for GROUP DOMESTIC FOR 56 FAMILIES AND 10 CAMPSITES. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.07 cubic foot per second, if available at the authorized point of diversion: LOT 5 (NW¼ NE¼), SECTION 26, T 19 S., R 12 W., W.M.; 330 FEET SOUTH AND 3000 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER, SECTION 26, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The applicant proposes to change the character of use to QUASI-MUNICIPAL.

THIS CHANGE TO AN EXISTING WATER RIGHT MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

1. The proposed change shall be completed on or before October 1, 2006.
2. Prior to diverting water the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.
3. The water user shall annually report the monthly quantities of water diverted pursuant to OAR Chapter 690, Division 85.
4. The water user shall install and maintain a fish screen or fish by-pass device. The type and plans of the screen or by-pass device must be approved by the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife prior to beginning of construction and shall be installed under the supervision of the Department of Fish and Wildlife. The water user may participate in the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife's cost sharing program for installation of screening and by-pass devices in accordance with ORS 540.525.
5. The right to the use of water is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in Certificate 48728 and any related Decree. The right to the use of water is further restricted to the use of not more than **one million gallons** during any month.

Certificate 48728 is canceled. When satisfactory proof of the completed change is received, a new certificate confirming this water right will be issued.

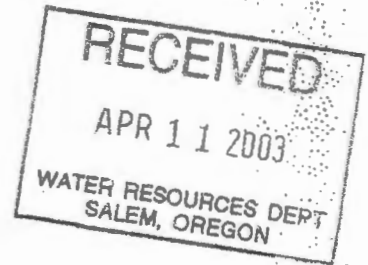

Dear Mr. Wobbe:

Enclosed you will find a copy of the map on file with OWRD which depicts the place of use for the referenced water right. The certificate authorizes group domestic use for 56 families, and, as it happens, there are 56 X's on the map denoting use. The circled X's indicate "served with water but not yet built."

Since ORS 540.510(3) was modified by the 1995 Legislature, the Siltcoos Heights Water System may use water on lands to which the water right is not appurtenant since the use is domestic use, a component of municipal use, and the system is a water supplier as defined in ORS 448.115. Thus, 56 homes may receive domestic service from the system regardless of their location and 10 campsites may receive domestic water regardless of their location under the existing water right. However, no more than 56 homes may be served under the existing water right.

As I indicated in our phone conversation, a transfer application changing the use of this water right to quasi-municipal use is a viable option in order to serve more than 56 homes. Another option would be filing a new application for additional water. A new permit, however, may be limited to human consumption use only.

Our records show that certificate of water right recorded at page 48728, Volume 42, State Record of Water Right Certificates, has been issued to Bernard La Forge. The certificate confirmed the right to the use of 0.07 cubic foot per second of water from Siltcoos Lake for group domestic purposes for 56 families and 10 campsites under a date of priority of October 18, 1971.

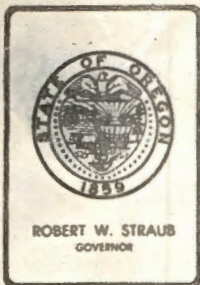
A completed and perfected water right as evidence by a certificate remains valid and in force indefinitely; however, all or a portion of the right can be lost through intentional abandonment or through failure to exercise the right for a period of five successive years.

Also, such a perfected right is an appurtenance to the specific place of use upon which the right was established and belongs to the legal owner of the real property; therefore, an assignment is not required.

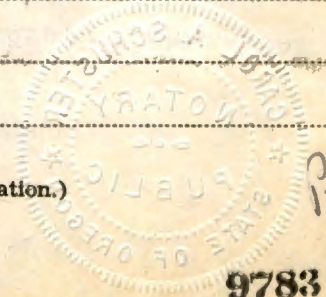

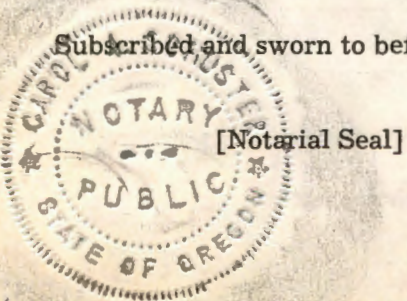


Pursuant to your request I am enclosing a form for use in making application for an extension of time limits under permit No. 35825.

This will acknowledge the notice of beginning of construction under the terms of permit No. 35825. Also acknowledged is your notice of completion of construction for that same permit. You stated on your completion of construction notice that water is being used for 34 families as of this date with more to be added as development progresses.

Your permit allows for the use of 0.10 cubic feet per second from Siltcoos Lake for group domestic use for 110 families. For construction to be complete for the use of 110 families requires not only the major distribution system but also the internal plumbing for each family unit. Your current use of 34 families does not indicate that this has been done.

Our records show that the time limit for completion of construction of the works and/or the purchase and installation of all the facilities required for the authorized beneficial use of water will expire on October 1, 1974.

Until such time as your project construction is totally complete or is complete to the extent intended then your notice of construction should not be submitted until the expiration date.

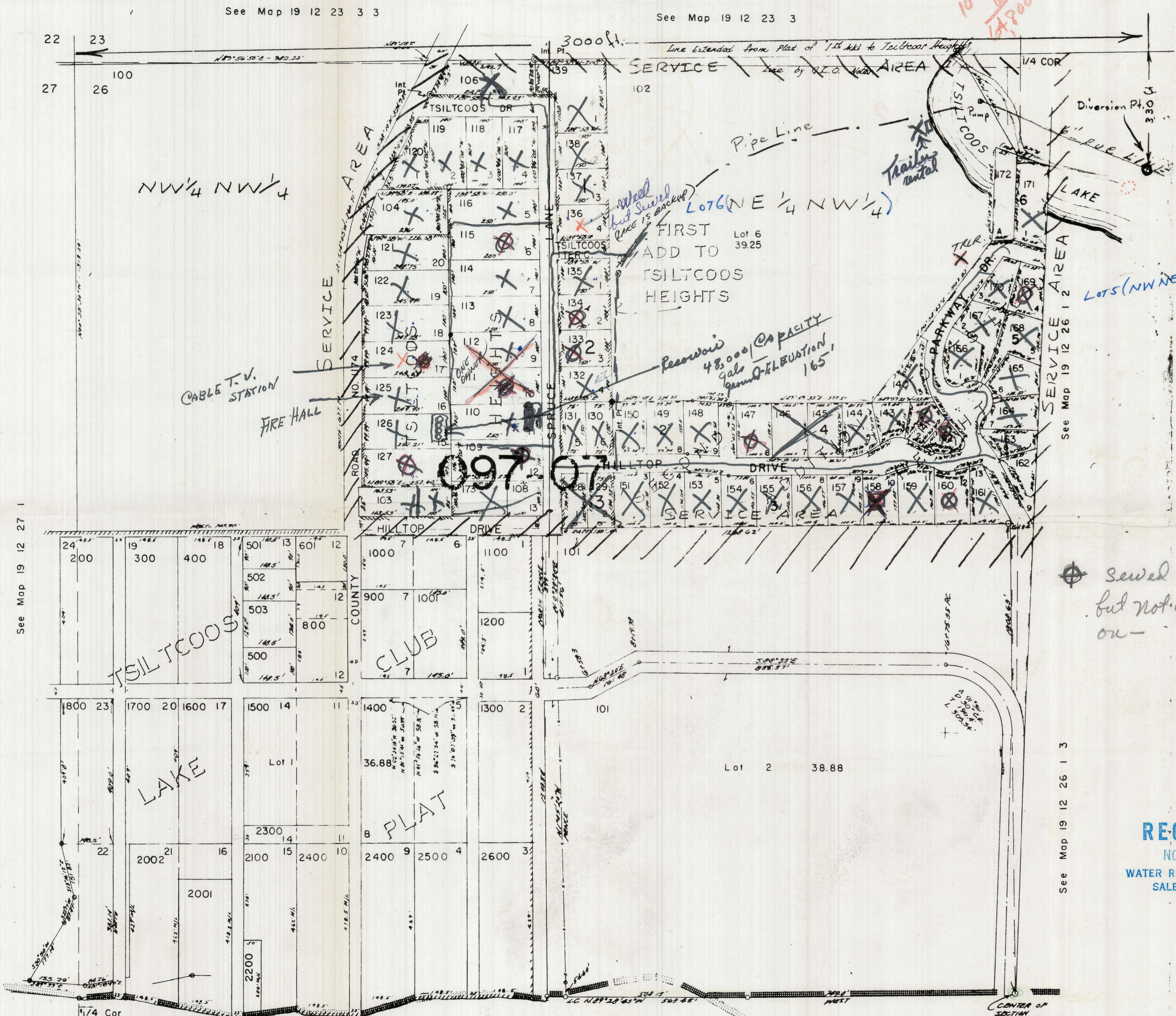

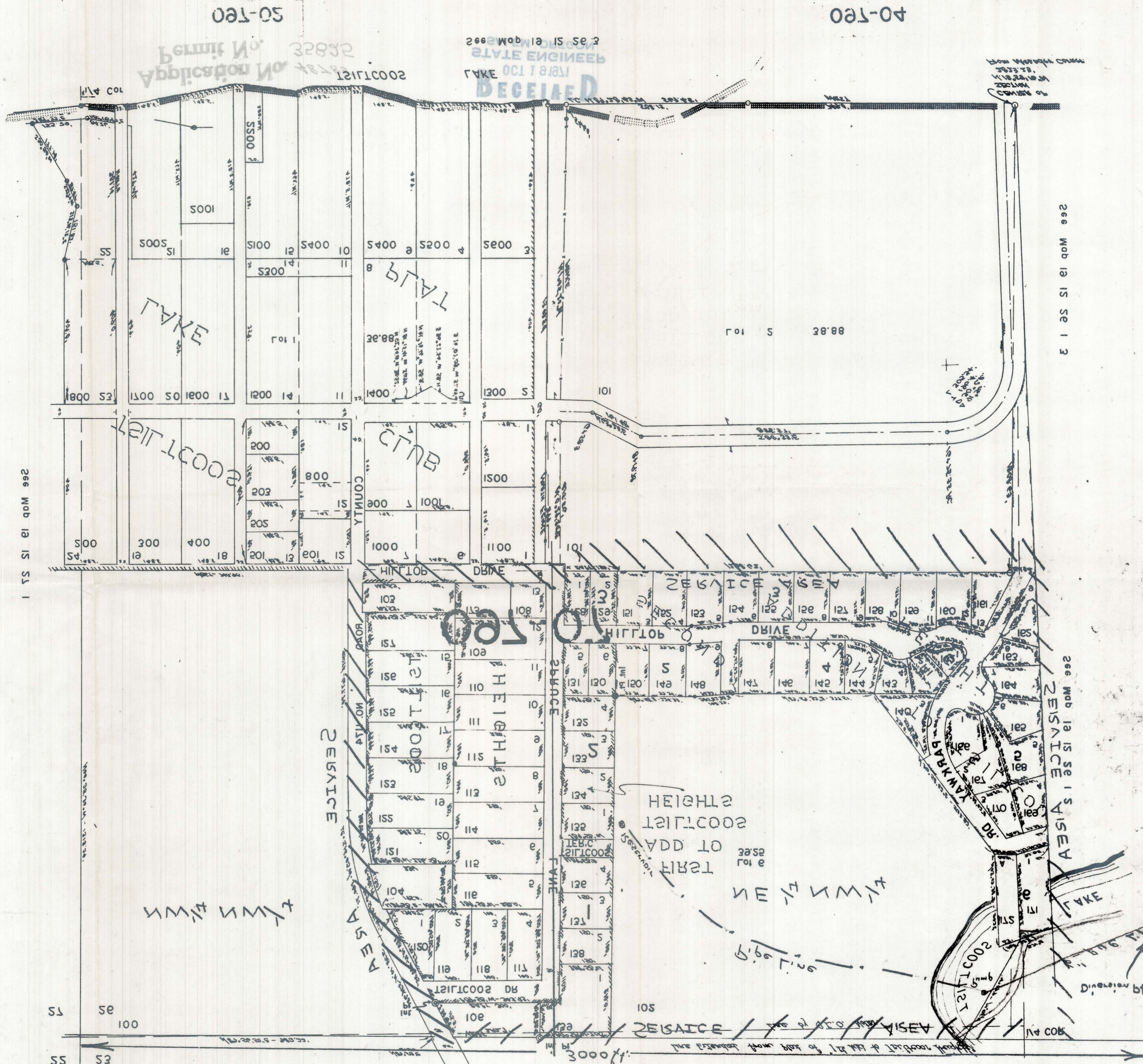
