Your Application G-11105 describing the proposed use of 1100 gallons of water per minute from two wells for agricultural-hay on 260.0 acres, together with the two maps, has been reviewed.

Also, your Application G-11106 describing the proposed use of 1050 gallons of water per minute from one well for agricultural-hay on 160.0 acres, together with the map, has been reviewed.

It will be necessary to supply additional information and make certain amendments to the applications before they can be considered for approval. Also, legal descriptions of the properties upon which the water will be used are needed.

The legal descriptions are needed to verify the places of use of water and may be copied from your deeds, title insurance policies, or sales contracts.

According to the information supplied on the maps submitted, Well 2 would be located by distances North and West from the Southeast Corner of Section 25 instead of from the Northeast Corner of Section 36 presently noted in Item 2 of the Application G-11105.

The latter part of Item 2 on the Application G-11105 will need to be further completed by locating the wells within the proper quarter-quarter sections.

If separate acreage will be supplied from each well described on the Application G-11105, Item 3 on the application will need to be further completed by listing separately the acreage to be supplied from each well. Also, the acreage to be irrigated in each quarter-quarter section will need to be noted in Item 3.
