Dear Doctor Walsh:

I have your application for a change in point of diversion for an existing water right involving the waters of Louse Creek and accompanying map.

Fifteen dollars from your \$30 check has been credited to this application as shown by our enclosed receipt No. 1198.

The application has been filed and designated application No. W-105.

Item 5 of the application should be completed to identify the lands involved in the proposed change in point of diversion. I have made pencilled entries to show the entirety of the water right evidenced by the certificate recorded at page 7432, State Record of Water Rights Certificates, in the name of W. J. Savage.

With reference to item 14 and the map, it appears that more than one point of diversion is indicated by the map. If you intend to irrigate by means of a portable pump, moving the pump with each change of the sprinkler pipes, it will be necessary for you to list the location of each end of travel of the pump.

Since the distance between the old and new points of diversion is more than one-quarter of a mile the law requires that notice of the proposed change be published at least once a week for three consecutive weeks in a newspaper printed and having general circulation in Josephine County.

It is necessary that you submit a deposit of \$30 toward cost of publication of notice. If the actual cost is less than \$30, we will refund the difference. If it is more than \$30, we will bill you for the difference.

Please specify which newspaper you want the notice published in.
