
Dear Mr. Curtis:



This will acknowledge receipt of your application for a permit to construct a well and appropriate therefrom 50 g.p.m. for the irrigation of 16 acres, the accompanying pencil sketch, legal description and your check in the amount of \$10 for which our Receipt No. 13446 is enclosed.

The application has been examined, given file No. G-775, and the following defects are noted:

Map: A map prepared in accordance with the requirements as set forth on pages 3 & 4 of the enclosed Rules and regulations must be submitted to accompany the application.

Since your project is within a platted and recorded subdivision, the easiest way to comply to the mapping requirements would be to obtain three prints from the Washington County Recorders office and add to each of the prints the following data.

The proposed location of the well with direct reference made to a lot corner.

Show the section lines and sectional subdivision lines in the immediate area so as to locate the project as being within specific 1/16ths of a section.

Shade the area you propose to irrigate and indicate therein the number of acres you propose to irrigate within each 1/16th of a section.

October 11, 1957

Application Item 4: The location of the well should be listed in direct reference to a specified lot corner and the well should be further located as being within a specific 1/16th of a section.

Item 12: The area you propose to irrigate should be listed as being within specific 1/16ths of a section with the number of acres to be irrigated within each 1/16th listed separately.

Fees: The fees necessary to the application as it is now written are an examination fee of \$10 and a recording fee, for the irrigation of less than 30 acres, of \$5 making a total of \$15. An additional payment of fees in the amount of \$5 must be submitted prior to the issuance of a permit.

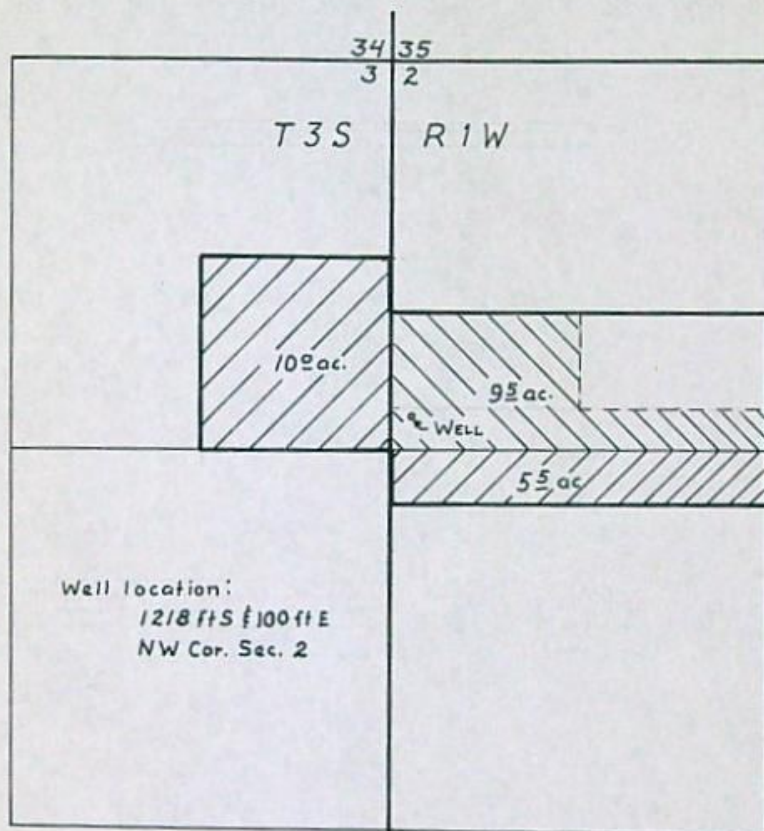
