

Acknowledged is your letter of September 9, 1974 in regards to additional time to submit the final proof of appropriation forms in regards to your water right permits.

On July 29, 1974 we mailed to you the final proof forms in regards to permits numbered G-3582, G-4356, 29557, 30580, 31039, 30581, 32322, 32323, and 32324. On August 19, 1974 we mailed to you the final proof forms in connection with permits numbered G-3742, 29330, 33050, R-5474, and R- 5475.

If additional time is needed in order to sign, date, and return the final proof forms, this additional time is granted and we will allow you an additional sixty days from the date of this letter in which to submit all of the signed final proof forms.
