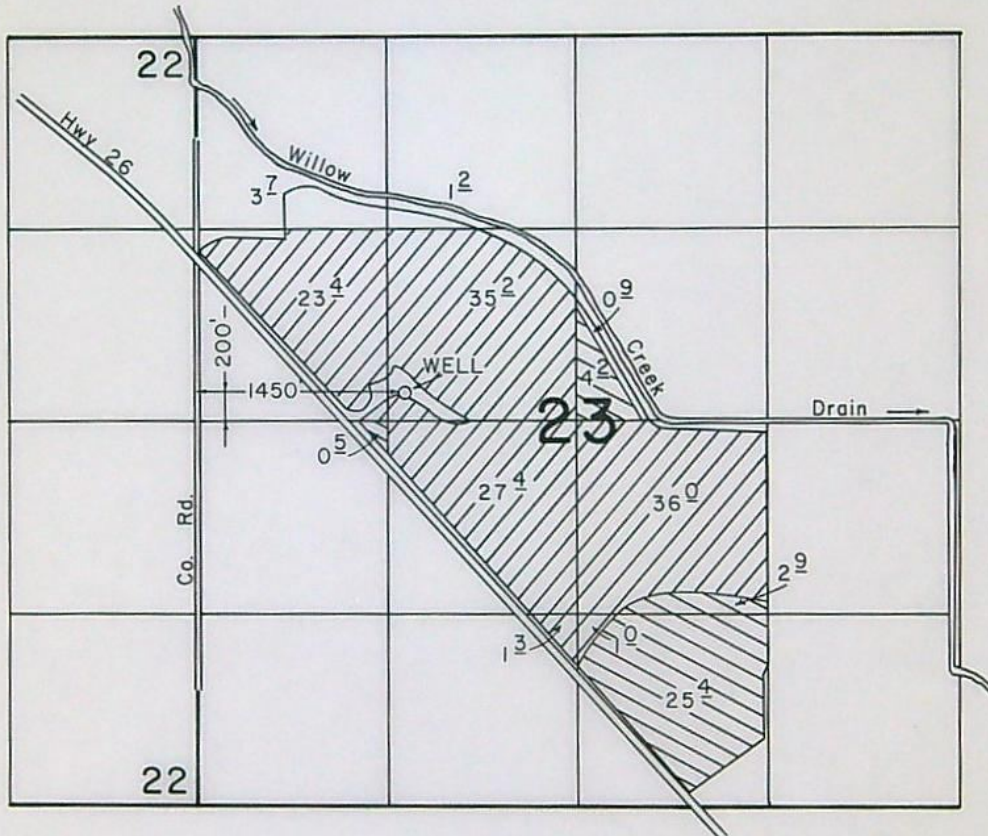

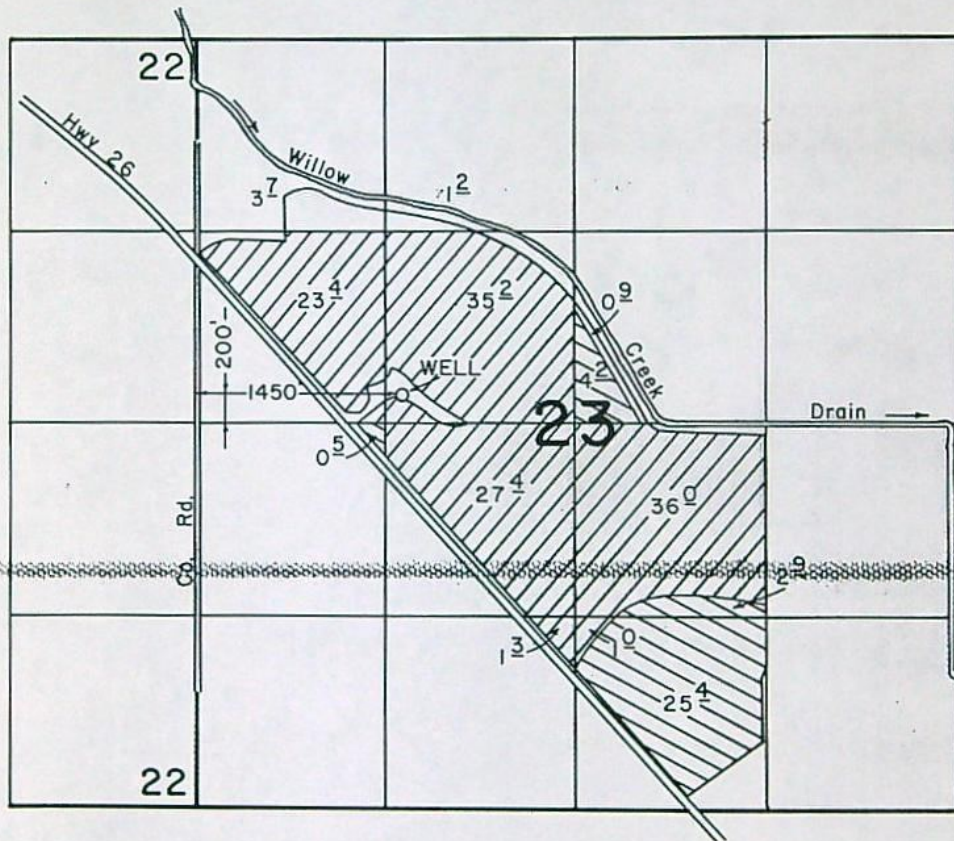

The Water Resources Department has reviewed and accepted the pump test results you submitted for POD-ID 26365. The Department requires no further testing of this well at this time. However, you will be required to submit a static water level measurement of the well on the ten-year anniversary of the test you conducted.

The Department has also reviewed your request for an exemption for the additional well listed above based on the results of the tested well. Our review indicates that the tested well and the well proposed for exemption:

- . are located within a five-mile radius and
- . appear to be completed in the same water-bearing zone.

Therefore, the Department is granting the exemption. This means that the additional well need not be tested. This exemption is valid **only if both wells are owned by the same landowner.**

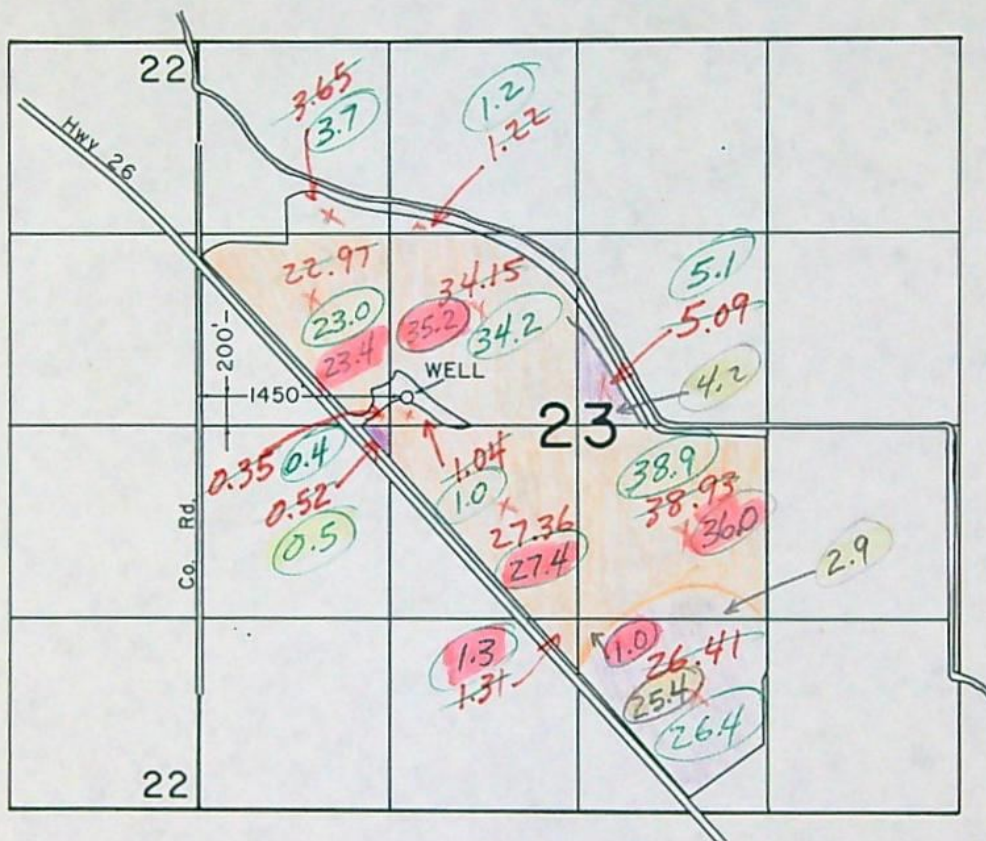

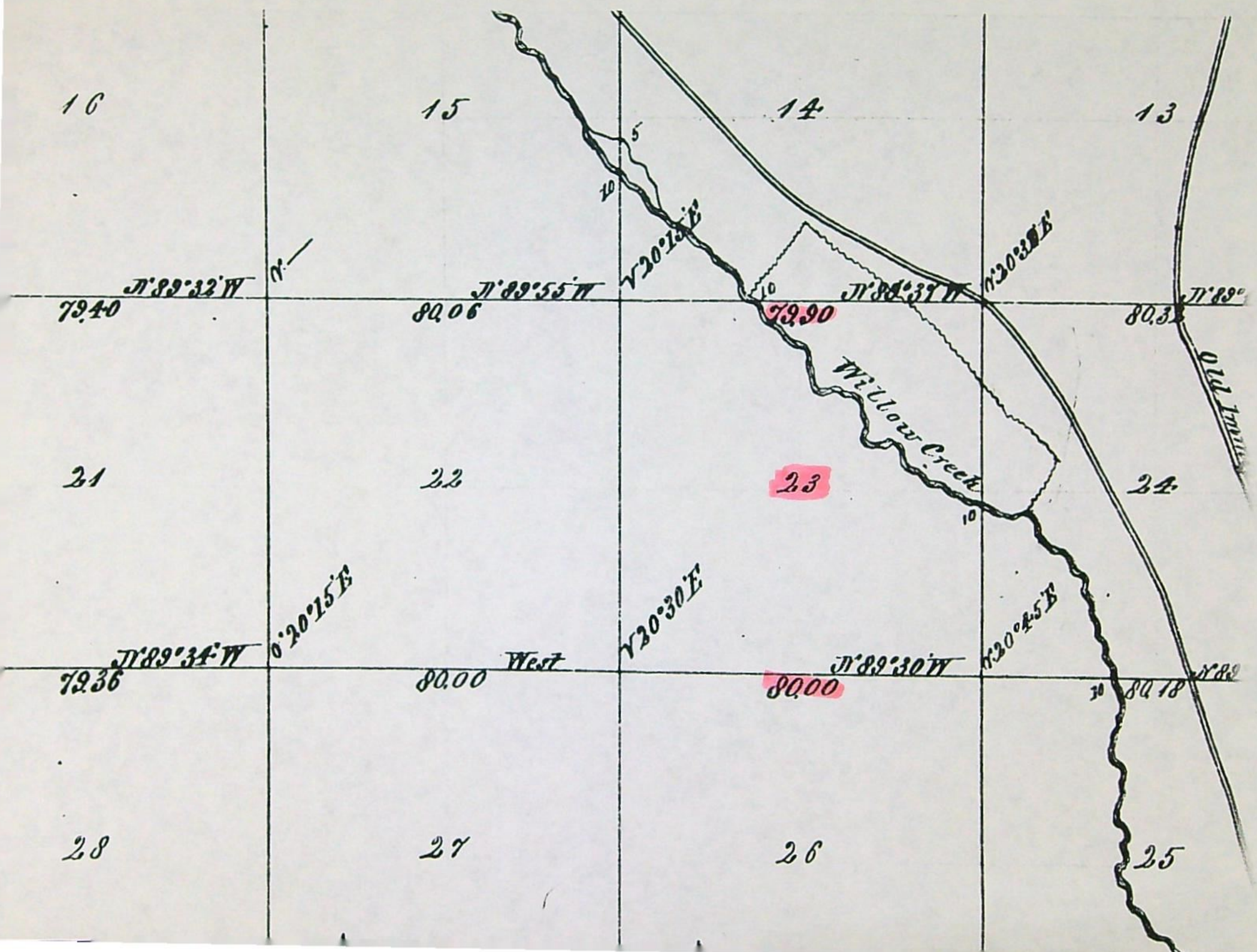

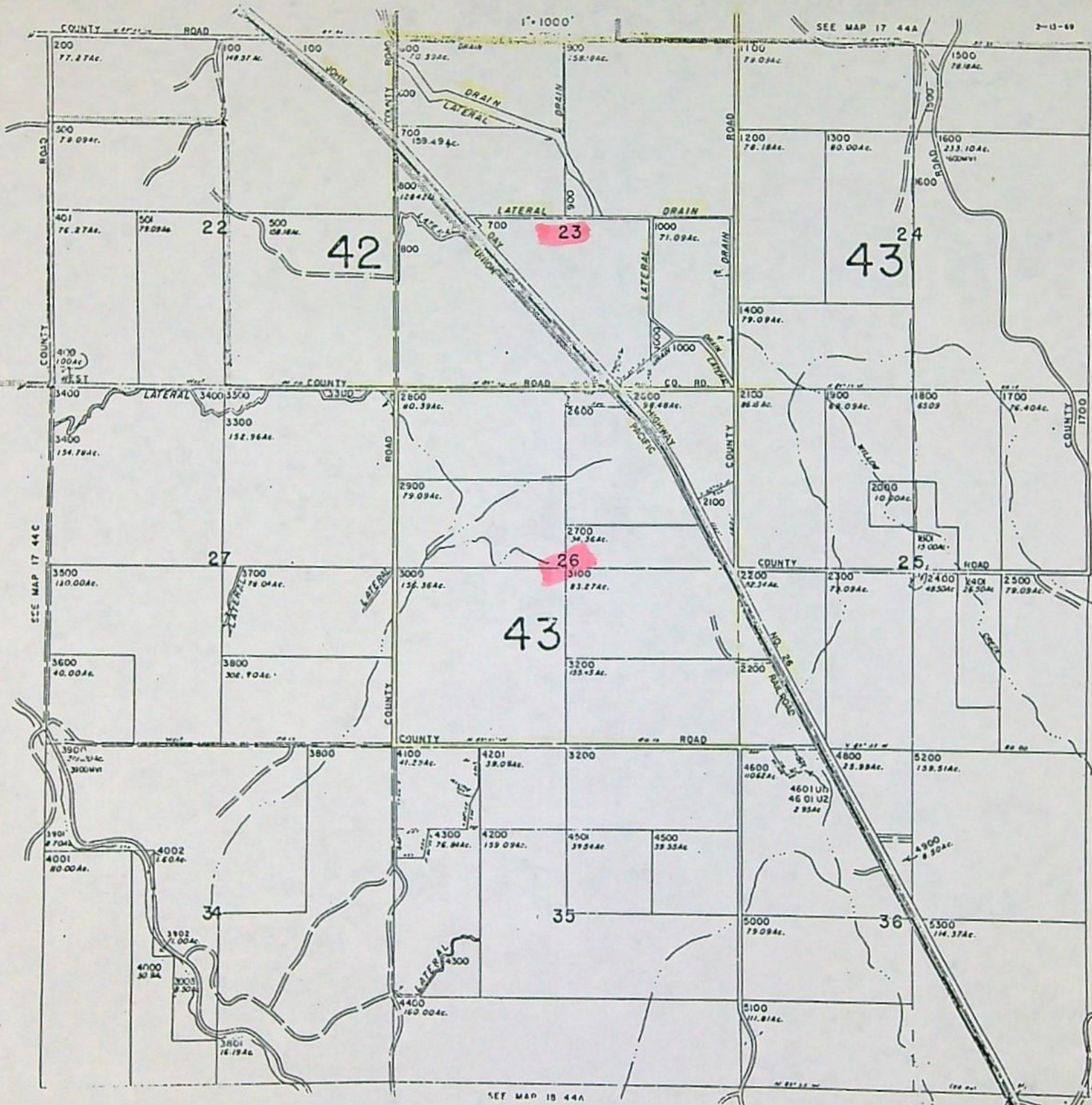

### Permit to appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.84 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the well or source of appropriation, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from a well.

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation and supplemental irrigation.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein,

Incidentally, adequate irrigation equipment for the project was to have been in your possession by October 1, 1979. We have not been advised as to whether or not this requirement was met. A form for reporting is enclosed.

Your application would receive the priority date, as of the date the proper fee is received in this office.

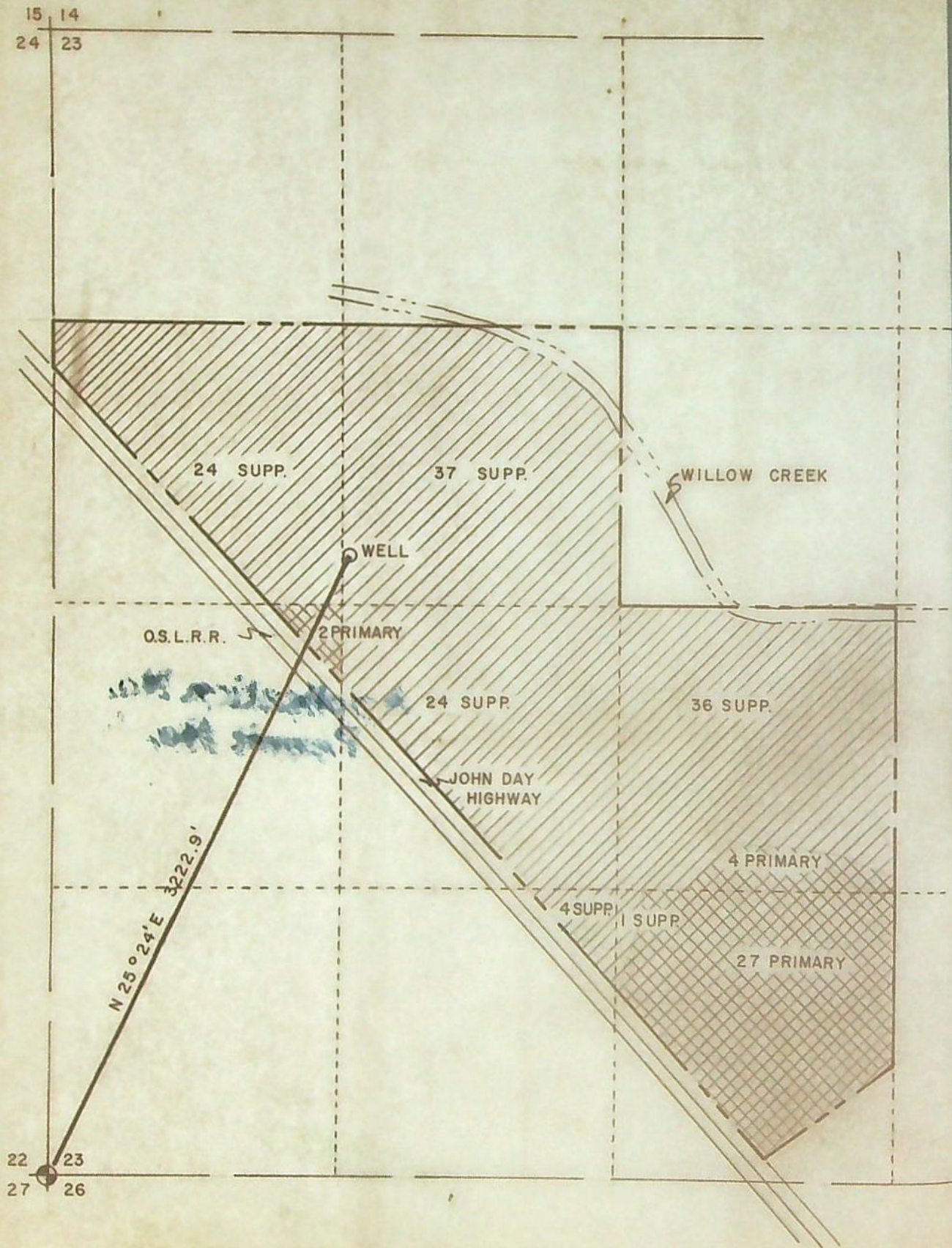
