



RE: Guidelines for processing certificates for claims received prior to 7/1/2004

### MAP

Maps are acceptable if they show the location of the use, the POD's or POA's, and an indication that the map was prepared by a CWRE.

If the claim includes irrigation, and DLC or government lots are present, the acreage should be shown in each DLC/Government lot within each QQ section. If the DLC/Government lot lines are not shown, the map is deficient in this area. Staff may either correct the map or may work with the GIS section to produce a new map. If a new map has been prepared or a correction to the original map has been made by the Department, the map along with an explanation of the changes shall be provided with the proposed certificate to the water user and CWRE. A proposed certificate will be mailed in each case where a map has been modified. A copy of the correspondence shall be left in the file as documentation of the change to the map.

### CALCULATIONS

Calculations are to be found satisfactory if there is some basis given for the claimed rate.

If the claim does not include calculations, but the claim contains enough information to determine the capacity of the system, the claim should be processed without the need to contact the CWRE or water user for additional information.

### PERFORMANCE RELATED CONDITIONS

Many claims do not specifically call out compliance with conditions (fish screening, ABC dates, measuring devices, amount of water used recorded monthly/annually, etc) but instead have a general statement from the CWRE similar to "use was found to be completed under the terms and conditions of the permit." This will suffice for most performance conditions.

## FISH SCREEENS

If the fish screen was required to be installed and inspected prior to making use and prior to the C date, the water user may use ODFW's approved self certification form at any time prior to certificate issuance. If the condition requires that ODFW approve the fish screen (and/or passage) device before water use begins, we will accept the approval information prior to certificate issuance as long as the fish screen was installed prior to use and prior to the C date. See memo implementing Sharyl's advice.

If the fish screen or by-pass device was not installed prior to the C date, the advice and implementing memo, read together, indicates that this can not be cured, unless ODFW writes a letter to indicate that the requirement was not needed.

# STATIC WATER LEVEL (SWL) MEASUREMENTS

A SWL measurement is considered timely if the measurement was taken in the month required, prior to the C date.

# WHEN A GROUND WATER FILE IS LACKING A PUMP TEST

If a pump test is the only item missing, contact the permit holder of record and the current property owner requesting the pump test.

# CONTRACTS FOR STORED WATER

If the claim is for a permit or transfer order for the use of stored water, in whole or in part, the permit or transfer holder or water user must have had a valid contract for the use of stored water in amounts at least equal for the lands and duty claimed. If the contract is for less water or lands, the proposed certificate should be for the lesser of the lands or duty. The water user may choose to file an application for water right extension of time so that water may be used consistent with the permit AND the contract.

A contract that does not match the developed use in relation to the location of the point(s) of diversion, place of use, number of acres (if less than the contract), is not a reason to delay the issuance of a proposed or final certificate. The water user must be notified of the importance of amending the contract to match their existing use as determined by the Department as evidenced by the certificate.

# DOMESTIC USE INCLUDING UP TO 1/2 ACRE LAWN AND GARDEN

When reviewing a final proof survey or COBU for "domestic use including up to ½ acre lawn and garden" where no water is being used in the primary residence, the domestic use does not necessarily have to be water used inside the home. The domestic portion of the use must be some use besides irrigation for a purpose ancillary to domestic use. In some areas, a domestic use may be served though some other type of water right (a group domestic water right or an exempt ground water use).

If a surface water permit was issued for "domestic use including up to ½ acre lawn and garden" we will determine that proof has been made if there has been some element of "domestic use" made and all other pertinent permit conditions have been satisfied (see definition of "domestic water use" below). Examples of domestic use other than in the house could include: a fish cleaning station; a water spigot that is used for car or house washing; a water faucet at an out building; filling a pool or hot tub.

OAR 690-0300-0010 (14) "Domestic Water Use" means the use of water for human consumption, household purposes, domestic animal consumption that is ancillary to residential use of the property or related accessory uses.

# ADDITIONAL INFORMATION REQUESTS - CURRENT OWNERSHIP

If additional information is necessary, and current contact information is questionable, research the County Tax Assessor's ownership information to determine the current landowner. Send the current landowner a copy of the letter mailed to the permit or transfer holder of record requesting additional information.







# FISH SCREENING CRITERIA FOR WATER DIVERSIONS

This summary describes ODFW fish screening criteria for all fish species.

Screen material openings for ditch (gravity) and pump screens must provide a minimum of 27% open area:

Perforated plate: Openings shall not exceed 3/32 or 0.0938 inches (2.38 mm).

Mesh/Woven wire screen: Square openings shall not exceed 3/32 or 0.0938 inches (2.38 mm) in the narrow direction, e.g., 3/32 inch x 3/32 inch open mesh.

Profile bar screen/Wedge wire: Openings shall not exceed 0.0689 inches (1.75 mm) in the narrow direction.

Screen area must be large enough not to cause fish impact. Wetted screen area depends on the water flow rate and the approach velocity.

Approach velocity: The water velocity perpendicular to and approximately three inches in front of the screen face.

Sweeping velocity: The water velocity parallel to the screen face.

Bypass system: Any pipe, flume, open channel or other means of conveyance that transports fish back to the body of water from which the fish were diverted.

Active pump screen: Self cleaning screen that has a proven cleaning system.

Passive pump screen: Screen that has no cleaning system other than periodic manual cleaning.

Screen approach velocity for ditch and active pump screens shall not exceed 0.4 fps (feet per second) or 0.12 mps (meters per second). The wetted screen area in square feet is calculated by dividing the maximum water flow rate in cubic feet per second (1 cfs = 449 gpm) by 0.4 fps.

Screen sweeping velocity for ditch screens shall exceed the approach velocity. Screens greater than 4 feet in length must be angled at 45 degrees or less relative to flow. An adequate bypass system must be provided for ditch screens to safely and rapidly collect and transport fish back to the stream.

Screen approach velocity for passive pump screens shall not exceed 0.2 fps or 0.06 mps. The wetted screen area in square feet is calculated by dividing the maximum water flow rate by 0.2 fps. Pump rate should be less than 1 cfs.

# SMALL PUMP SCREEN SELF CERTIFICATION

The Oregon Water Resources Department in coordination and cooperation with the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife includes screen requirements on pumps to protect fish as a condition of many surface water and/or reservoir water right permits. This is done in accordance with ORS 537.153.

The Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife does not usually inspect small pump screens at pumped diversions less than 225 gpm (gallons per minute), but furnishes the following fish screening criteria information to the water right permit holder:

Screen material open area must be at least 27% of the total wetted screen area. Perforated plate: Openings shall not exceed 3/32 or 0.0938 inches (2.38 mm). Mesh/Woven wire screen: Square openings shall not exceed 3/32 or 0.0938 inches (2.38 mm) in the narrow direction, e.g., 3/32 inch x 3/32 inch open mesh. Profile bar screen/Wedge wire: Openings shall not exceed 0.0689 inches (1.75 mm) in the narrow direction.

Screen area must be large enough not to cause fish impact. Wetted screen area depends on the water flow rate and the water approach velocity. Approach velocity is the water velocity perpendicular to and approximately three inches in front of any part of the screen face.

An Active pump screen is a self-cleaning screen that has a proven cleaning system. The screen approach velocity for active pump screens shall not exceed 0.4 fps (feet per second) or 0.12 mps (meters per second). The wetted screen area in square feet is calculated by dividing the maximum water flow rate in cubic feet per second (1 cfs = 449 gpm) by 0.4 fps.

A Passive pump screen is a screen that has no cleaning system other than periodic manual cleaning. Screen approach velocity for passive pump screens shall not exceed 0.2 fps or 0.06 mps. The wetted screen area in square feet is calculated by dividing the maximum water flow rate by 0.2 fps.

AGREEMENT FOR PURCHASE

Application No. 70222 OF DOMESTIC WATER Permit No. 51372

> THIS IS AN AGREEMENT made between Lookingglass-Olalla Water Control District, hereinafter called District, and Darrell L. Ham. 17-4 Consumer. It is dated 8-31-8 , hereinafter called expires /2-31-91

The annual reservation fee shall be \$100.00 per year payable January 1st of each year, shall be non-refundable and is due in full upon the signing of this contract. In addition to the reservation fee, the consumer will pay \$100.00 per year for use of domestic water, as hereinafter provided. Said \$100.00 use fee shall be prorated if this contract is signed on a date other than December 1 of each year.

Subject to the conditions hereof and in consideration of the covenants, agreements and payments hereinafter specified, the District agrees to sell and to deliver to Consumer at the point or points hereinafter mentioned and the Consumer hereby agrees to purchase and receive from the District not to exceed 2 acre feet of domestic water during each of the next three (3) ensuing years, commencing with the year of 1987.

This agreement is made upon the following terms and conditions:

- 1. The point of delivery of the water will be at the bank of <u>clalla Creet</u> on the property of <u>Kieth Haska</u>

  Tax Acct. # 12/16.10 , at such point as the parties hereto may agree upon for the installation of a pump or other facilities for the taking of the water from said stream.
- 2. All installations and facilities, including but not limited to the intake pipe, pump, or other means of taking water, shall be provided by the Consumer at its own expense.
- 3. The District reserves the right at all reasonable times to go upon the premises of Consumer or at the point of diversion to inspect the water intake and other facilities. All necessary easements must be provided by the Consumer.
- 4. The obligation of the District to deliver the water to the Consumer is conditioned upon the ability of the District, in the exercise of reasonable care and diligence, to provide the same. The District shall not be liable for failure to deliver the water

at any given time or in any given amount if it is prevented from doing so by breakdown of facilities, accidents or other events which may occur and be beyond the ability of the District to control.

- 5. It is acknowledged that the District has and will enter into other contracts with various Consumers for the purchase of irrigation and domestic water and that by reason of water shortages which from time to time may occur either from inadequate rainfall or other events beyond the control of the District, the District may be required on a pro rata or other equitable basis to make reduced allocations of the right of the Consumer and other consumers to receive the amount of water called for in this agreement in any given irrigation season year. Consumer agrees that the District shall have the right so to do.
- 6. The obligations of the District hereunder at any time may be limited by any lawful order, regulation or ruling of any governmental agency which may impair or make it impossible or impracticable for the District to perform any one or more of its obligations hereunder and this agreement is subject thereto.
- 7. The price to be paid for the furnishing of domestic water to the Consumer shall be at a rate applicable at the time of the signing of this contract. A rate schedule is attached hereto and made a part of this contract.
- 8. The District shall bill the Consumer for the water used each year or part of year from December 1 of each year. If the Consumer has not used water for one full fiscal year period, his water user fee will be prorated as of December 1. Consumer agrees to pay the billing for water used for the billing period within a period of not more than 30 days after such billing, and if said water bill is not paid within 30 days after such billing, interest will be charged from the date of said billing at the rate of 9% per annum. The District reserves the right to refuse to deliver water to the Consumer or to the real property for which water is furnished under this agreement at any time when the Consumer is in default in payment of any water charge or billing.
- 9. The District reserves the right to promulgate reasonable rules and regulations applicable to all water users of the District governing the taking and use of water from the District. Consumer agrees to comply therewith, and the District shall have the right to withhold delivery of water to the Consumer at any time while the Consumer is in default or in violation thereof.






