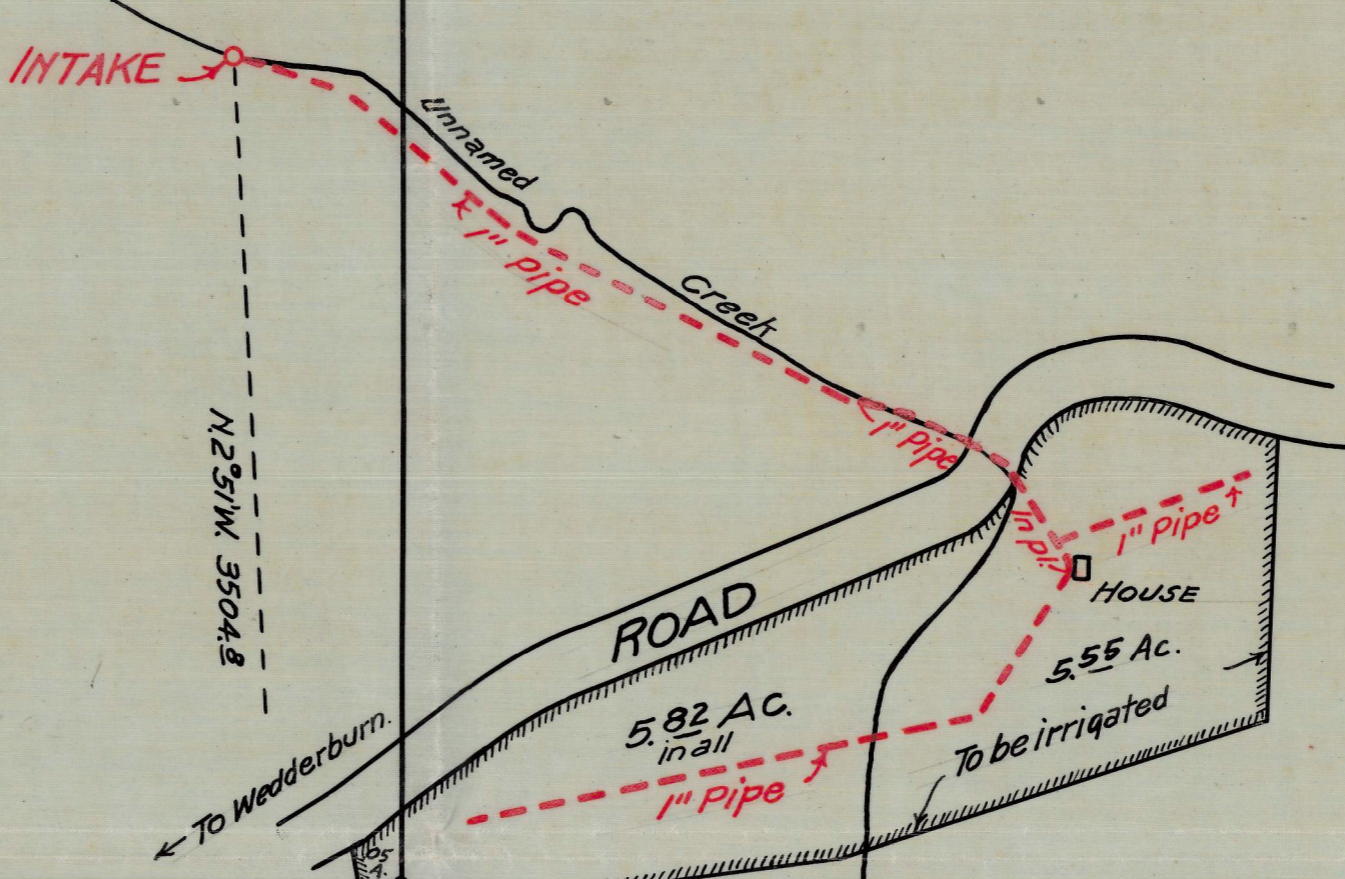
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MAP OF

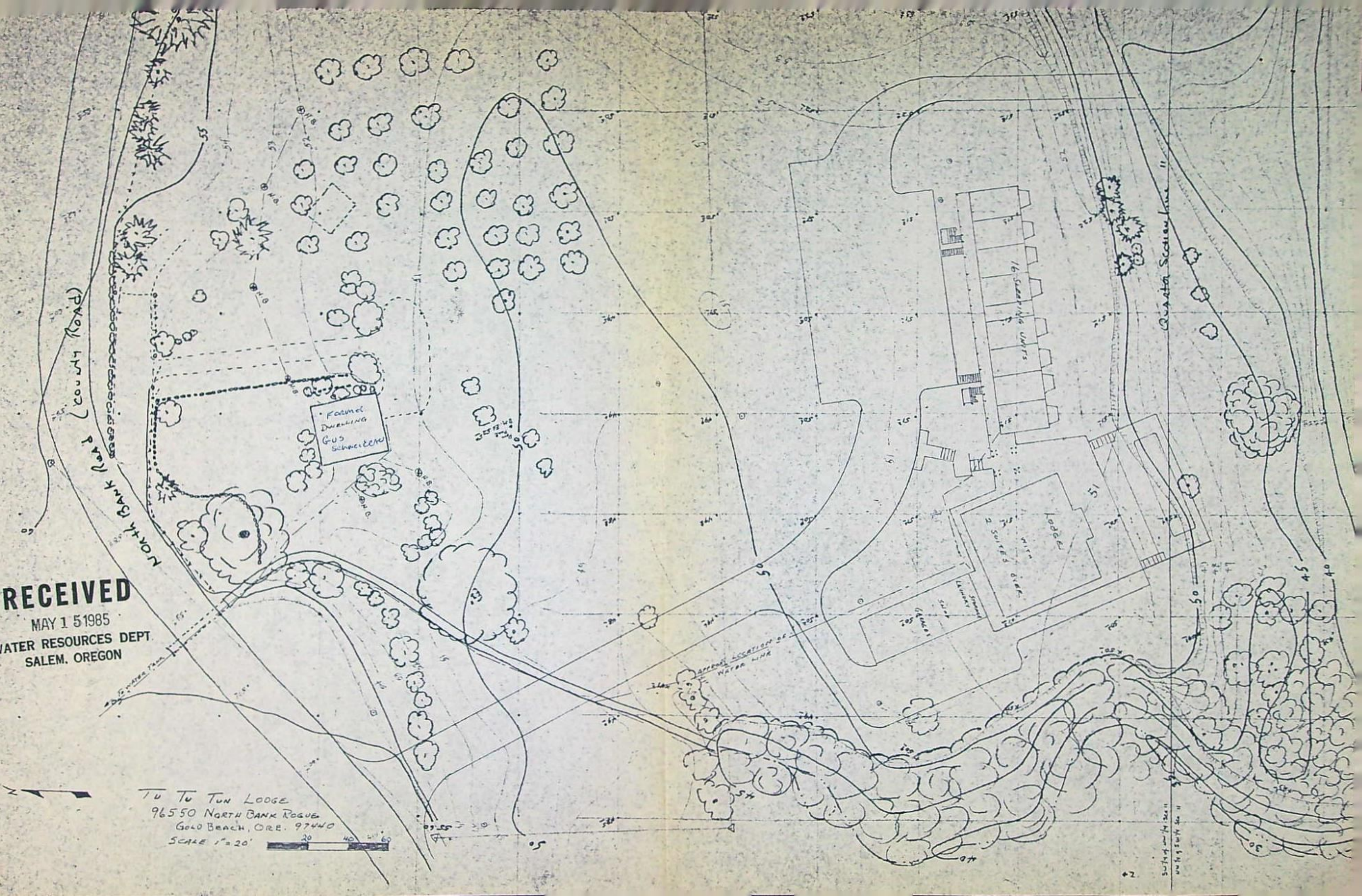

Enclosed find copies of maps associated with application No. 13930 and No. 49642 as discussed in our telephone conversation of March 27, 1978.

If I would have been looking for more than the name of the creek, I would have noticed that application No. 13930 is in the name of Gustaf Schneidau and the unnamed stream involved is most likely Schneidau Creek.

The Right under application No. 13930 is for 0.07 cubic feet per second of water from an unnamed stream for domestic use of one family and irrigation of 5.55 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, section 11, township 36 south, range 14 west W.M. as evidenced by certificate No. 10751.

The Right under application No. 49642 was issued permit No. 36106 for the use of 0.02 cubic feet of water per second from the same unnamed stream for domestic use of four families and irrigation of 1.0 acres. The diversion point for this permit is shown approximately 60 feet downstream from the Schneidau diversion. A certificate has not yet been issued to confirm this Right.


I assume the water right you have reference to is that which you made application for in January, 1931. The certificate recorded at page 10751 was issued in evidence of your right to appropriate 0.07 cubic feet per second of water from an unnamed stream for domestic use of one family and irrigation of 5.5 acres. According to the maps submitted with the application which also accompanied the proof the house described in the right is East of the Creek about at the location you show on your sketch for the house on Tract 1. The 5.5 acres is all within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, so it includes substantially that which you outlined in red on your sketch with the exception of the small strip to the river and a fraction of an acre on the extreme West edge of the property. Unless the right was forfeited by failure to use the water for a period of five successive years it is valid but does not include all the additional uses of water you refer to in your letter. It does not include the use in your home on the West side.

The problems in the use of a common pipe line for several parties involves property rights not within the jurisdiction of this office and these problems should best be discussed with your attorney.

To establish a right for the uses you say are being made, the various owners should individually or collectively file applications for permits. Unless the existing right has been forfeited each owner of parts of the 5.55 acres has that share of the right appurtenant to their land for irrigation but this does not provide for domestic supply or for trailer court, or for commercial operation.

Dear Mr. Evert:

The certificate recorded at page 10751 State Record of Water Right Certificates was issued to Gustaf Schneidau, evidence of the right to appropriate not exceeding 0.07 cubic foot per second of water from an unnamed stream for the irrigation of 5.55 acres and domestic use of one family. If the right or any part of it has not been forfeited by failure to use the water for any period of five successive years the right is valid and is appurtenant to the lands described whether it be in one ownership or divided in several.

For any additional users or uses an application for a permit should be made. A permit does not carry with it the right to cross another's property to gain access to a water source. This must be resolved between the property owners involved.

If you wish a copy of the certificate issued to Mr. Schneidau and a print of the map showing the point of diversion and place of use we will furnish it if you will submit a copying fee of \$1.60. If you should order this would you please refer to File No. 13930.

I am enclosing a form and copy of the Rules and Regulations of the State Engineer for your use if you wish to make application for a permit.

We are the present owners of part of the property covered under the water right application of Mr. & Gust Schneidau our next door neighbor. He was granted these water rights about 47 years ago from a small stream originating ~~xxxxx~~ North of the Rogue River and flowing southerly into the Rogue. This stream is located in Section 11 Twp. 365 R 14W WM, Curry County, Oregon.

As the present system is not quite adequate to handle our needs, we have talked with Mr. Schneidau and he advises that there is more than ample water and that if we were able to get second water rights, that we could put in our system below this and still have much more than enough for our needs.

I would appreciate it if you would send us a photocopy of the original water rights agreement (for which I will be happy to pay) and the present status, and any information that you could furnish us with regard to our application for second rights.

Dear Sirs.

I have been going along for several years saying nothing. Now it seems like I have to. First I started to raise milk here. Needed piped water so took out water right. I carried up 3 28' sections of 4" galvanized pipe for my intake. Then 3" one thousand ft to road, 100 ft drop about 42 pounds pressure. The food problem was serious, so bought 35 ac. adjoining Hart's State Park.

Sold Walter Fisher 140 ac. N2 on the map. Decided I would sell the rest of it and build on the 1/2 ac. I had just west of him.

The first thing I did was to put in a pipe line. Fisher said I will pay for pipe if I can get it on it. So we done it that way.

Then I sold 6 acres to Hobart Cook. ^{Not} he used a lot of water. Walt got a bulldozer to make a part road part ways up the creek. I then backed up, pkp with gravel then wheel barrowed it up hill for 100 ft. Then my wife and I built form poured the concrete. The result a 4x4x8 tank with screens. "No more water dogs in the faucets or parts of them. The worst was when water had

one half of a tope and I found a dead sheep
in the creek I had to take out in pieces.
We never got the milk ranch moved to Brook-
ings Our son coming home from working
on the place cracked up on his motor cycle has
been in a wheel chair ever since. lives with
us."

We sold Mr Fisher N3 he built a large shop and
stroke house, a place for his boats.

Walt said I would like to bring a water pipe
over to the shop. Told him OK.

In the 50's many high waters that came up on siding
of Fisher home. Fisher wanted to get out.

Hobart Cook the following spring said -

Cost I would like to have the water right
papers. If you move away ect ect.

I told him Hobart it doesn't make any differ-
ence if you or I have them there is so much
issued to each acre off hand you can have
the papers providing 1/2 comes my way

"I don't think that pipe line carries the
water issued ms."

Cook puts in I plier 4 elbows below where
my pipe line comes in to check the flow
Fisher sells to a police sergeant from LIA
he wants a trailer Court. I told him do
do not hook your trailer court on that pipe
line he said the law is I can not use

surface flow water for a public place without chlorinating it. So just let me hook up hose enough to dig a well. I said I do not want a trailer court or that like. He looked on told me you told him to hook on and OK. To use surface flow water. Cook sold, that remained the same.

64 Flood came we lost 40 years off work clothes furniture tools garage tools toolhouse just the shell of our home windows gone door smashed. No help, we had a savings account. So no help. I was 70 we found after the flood that Corvair by all appearance had used a booster on pipe here.

Oh Boy here it comes
Bob White, a building contractor from SEB
He buys the Trailer Court No 3. A Building contractor and his brother is an architect buys No 1 they said we have the water right you people do not belong on this line. They put in a large swimming pool tap the line below where I tap the line and put in a larger pipe. "I have not checked my neighbor legs"

Now this pipe goes to the large Totstok Lodge. Now Bob White sells No 2 to

a Mr Dave Everett Bob when he bought built a
fine upstairs apartment and downstairs
recreation room Laundry showers Toilets
where boat house was that went out in
flood. Bob White digs a deep well as I
keep telling them U.S. Plywood will log that
creek you will have mud. Tototen digs well
either one will use water from the wells
Tototen does now as after every storm you
have to clean screens in the creek.

Mr Everett wants to go up creek build tank
below ours take over flow as at night tank
catches up and overflows

shaky, heart O.K. 132 over 82.

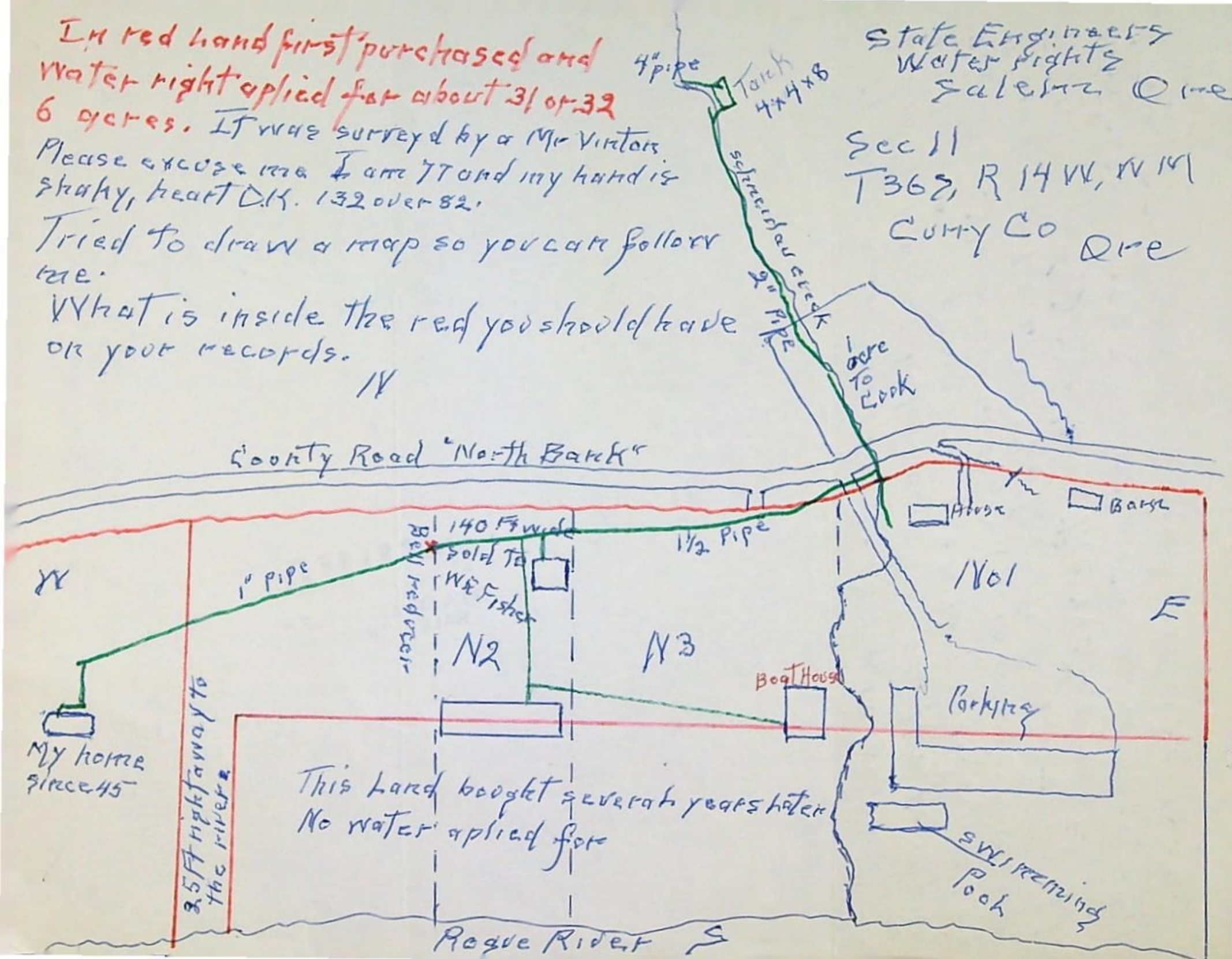

There is no statutory provision for re-issuing certificates to show subsequent owners of the property nor recording assignments of perfected rights so as to change our records. This action is not considered necessary since the right is appurtenant to the land for which it was issued and travels with it at time of sale unless specifically reserved in the deed.

Since this information was not previously furnished, I am returning the assignment and the certificate as well as your check. If you still wish us to record the assignment, we will do so and the recording fee necessary is \$1.50. We will not be able to take any action other than recording the assignment in the Miscellaneous Records of the State Engineer.

We will notify you regarding any filing Mr. H. E. Crowder may make within the next year as stated in our letter dated October 23, 1959.

In reply to your letter of October 19, we have no record of a water right application having been filed in the name of H. E. Crowder.

Our records show that on May 8, 1934, certificate No. 10751 was issued in the name of Gustav Schneidau in evidence of a right established under permit No. 9987 for the appropriation of not to exceed 0.07 cubic foot per second from an unnamed stream within Section 10, Township 36 South, Range 14 West, W.M., with the priority date of July 24, 1931 for domestic use and for the irrigation of 5.55 acres of land within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 11, Township 36 South, Range 14 West, W.M.

Any water in the stream not necessary to the satisfaction of this right within the limits of the certificate is available to appropriation under a State Engineers permit.

If you wish to be notified if an application is filed in the name of H. E. Crowder in this area and will so advise us, a note will be entered into our records so that at any time during the next year if such an application is filed you will be given an opportunity to file a formal protest against the approval of such application. A protest against the State Engineer's approval of an application can be filed only on the grounds that the proposed project will conflict with existing rights, or that the approval of such an application will be prejudicial to the interest of the people of Oregon.

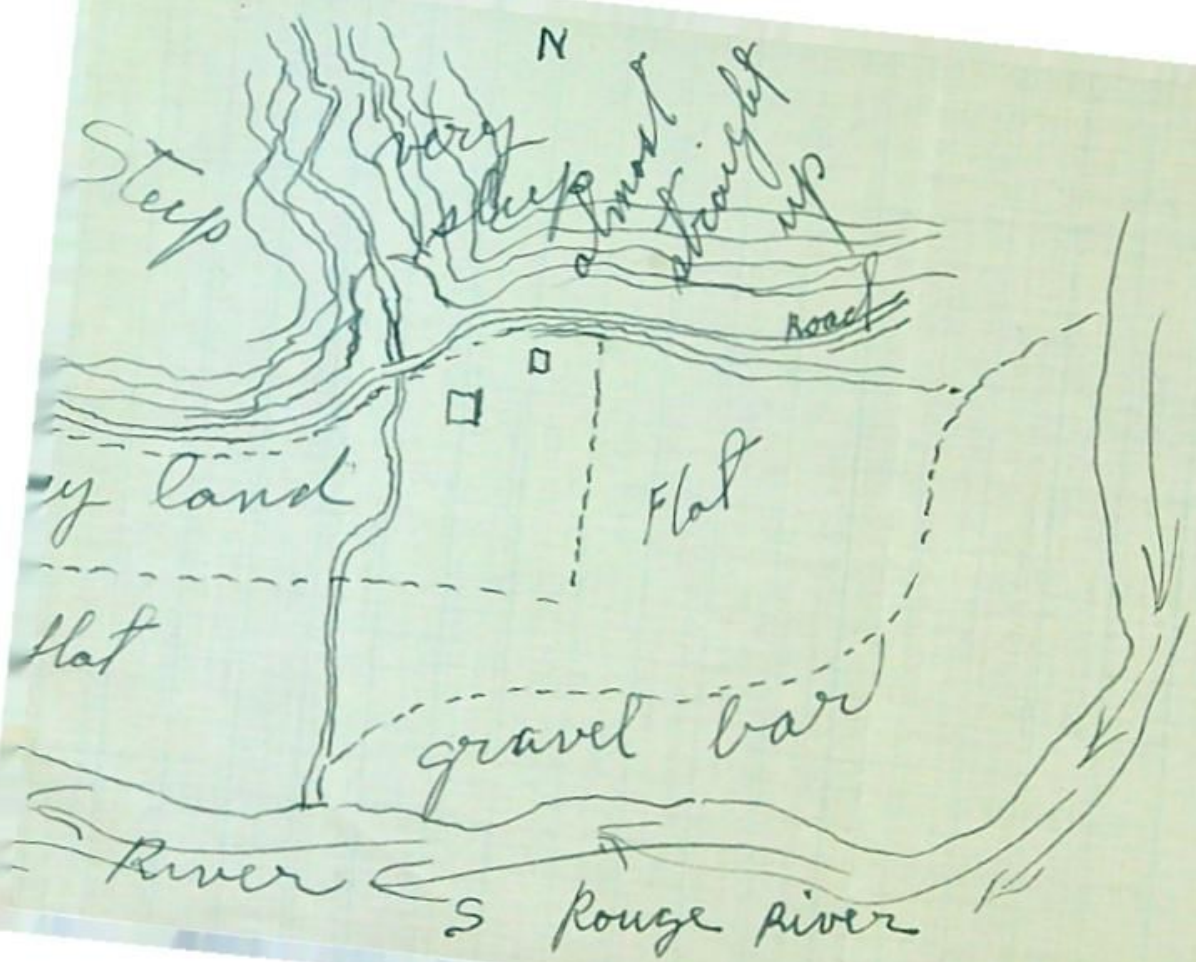
It was at O.K. to I applied for a water right, as I did not like the idea of spending \$500.00 out of my savings then Macleay telling me
