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

General description the Lone Mountain Resort Park water system:

The water system for the Lone Mountain Resort Park is complicated and includes two wells, and surface water from the West Fork Illinois River provided by T-13592. The water is treated for domestic use, is inspected by Josephine County, and has a Public Water System number of OR41-95444. Well 1 pumps water into three 2000 gallon storage tanks, well 2 pumps water into three 2000 gallon water tanks. The river water can be pumped into the well 1 storage tanks for domestic use or pumped directly to the irrigation of lawns and ornamentals. From the six 2000 gallon storage tanks pressure pumps are used to move water to the places of use and all water is metered.

During the wet season well 2 provides all group domestic water needs. During the dry season well 1, well 2, and the river water can all be used to supply treated group domestic water as needed. During the irrigation season river water is used to irrigate one acre of lawns and ornamentals. The river water is pumped from the O'Brien ditch with a 5 HP centrifugal pump and through a water meter. The lawns and ornamentals are irrigated with impact sprinklers, oscillating sprinklers, popup sprinklers, and drippers. The underground domestic PVC pipe distribution system is arranged in a loop layout.



- Point of re-diversion (PORD) from the O'Brien Ditch, 5 HP pump, and 2" water meter. The PORD is 90 feet south and 760 feet east from the north 1/4 corner of Section 25. The POD on the West Fork Illinois River and the ODFW fish screen are shown on the transfer map.

 Well JOSF#59705 and Well2 JOSF#60550.
- 1.0 acre of primary irrigation rights from the West Fork Illinois River under application S-6998 and permit S-4471 with a priority of February 17, 1920 at a rate of 0.0125 cfs and a duty of 3.5 acre feet. The 26 small squares are 0.01 acre lawns at RV slots.
- Group domestic uses from the West Fork Illinois River under application S-6998 and permit S-4471 with a priority of February 17, 1920 at a rate of 0.0125 cfs and a duty of 3.5 acre-feet during April 1 through October 31. Uses are in and around 42 RV slots, 5 tipis, the lodge, 3 pump houses, bathrooms, restrooms, laundry, a fountain, a sink, and the office.

This map was drawn by Gordon R. Lyford for James Beard, trustee of Trin Corp Roth 401K - Lone Mountain Resort Park LLC to support his claim of beneficial use under water right transfer 13592 to change the irrigation place of use and character of use. Lone Mountain Resort Park LLC owns tax lot 2000.
