

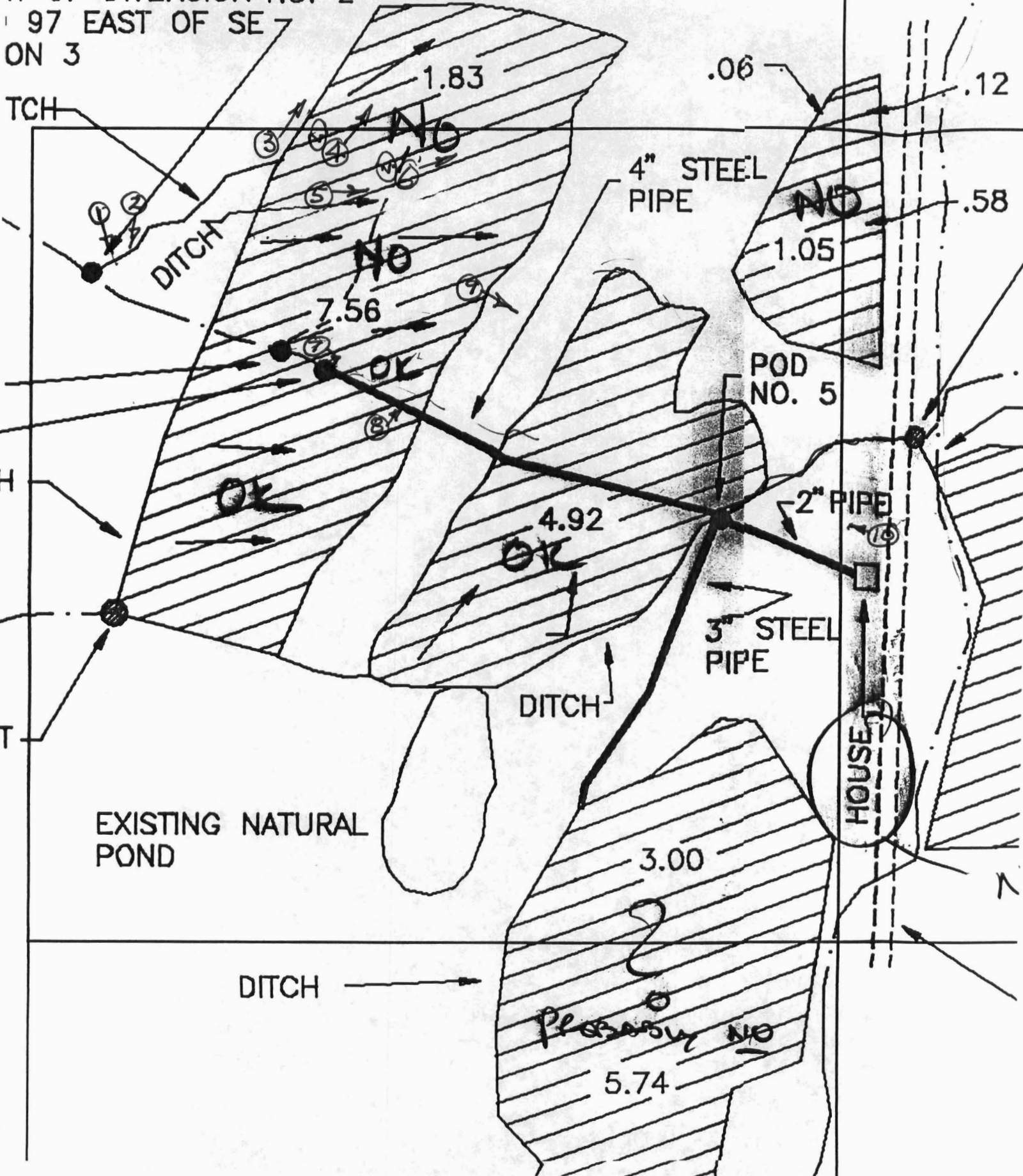

I am sending a copy of my memo to your surface water registration file. As you can see, we have some question as to the validity of a claim to a beneficial use. For a claim to be valid, the use must not have been abandoned or unused for a period of 5 successive years. I have not completed my final review of all the information but I suspect I will recommend that a portion, approximately $\frac{1}{2}$ of the irrigation and the domestic use not be allowed. This would leave about $\frac{1}{2}$ of the irrigation that I could recommend for indorsement under this program.

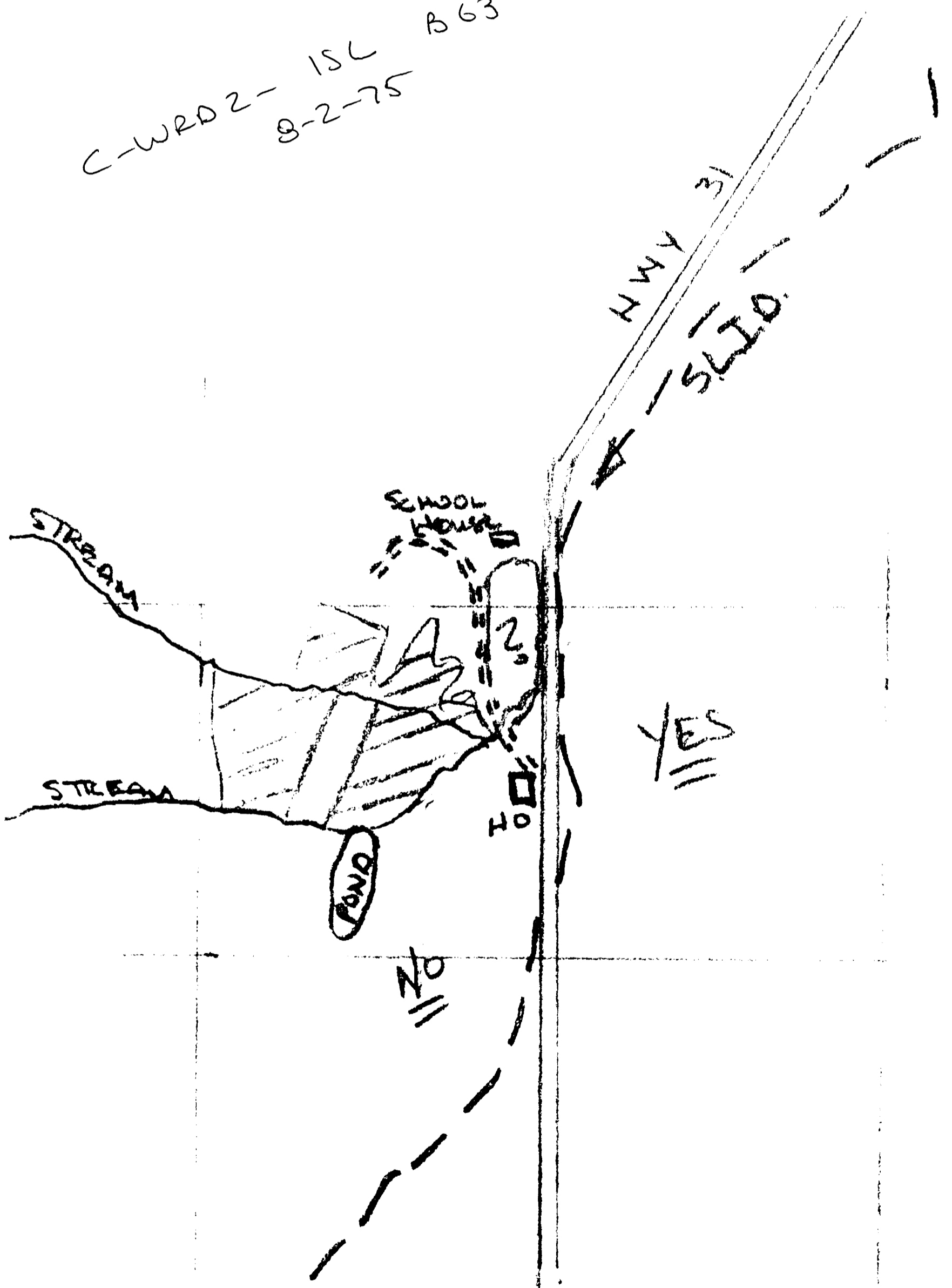

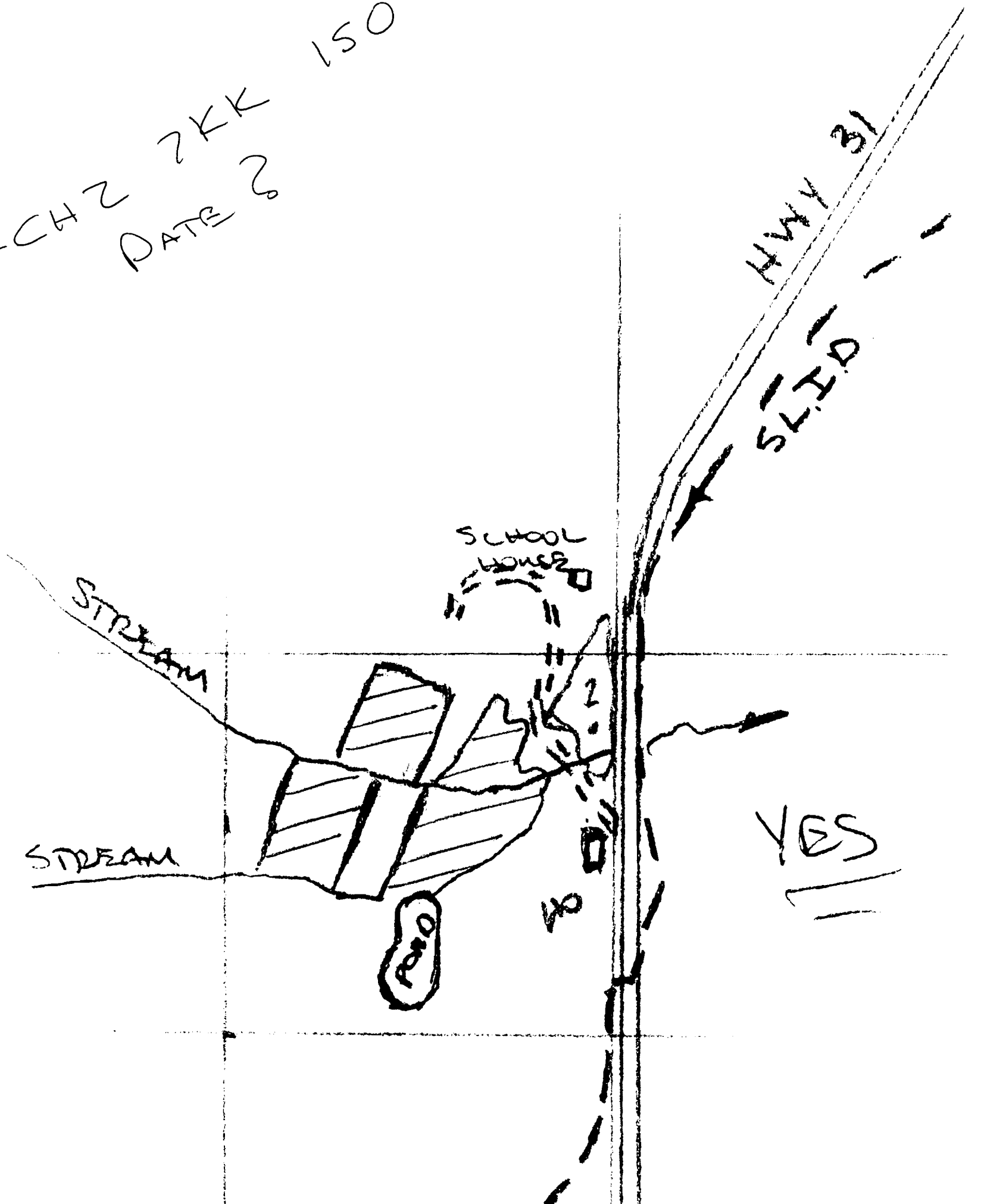
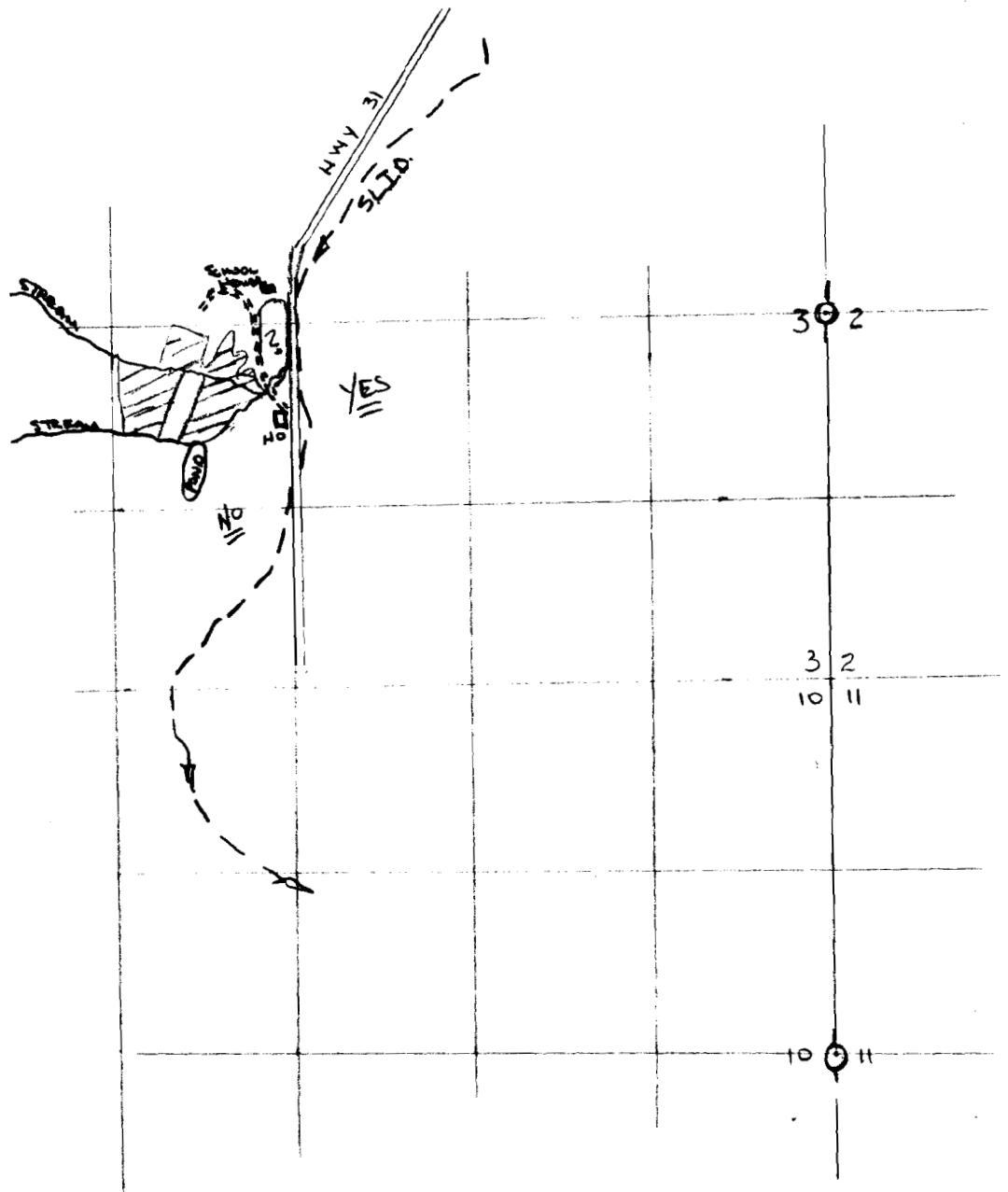

SKETCH OF LOOSELY PROPERTY

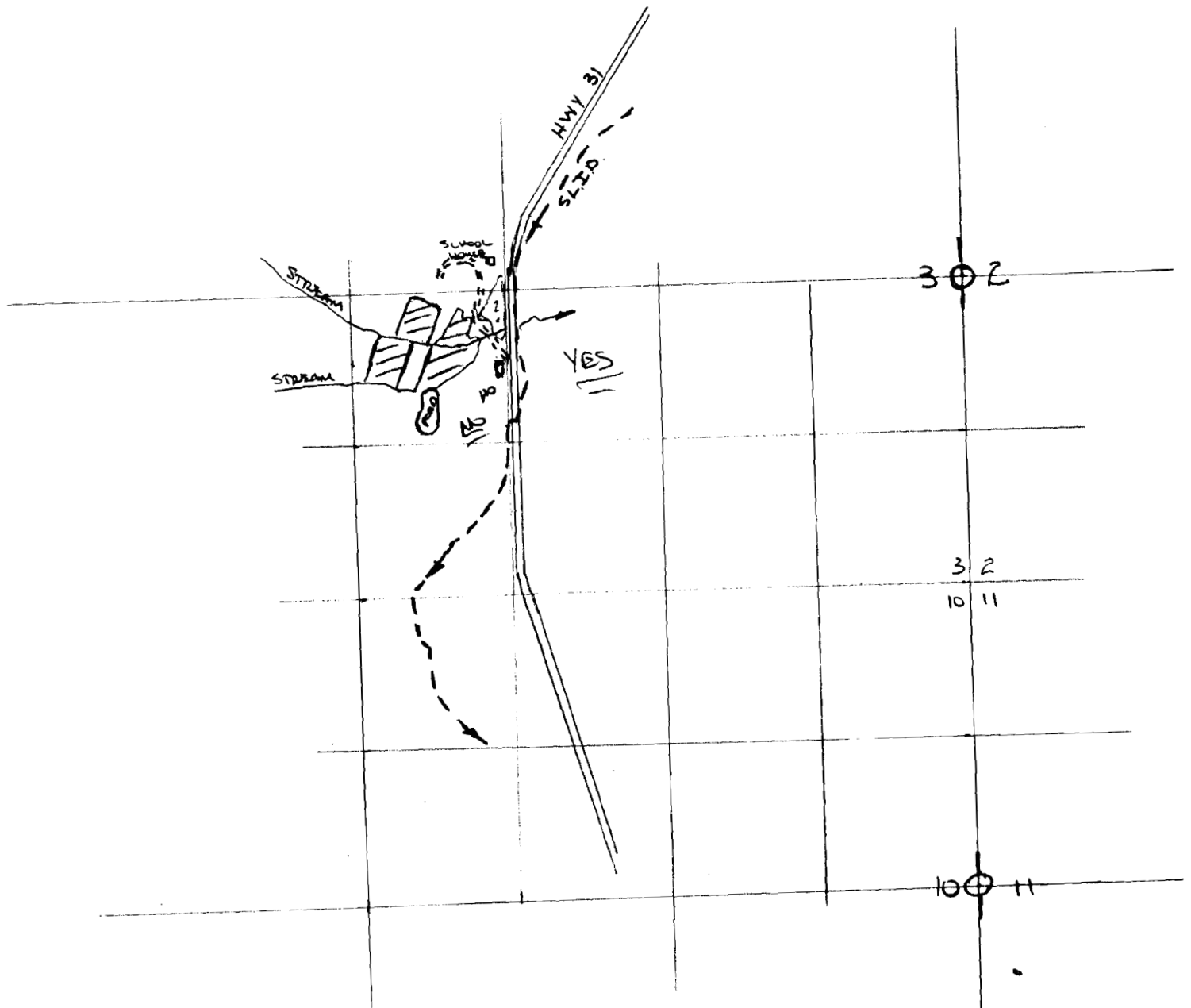



SUBJECT: PHONE CONVERSATION WITH MS LOOSLEY

This morning Ms. Loosley called and asked if I would fax her a copy of the map that I had made my notes on during my field inspection on May 5, 1992. I faxed a partial copy of the map prepared by Anderson Engineering for this claim which I had used to write my notes on.

Ms. Loosley called after she received the copy of the map. She was upset to find that I was likely to recommend that portions of the claim not be allowed. We talked first about the domestic part of the claim. She said there has been a renter in the house until last year. (This goes along with what Darryl Anderson said about his visits to the property to do the survey.) I told her I would change my recommendation on the domestic use.

We then began to talk about my visit to the property on May 5, 1992 and what my recommendation will be concerning the irrigation claim. I explained what I had done and saw (which I had done in my memo, which she had). I told her about the aerial photos I had discovered and what they showed.

She told me that every bit of the property has been irrigated within the last year by the renter who works for Mr. Alan Withers and that the renter is willing to testify to that.

I explained the adjudication process to her and she asked if she should write me a letter about what she knows to have gone on on the property. I told her that was a good idea.

POINTS OF DIVERSION

NO. 1, 2 AND 3 DIVERT INTO SMALL HAND DUG DITCHES (NO. 2 DIFFICULT TO FOLLOW) SLOPE VARIES FROM 1% TO GREATER. CROSS SECTIONAL AREA ABOUT 0.5 TO 1.0 SQ. FT. CAPACITY VARIES FROM 0.25 TO 0.5 CFS.

NO. 4. IS A SMALL CONCRETE WEIR WHICH DISCHARGES INTO A 10 INCH STEEL PIPE. SUBJECT: FIELD INSPECTION

On May 5, 1992 Dwight French and I arrived at the property covered by this SWR. As we drove up Mr. Alan Withers was driving out of the gate west of the house. He told us he was doing the irrigating and had started the water that morning. He said he needed to do some work on the ditches to get them into better shape.

Mr. Withers left and Dwight and I walked to the west side of the property and diversion point # 2. We walked through an orchard which had sagebrush growing waist high around the trees. The diversion point was not in use and a short distance down the ditch was an upturned tree root-wad blocking the ditch. The tree had been down so long that the bark had fallen to the ground. The ditch was in total disrepair with breaks and filled in here and there. We found that all diversion points and ditches were in very poor repair. The pipe system was all but unusable. The pipe was rusted and had frost breaks along it. The concrete structures were frost heaved and almost unusable. The house did not appear to have been lived in for many years, probably more than five years. All use under this claim is very questionable and I have shown on a print of the map prepared by Anderson CWRE # 005 the areas definitely not to be allowed and some areas which could be allowed.

I retrieved my camera from the car and retraced our route across the property and took a number of slides to document the existing conditions.

It was apparent that Mr. Withers had done some work on this day to irrigate part of the property.

After returning to office I discovered aerial photographs covering the area of this property. There are two photos, # CHZ 7KK 150 (which is not dated but work was done on the photo by an employee who left the WRD in about 1976) and # C WRD2 15L B63 1-3 dated 8-2-75. Both of these aerial photographs show the property

in a condition as we found it on our site inspection. That is, the only irrigation appears to be what is happening on an coincidental bases. Ditches happen to be there and water happens to get to some of the property.

We need to contact the CWRE and review this map and claim to a beneficial use so that he fully understands the SWR program and what is required by the claimant for "beneficial use".


In your discussion with Chris Wheeler and Dwight French you indicated that additional information was necessary to justify your acceptance of the surface water registration claim.

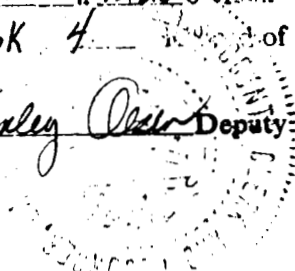

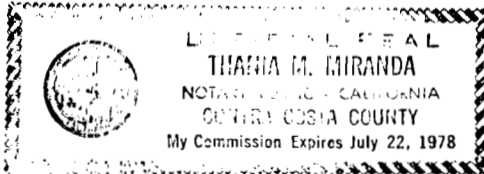

During this time, part of my responsibility was to water an area referred to as the North and South orchards located West of the highway. This was done each year. The North orchard was watered by diverting water from the creek to a ditch at the top of the orchard running North and South. From this ditch, I would let small amounts of water out to cover the ground. When it became wet, I then closed the opening in the ditch and repeated the same procedure until the ground had been covered.

It was easy to irrigate the land in the orchard up to an area about 20' North of the road in the orchard that crosses this ditch. The area past about 20' North of the road really drank the water. I'm sure that this water through seepage helped irrigate the pasture below the orchard and up to the highway.

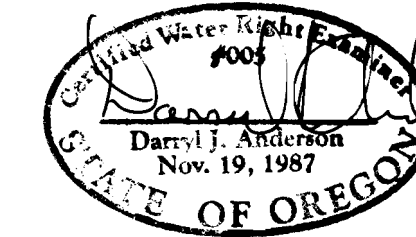
