SUBJECT: Field inspection on October 13, 1992

On October 13, 1992 Dwight French and I met with Ms. Knox and Mike Mitchell who is buying the property. They showed us the fields and water use. The fields are pasture, hay and grain. A neighbor is leasing from Mitchell and doing the irrigating. The property is within a USBR Project. Some fields under contract get water from the Owyhee Reservoir. The fields on this claim do not get contract water.

The fields in this claim appear to be the lowest in elevation and probably were the first irrigated. Mitchell said there is only about 18 feet of fall in the delivery ditch from the diversion point. It appears that some changes have been made in the system and that probably occured after the USBR project. At present the ditch is used by this property and a neighbor between this property and the diversion point. The neighbor may have a claim also.

The field east of the ditch is quite dry. They said this is due to the drought and lack of water. This is the only questionable area but I couldn't argue against a claim.

4. Description of Water Delivery System:

The diversion dam is an existing gravel dam across Succor Creeck. It feeds an earth ditch with a top width of approximately 10-12 feet and a depth of 3 feet. This ditch traverses the property of 3 other owners prior to reaching the Knox property approximately 2 miles away. Water is delivered through a culvert under Desert Glen Road into a concrete ditch running eastward along the south boundary of Section 6. This ditch leads to a small ravine in the SW/SW quarter of Section 6. The ravine is the central point of the present irrigation system. All of the head ditches, both earth and concrete, are fed from this channel.

Water from the Ridgeview Irrigation District flows onto the property from the south in Lot 4. A ditch circles around a small knoll to the west and delivers water to the ravine mentioned above. This ditch is approximately 3 feet in width and 1 foot deep.

All the concrete ditches on the property are of the same size:
Top width - 3.3 ft.
Bottom width - 1.0 ft.
Depth - 1.2 ft.

The earth head ditches on the property are similar in size:


Top width - 3 ft.

Bottom width - 1.5 ft.

Depth - 1 ft.

Two distinct methods of water use are included in this application. First is furrow irrigation of 3 parcels: 1) the 2.2 Ac. north of the concrete ditch in the SW/SW of Sec. 6; 2) the 3.2 Ac. north of the same ditch on Lot 4, and the 2.4 Ac. in the SE corner of Lot 4.

The rest of the acreage proposed is the area shown as small black dots on the application map. These areas will be sprinkler irrigated using aluminum mainline and handlines. Two 10 hp. pumps are proposed, one located in a pump pit in the ravine in the SW/SW of Sec. 6, and the other at the wastewater recovery site in Lot 3. A 6-inch PVC pipe will carry this water from the pump site to the distribution ravine.



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



I am writing you regarding the status of a registration statement filed by Cleathel Knox on the property that we purchased (SWR-45).


I have had several discussions with the ASCS office regarding on and off farm delivery system improvement ideas. One of the items that we have discussed is changing our point of diversion for the Succor Creek water that the registration statement was filed on. The water is currently diverted across Mr. Markley's property, approximately a mile through a virtually flat, unlined ditch. We are considering installing a pump at the northwest corner of our property to take the water from Succor Creek and deliver it to the high point in our concrete ditch system at the southwest corner of our property. Do we have to amend the registration statement which Cleathel filed or will changing the point of diversion make any difference?


I can probably complete the design of the pumping system, but I can not begin discussing cost share with ASCS until I have a finding from Water Resources. We are also discussing some improvements to our on-farm and irrigation district delivery systems. Again ASCS doesn't want to talk about the particulars until we can prepare an overall development plan for the site. Can you give me any idea how the claim process is progressing and how long it might be until any decisions are made?
