Dear Mr Cramer,

This will acknowledge your letter received June 14, 1993. You asked about the review of the files and my recommendation to the Water Resources Director in regards to the pre-1909 vested water right claims made by the Vickers. I did expect to complete the review and my recommendation sometime last winter. Two unexpected projects occurred and delayed my review and my recommendation to the Director. The big one was receiving over 500 pre-1909 vested water right claims during the fall and early winter.

There is legislation pending, House Bill 2110, which would change the Water Resources Departments (WRD) processing and administrating the pre-1909 claims. I am waiting the outcome of this bill before completing my review.

The Vickers have done what has been required to file their claim to a pre-1909 vested water right. The manner in which the WRD processes their claim will not affect the validity of their claim.

SUBJECT: Field Inspection on October 12, 1992

On Oct 12, 1992 Dwight French and I visited this property. Mrs Vickers was not available to meet with us. We spoke with her hired man who said he has been there about a month. She had told him that it has been about three years since any water was in the creek.

Dwight and I drove up the field to the diversion points. The fields south and east of Curtis Creek are hay. The fields north and west are bunch grass and some sage brush. There isn't much sigh of water being used from the creek but it must be due to the drought. I think the claim is somewhat marginal but couldn't actually recommend denying it.

I don't think there is anyone downstream who might be affected by this water use. And it is unlikely anyone upstream would be.





Dear Mr. Cramer:

This will acknowledge that a Registration Statement Claiming a Right to Appropriate Surface Water in the name of Lyle and Helen Vickers has been received by our office. The fees in the amount of \$ 92.00 have been received and our receipt #83340 is enclosed. The claim has been numbered SWR-59.

I am returning the claim form because I need clarification on the following items. Your answer to question # 2 lists two sources. I need to know the quanities of water claimed from each source in your answer to question # 5. Your answer to question # 3 lists two beneficial uses, irrigation and stockwater. If these are two seperate uses you will need to list the amount of water for each use from each source, list the period of use for each in answer to question # 7 and pay a fee for both uses. (An additional \$ 200 if the amount is less than 1 cfs.) If the stockwater use is part of the irrigation use then all I need is clarification. The question is if water is diverted outside of the usual period of irrigation use for stockwater. If the answer is no then usually the stockwater use is included with the irrigation use. If the answer is yes then you will need to answer the questions I have listed above and we will need to have the stockwater use shown on the map prepared by your CWRE.

You asked when this claim would be confirmed and a certificate issued. The earliest you could expect an "indorsement" under ORS 539.240 (6) would be late fall or winter of this year. I can't speculate as to when an adjudication of this area might occur. It won't start until after the deadline for filing registration statements which is December 31, 1992. I have no idea how long an adjudication might take and a final decree entered by circuit court. Certificates would not be issued until a decree is entered.

Conversation with Lyle Vickers at Vicker's home in Sec. 12, T.23S., R.33E., W.M., Harney County, Oregon

RE: Surface Water Rights - "Turner Field"

"Mahon Creek used to be called Menn Creek after Jim Menn.

Water from Curtis Ck. flows Southwest to Layton Point and then some goes South and some swings West around Layton Point and fills up a little pond, and then about 90% goes South again.

Curtis Ck. and Mahon (Menn) Ck. come together in Sec. 13 and flows Southwesterly to the Turner Field. The water just floods Southwest, there are no definite ditches or dikes until you get to the SW corner of Sec. 26. Everything south of Sec. 13, and Mahon Ck., misses Turner Field.

In SW of Sec. 26, the SE of Sec. 27, and the NE of Sec. 34, there are a series of dikes and levees that dam off the "low spots" to keep the water flowing Southwest towards Turner Field.

Some years the whole area floods, and even in low water years it spreads out over a large area.

From the stock well located in the SE1/4 of Sec. 33 the water collects here in a main ditch that flows Southwest to the pond located just East of Turner Field. There is a large dike just South of this pond that directs the overflow from this pond West to Turner Field.

Turner Field has a series of dikes and levees that hold the water so this field can be flood irrigated. When the water gets deep enough it spills over these dikes and heads South again.'

I, Charles F. Palmer, registered Water Rights Examiner, certify that the above is a true and accurate summary of the conversation I had with Lyle Vickers on Nov. 26, 1991, and based on my notes.
