Dear Sir:

This will acknowledge your application for a permit to appropriate .6 cubic foot of water per second from a well for the irrigation of 30 acres, the accompanying map, legal description, and fees of \$15 for which our receipt No. 6931 is enclosed.

The application has been filed and numbered G-3242.

Item 18 indicates that the 30 acres are supplemental to permits Nos. 15670 and 15577. Permit No. 15577 has been confirmed by a certificate and does not include land in the NWA NWA of Section 30. Permit No. 15670 also has been confirmed by the certificate and only includes 20 acres in the NWA NWA of Section 30. Your application, then, should be for supplemental irrigation of 20 acres and primary irrigation of ten acres. You should also indicate on your map the location of the 20 acres irrigated from the West Fork of the Illinois Hiver.
