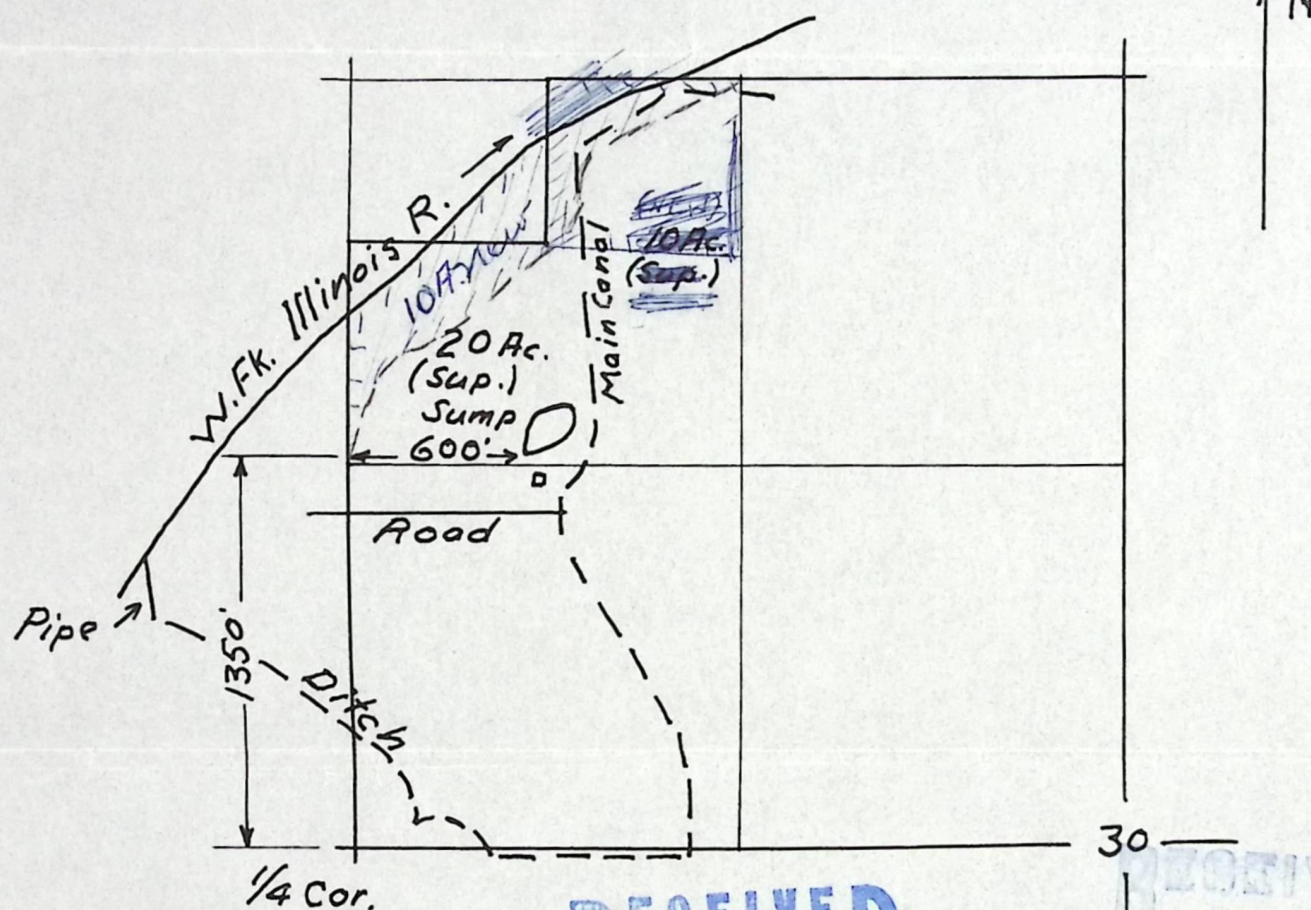

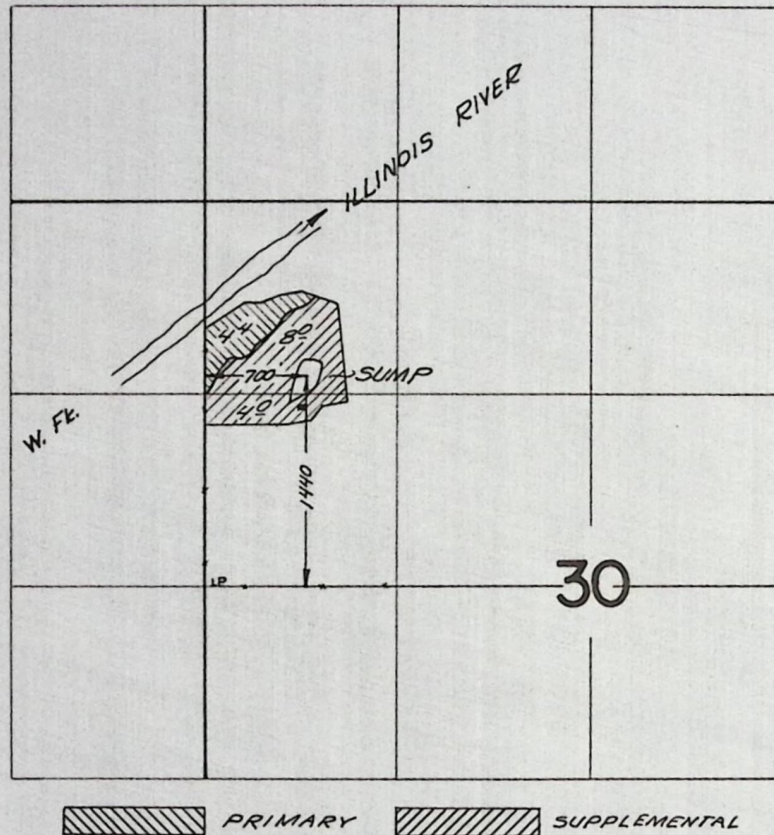



The dashed pencil line on your map is approximately the North line of the 20 acres granted in Permit No. 15670. 

Dear Sir:

This will acknowledge your application for a permit to appropriate .6 cubic foot of water per second from a well for the irrigation of 30 acres, the accompanying map, legal description, and fees of \$15 for which our receipt No. 6931 is enclosed.

The application has been filed and numbered G-3242.

Item 18 indicates that the 30 acres are supplemental to permits Nos. 15670 and 15577. Permit No. 15577 has been confirmed by a certificate and does not include land in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 30. Permit No. 15670 also has been confirmed by the certificate and only includes 20 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 30. Your application, then, should be for supplemental irrigation of 20 acres and primary irrigation of ten acres. You should also indicate on your map the location of the 20 acres irrigated from the West Fork of the Illinois River.

I am returning both the application and map so you may make the changes. The application is endorsed so that in order to retain its date of priority it must be returned to this office on or before December 13, 1965.

Mr. Ross uses this pump to pump any where along the banks of the Sump. He lays his pipe out to cover high spots that don't get covered by the usual flood system, the entire field surveyed gets flood basically.

The sump has more the appearance of a pond than a sump. One side of sump is excavated, the other is a embankment, visible seepage in the excavated area. Also a defined channel flows below the sump and has water flow from an overflow pipe.

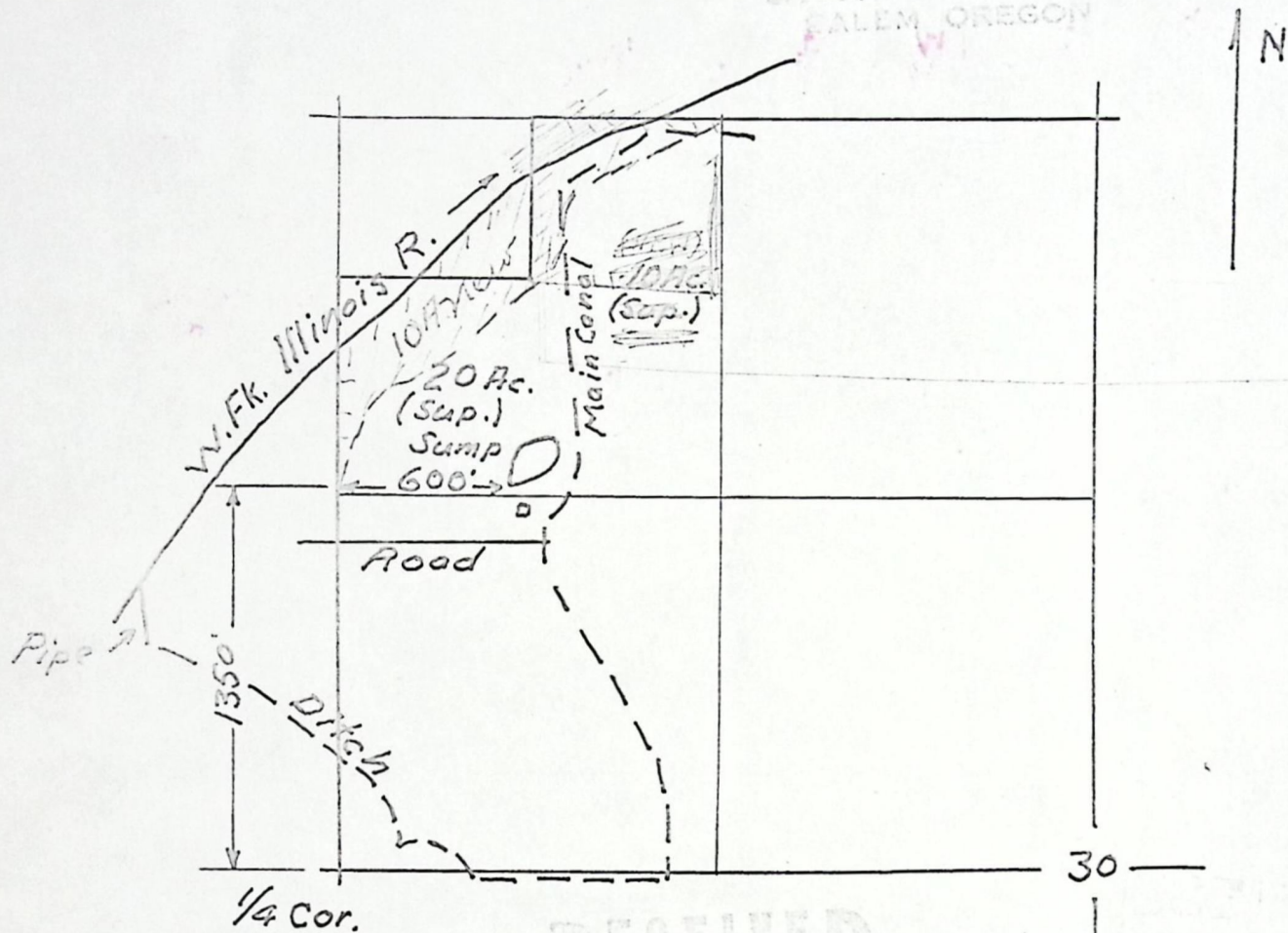
