Dear Sir:

This will acknowledge your application for a permit to appropriate .6 cubic foot of water per second from a well for the irrigation of 30 acres, the accompanying map, legal description, and fees of \$15 for which our receipt No. 6931 is enclosed.

The application has been filed and numbered G-3242.

Item 18 indicates that the 30 acres are supplemental to permits Nos. 15670 and 15577. Permit No. 15577 has been confirmed by a certificate and does not include land in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 30. Permit No. 15670 also has been confirmed by the certificate and only includes 20 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 30. Your application, then, should be for supplemental irrigation of 20 acres and primary irrigation of ten acres. You should also indicate on your map the location of the 20 acres irrigated from the West Fork of the Illinois River.

I am returning both the application and map so you may make the changes. The application is endorsed so that in order to retain its date of priority it must be returned to this office on or before December 13, 1965.

Brown and the law under which the permit was issued, construction should have been commenced on or before December 3, 1944, construction should have been completed on or before October 1, 1945 and water should be completely applied to the use contemplated, namely the actual irrigation of 15 acres of land, on or before October 1, 1946.
