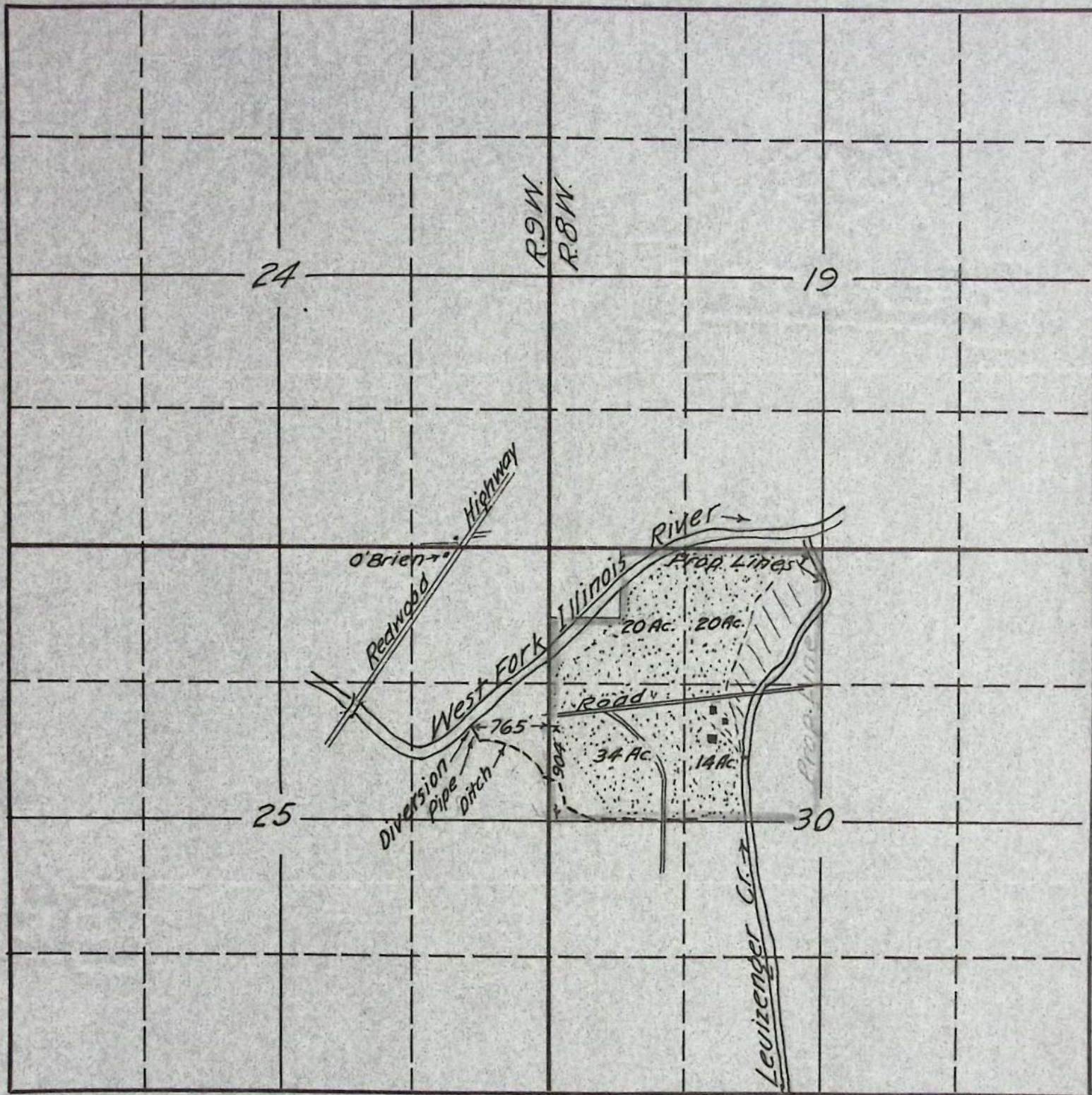

Eugene R. Brown of O'Brien,
State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of

of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon;
that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from

January 10, 1944
that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby con-
firmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually bene-
ficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.76 cubic feet per
second

or its equivalent in case of rotation.
The point of diversion is located in the $SE\frac{1}{4} NE\frac{1}{4}$, Section 25, T. 40 S.,
R. 9 W., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount
secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited
to $\frac{1}{50}$ th of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent
for each acre irrigated throughout the irrigation season from April 1st to
November 1st of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by
the proper state officer.

Dear Sir:

This will acknowledge your application for a permit to appropriate .6 cubic foot of water per second from a well for the irrigation of 30 acres, the accompanying map, legal description, and fees of \$15 for which our receipt No. 6931 is enclosed.

The application has been filed and numbered G-3242.

Item 18 indicates that the 30 acres are supplemental to permits Nos. 15670 and 15577. Permit No. 15577 has been confirmed by a certificate and does not include land in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$, NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 30. Permit No. 15670 also has been confirmed by the certificate and only includes 20 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$, NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 30. Your application, then, should be for supplemental irrigation of 20 acres and primary irrigation of ten acres. You should also indicate on your map the location of the 20 acres irrigated from the West Fork of the Illinois River.

I am returning both the application and map so you may make the changes. The application is endorsed so that in order to retain its date of priority it must be returned to this office on or before December 13, 1965.
